## Consultation on the admission arrangements for 2024-2025 at Our Lady of Muswell Catholic Primary School

The Governing Body of Our Lady of Muswell invite you to view the proposed admissions policy for 2024-2025 as well as the Supplementary Information Form (SIF) 2024-2025. These documents are now out for consultation until the **17<sup>th</sup> January 2023**.

The school is proposing the following changes to its admission arrangements:

- The reduction of the published admission number (PAN) from 60 to 30 places – responding to the need to reduce the PAN across the Borough and low reception 22/23 admissions.
- The addition of “catechumens and members of an Eastern Christian Church” at criterion 4 and accompanying notes – as directed by the Diocese of Westminster (DoW).
- The addition of “siblings” at criterion 5 and the accompanying notes – to help bond the links between school and families by keeping siblings together.
- The addition of the phrase “where logistically possible” when admitting siblings from multiple births where one of the children is the last ranked child – to match the DoW model policy and as advised by them.
- The removal of the phrase children “from families” of other Christian denominations – as it is the faith of the child that is considered, not that of the family.

The following changes have been made to the notes, to aid clarity and move further in line with the DoW model policies:

- Definition of sibling
- Definition of home address
- Definition of “looked after” and “previously looked after” children
