This street has witnessed many important trailblazers and change-makers who, rooted in their communities, went on to succeed in building some of the most successful black enterprises in this country. From Dyke & Dryden's beauty and hair products, becoming Britain's first black multi-million-pound business, to Althea McNish, the internationally-renowned textile designer and artist who made West Green Road her home for over 60 years, you can find out more about the stories of these pioneers and others – all starting out and finding their feet in West Green Road. This exhibition shares these histories and stories about West Green Road from the collections of Bruce Castle Museum & Archive. It also shows in public for the first-time personal items and works from the amazing art studio of textile designer Althea McNish – very kindly on loan from The N15 Archive (external link) – alongside new artwork created for the exhibition from local artist and architect Tania Pascoal.
