We wish to register our deep concern and objection to the intended change of designation of the Pinkham Way site from employment use to industrial ("employment land designations in SP8 Employment of the Core Strategy, change of land designation for DEA6 from employment land to locally significant industrial site"). This change is clearly intended to facilitate the use of the site for a development which we consider to be wholly inappropriate and potentially harmful to the surrounding area and the people who live there. We believe that previous attempts to consult the community were deliberately low key and inadequate.

The attempt to make the site available for a waste disposal plant must surely only have been considered because it is on the periphery of the Borough -perhaps it was thought no one would care or notice. That such a plant is being considered in an area close to housing and schools (I am a Governor of one of them) is truly mind boggling and will be resisted by people who live nearby and all those who care about the local environment. We care about protecting green spaces and communities and believe that both are at risk as a consequence of the proposed development. We care, too, about the responsible management of waste produced by our society. This scheme, however, is irresponsible and cynically inappropriate to the location.
