Dear LDF team,

I strongly object to Haringey's proposal to redesignate the former Friern Barnet sewage treatment site (Pinkham Wood) from EMPLOYMENT USE subject to 'no adverse impact' on the nature conservation value of the site, to **LOCALLY SIGNIFICANT INDUSTRIAL USE**.

- 17/11
1. There is no new evidence on why the site should be redesignated.
  2. Haringey could have made this into a local green space. It was used by residents as parkland until it was recently fenced off.
  3. Green spaces like this are a valuable resource and should be kept.
  4. The site cannot properly continue to hold a grade 1 nature designation, and also site of importance for nature conservation and at the same time be for **LOCALLY SIGNIFICANT INDUSTRIAL USE**.
