# What's next for Broadwater Farm A look ahead





With works already underway and more expected over the coming months and years, 2023 is set to be an exciting year for Broadwater Farm and its community. Residents will start to see new homes being built and the requested repairs and refurbishment getting underway.

# **New Homes, Rehousing and Demolition**

- The Tangmere mural removal and restoration will start in February and end in June 2024, when it will be installed in its new location
- New homes will start being built on the former Moselle School site in the summer
- Tangmere demolition will be completed in August

# Improving the core housing services, repairs and estate services

- A programme of communal repairs in all blocks has now started will be complete at the end of June
- Communal areas across the estate will be decorated and cross corridor fire doors in blocks, and individual fire doors will be installed from August onwards (in all blocks with the exception of Martlesham and Rochford where it will be included in the pilot refurbishment programme starting in January 2024)

# Refurbishment programme

- Pilot kitchen and bathroom projects completed in January. The main works to replace 93 kitchens will complete by June
- A refurbishment meeting with PRP Architects and residents was held on 9 February to discuss the pilot external refurbishment programme, which will include Rochford and Martlesham blocks, followed later by the rest of the existing blocks. The works involve structural strengthening, building insulation and fire safety, among other elements. Residents will have more opportunities for input in the coming months

# A visit to the Gascoigne Estate

A group of residents had an insightful experience on Thursday 26 January during a 'study visit' to the Gascoigne Estate in Barking.

Wilmott Dixon, the contractors also responsible for the new homes on Broadwater Farm, invited residents to take a look at the new homes they are building on the estate which are at different stages of construction, from foundations to being ready to let.

It was a great opportunity for residents to see construction in progress and get an understanding of how the new homes on the estate will be built and what they could look like when they are complete!





# Temporary Storage for Tangmere Mural

Demolition of the Tangmere block is already underway and the next important step in the project is the careful removal of the mural.

Preparation for this is now starting with excavation works set to start soon to create a temporary structure that will store the mural ahead of its restoration.

The contractor will be drilling eight boreholes, using a drilling rig, and excavating trial pits with a mechanical excavator, all to ensure the soil is suitable for the structure. All works will be taking place between 8am - 5pm, to minimise any disruption to locals and visitors.




# **New Recycling Areas**

The second and last Wednesday of the month between 11am - 1pm. You can report and get confidential advice about any ASB issues that you are concerned about from drug use or dealing, littering and vandalism, noise nuisance, hate crime, abusive language or behaviour, and fly-tipping

#### Your Money and Rents Surgery

The second and fourth Monday of the month between 9.30am - 1pm. If you are a tenant or leaseholders and having difficulty paying your rent or service charges the team can help. This includes support to manage your finances and look at opportunities for grants and additional welfare benefits.
