I am writing to express my concerns about the change of designation of the Pinkham Way site from employment use to industrial use. I understand that this is formally referred to as 'employment land designations in SP8 Employment of the Core Strategy, change of land designation for DEA6 from employment land to locally significant industrial site.' I live with my young family on Victoria Road in N22, and fear that we will be negatively impacted by the proposed waste plant.

There are a number of grounds on which I object to the change of use the Pinkham Way site. These are:

The suitability of using the site for industrial use when it has been previously listed as green space that should be protected.

The environmental impact of using the site for industrial use, particularly when the site is very close to a built up residential area and local schools. In particular, the site is very close to Rhodes Avenue primary school, which is at the end of Victoria Road and which will be our first choice school for our son.

The limited consultation that has been carried out and Haringey Council's failure to adequately consult local people and inform them of the re-consultation. The first I heard of the change of use was when I saw posters on our street campaigning against it.

The loss of land for employment use and the impact this will have on creating new jobs.

I hope that this helps to convince you that the proposal for the waste plant should be refused. If you would like to discuss, please let me know.
