Dear Ms Whelehan,

I am writing to you to make a strong protest at our Council's proposed re-designation of Pinkham Wood (formerly Friern Barnet Sewage Works) from one where you have purported to protect the site with a designation of Grade 1 listed Importance for its Biodiversity but where Employment is an option (EL) to one where you give it no protection at all (LSIS)

This major change would mean the borough would lose a valuable and ecologically rich site not only on its own but also would destroy a wildlife corridor linking Barnet with even Finsbury Park. As a volunteer in the borough I therefore deplore that you should ignore National Policy PPS9 para.9 (networks of natural habitats) and also regionally with Policy 7 in The London Plan (7.14 & 7.18-21).

I have already written to your Head of Planning in relation to this and other issues (28th June, and received not even an acknowledgement). I understand that, although you have stated that validation has been "put on hold", you are still going ahead. I therefore also deplore this

Council's attitude and request you do not go ahead with this re-designation.
