

# KRANKBROTHER

Dear Resident,

For the second year running, Sink the Pink returns to Finsbury Park. This letter is to give you some information about the weekend of events taking place in Finsbury Park on the Eastern carriageway adjacent to Green Lanes, on 17<sup>th</sup> / 18<sup>th</sup> August 2019, the steps being taken to minimise the impact of the events on local residents, and how to get in touch with the relevant people during the event period.

## General Event Information

Two events are taking place across the relevant weekend. On Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> August, Sink The Pink Festival (<https://sinkthepink.co.uk/>) takes place. This is an LGBTQ lead event with pop music, dancers and performers. On Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> August, krankbrother presents Peggy Gou takes place. This is another music event, with the predominant music being electronic in nature ([www.krankbrother.com](http://www.krankbrother.com)). Both events are produced & operated by krankbrother Limited.

The events attract an audience of all ages, but the bulk of whom are 24 - 35 years.

Each event day will be attended by up to 3,500 festival-goers, and we are committed to keeping any inconveniences to local residents to a minimum by working closely with Haringey Council and local stakeholders, and responding to residents' concerns. The Event Organisers will bring high-standard measures to Finsbury Park and its local residents, in order to build and maintain positive relationships.

## Park Occupation Dates & Times

Build days: 13 – 16th August  
Show days: 17<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> August  
De-rig days: 19<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> August

The site working hours during the event Build and De-rig periods are 8am - 8pm, and the Show-day curfew is 10.00pm on Sat 17<sup>th</sup> August and 09:30pm on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> August, as agreed by Haringey Council.

Following de-rig, the Festivals' organisers will ensure the Park is returned to its users and the Council cleaned to the best possible standard.

If you experience any problems during the event build, show days, or de-rig period, then please contact the management team on the dedicated **Residents' Line 07501 430073** for assistance. This number will be available over the Event's build and de-rig period from 8am-8pm daily, and on show days 17<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> August from 10am-11pm.

## Crowd Management

On show day, to support the safe egress of attendees from Finsbury Park to local stations, a crowd management operation will be in place. Fencing, stewards, and security staff will be positioned along routes to deter anti-social or nuisance behaviour.

## Toilets

Temporary toilets in key locations will be provided outside the event site, as agreed by Haringey Council, for festival-goers arriving/leaving the event. There will also be adequate toilet facilities inside the Festival's fence for the number of people attending.

## Noise

Soundchecks will be carried out on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> August at 10am. Further tests will take place on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> August at 10am.

Event times are Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> August from 1pm- 10pm and Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> August from 1pm – 9:30pm. Throughout the events, noise will be controlled to limits agreed with Haringey Council. A team of noise consultants will monitor levels from key locations around the park's perimeter and at noise sensitive properties.

If you have any concerns about the levels of noise generated during the event, in the first instance (and to enable the fastest response time from the event delivery team) you should contact the **Residents' Line on 07501 430073**.
