## Parking Consultation & Feedback

### Bruce Grove North and Bruce Grove Controlled Parking Zones (CPZ)

Dear Resident or Business,

In February 2019 you may recall the council undertook a review of parking controls in your area. Questionnaires were distributed, giving residents the opportunity to feedback their views on the operational aspects of the CPZ. Based on your feedback, Ward councillors, the Cabinet Member for Neighbourhoods and council officers have now agreed how to proceed.

### Consultation Feedback

#### Bruce Grove North CPZ area

Of the 1814 properties that were consulted, 272 responses were received representing a 15% return rate. Overall, there was a positive response to the existing CPZ controls, with 72% of those responding saying that the CPZ made it easier to park. When asked about operational times, 51% of those who responded wanted the controls to remain the same, 30% wanted shorter operating times and 20% supporting evening controls.

As the majority of residents showed support for the operational times to remain the same, the council will not be proposing any changes.

#### Bruce Grove CPZ area

We carried out a review of this area to understand the level of support to merge both Bruce Grove and Bruce Grove North CPZs. The council had been receiving reports of parking congestion, and problems with finding parking space, particularly where the two zones meet. Merging both zones will provide greater flexibility and parking opportunities, especially for residents living near the boundaries. The council had also received requests to introduce event day controls as complaints had been received in relation to commuter parking activity, associated with the opening of the new Tottenham Hotspur Stadium.

Of the 468 properties that were consulted, 75 responses were received, representing a 16% response rate.

When asked, “Are you in favour of combining the Bruce Grove CPZ with the Bruce Grove North CPZ”

44% of those consulted were in support of these changes, 35% objected and 21% had no preference.

## Next Steps

Given the level of support to merge both zones and introduce event day controls in the Bruce Grove CPZ area, we are proposing to merge the two zones so that they **operate as 'Bruce Grove North'**.

This means the operational times of the CPZ area will remain **Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm**, and the event times will operate **Monday to Friday 8am to 8.30pm, Saturday & Sunday 8am to 8pm, Public Holidays Noon to 8pm**. A map is enclosed that shows the extent of the new proposed zone.

The council will also introduce additional shared use and short stay Pay by Phone facilities throughout the area to provide improved parking opportunities for visitors.

A statutory consultation on these changes will begin on **Wednesday 12 August 2020** and provides a 35-day period for people to comment or object on the proposals. 
