Dear Sir or Madam

I see that you are proposing to redesignate the former Friern Barnet Sewage treatment site (Pinkham Wood) from employment use to locally significant Industrial Use. I believe there would be no linked protection for the nature conservation value of the site if this happens.

I do not wish this redesignation to happen as I believe we would lose this ecologically beneficial site. In addition I believe it would leave the site open to development for heavy industrial use and as a local householder I am against the additional noise, pollution and congestion this would bring to our locale.

I do not feel there is any good evidence that this site should be redesignated and I do not believe that Haringey has properly considered whether this is the best course of action for this site and such an action doesn't fit with current national or regional policies. I would very much like to know why Haringey feels it should redesignate the site.
