Dear Sir

Re: Haringey Core Strategy, consultation regarding Employment Land Designations changes, September 2011 I am writing as Chair of Governors of Hollickwood School, Sydney Road, N10, to object to the proposed change of designation of the Pinkham Wood site (former Friern Barnet Sewage Works) from Employment Use to Locally Significant Industrial Site.

It is of deep concern to those at this school that the change in designation would:

- a) Look to diminish the much-valued protection afforded to the site's natural environment as a Site of Importance for Nature Conservation
- b) facilitate an industrial use for the site that the local community of this family, residential area would find uncomfortable and unacceptable.

We particularly object to the redesignation at a time when the site is infamously being considered for an unpopular and highly-contested waste treatment plant. This change certainly facilitates such a development and we would argue that it shows unacceptable planning bias for such policy changes to be taking place whilst the waste plant proposals are very much in discussion. I hope these comments are of use to you.
