I have begun drafting my report on this examination, in as far as I am able without at this stage addressing the matters raised in the representations. However, I have realised that there appears to be some documentation missing from that submitted to support the Modified Draft Charging Schedule. This relates to the requirement to provide infrastructure planning evidence (see Planning Practice Guidance Paragraph: 017 Reference ID: 25-017-20190901 and Paragraph: 018 Reference ID: 25-018-20190901). As I understand it, The Community Infrastructure Levy, Amendment) (England) (No. 2) Regulations 2019 require the principal document to be the annual infrastructure funding statement, the first of which must be published by 31 December 2020. I am aware that the council has published this document, but it is not amongst the documentation provided to me.

Please provide this document with any additional comment that you wish to make. Since this should be very straightforward, I hope to have a reply by Friday 19 November.
