

Car Park Terms and Conditions

Our Car Parks are managed under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended). A copy of the relevant order is available from parking@haringey.gov.uk

The required parking fee must be paid during the operational hours unless the vehicle has a valid parking season ticket or permit for the car park.

Outside the operational hours of our car parks, vehicles may park free of charge.

Vehicles are restricted to parking within the designated marked bays.

Contraventions of any of the provisions of the Traffic Management Order may lead to the issue of a Penalty Charge Notice.

A vehicle which appears to be abandoned or left in a parking space in contravention of the regulations may be removed to a place of safe keeping and eventually disposed of. Costs of release, removal and storage will be charged to the registered keeper.

The car park may not be used for advertising, trading, camping, cooking, sleeping, washing or servicing vehicles unless agreed in advance with the Council. It is forbidden to erect any tent, booth or other structure.

Blue badge holders

Blue Badge holders may park for free. The named person whose photograph appears on the badge **must** be either a driver or passenger in the car at the time of parking.

Exclusion of Liability

Haringey Council, its servants and agents will not accept liability in respect of any loss, destruction, damage or theft from any vehicle save where the same is caused by the negligence, wilful act or default, or breach of statutory duty of the Council, its servants or agents, or the dishonesty of its servants or agents, and Haringey Council, its servants and agents will not accept liability in respect of the death or personal injury sustained by customers and others in the Car Park save where the same is caused by the negligence, wilful act or default, or breach of statutory duty of the Council, its servants or agents.

Penalty Charge Notice Information

A penalty charge notice may be issued to a vehicle if one or more of the regulations governing the use of the car park are contravened.

The contraventions include:

- Failure to pay the parking charge.
- Incorrectly displaying a valid pay and display ticket.
- Staying beyond the time you have paid for.
- Failure to park within the marked bays.

- Parked in a 'Blue Badge holders only' bay without correctly displaying a valid Blue Badge
- Parked in a permit bay reserved for designated users.
- Parked in such a position to cause an obstruction.
- Parking a vehicle which exceeds the maximum height and/or weight and/or length limits permitted in the area.
- Parking a vehicle in a car park or area not designated for that class of vehicle.
- Using a vehicle in a parking place in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of goods.

If you wish to appeal a Penalty Charge Notice issued to your vehicle, please follow the instructions on the reverse of the Penalty Charge Notice.

Where an issued Penalty Charge Notice remains unpaid after 28 days, we will contact the DVLA to obtain details of the current registered keeper of the vehicle in order to commence recovery proceedings.
