



## Haringey Adult Learning Service English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) offer

We have a range of **English Second Language courses** to suit you.

Our classes take place in a range of settings including schools, children's centres and libraries including Wood Green Library, St Anne's Library and Marcus Garvey Library.

We also offer **remote online courses** for those who cannot attend on site courses.

### **You also have the opportunity to take part in our extra curricula enrichment programme including:**

- Accessing computers in the various libraries
- Attending Wednesday lunchtime talks
- Receiving 1:1 individual career coaching at higher levels
- External visits to places of interest in and around Haringey
- Attending spelling and grammar workshops
- Taking part in a reading group
- Conversation classes

All of our classes support you to **improve your IT skills** as well as **develop your employability skills**, at a range of levels.

## English Speakers of Other Languages Classes

We have two types of delivery, one day a week or two days a week depending on how often you are able to study each week.

### Pre-Entry

This class is for learners who may use a different alphabet – a non-Roman script e.g. Arabic, Bulgarian or Japanese.

### Entry 1

This class is for learners who can say their name and address and can write the alphabet.

### Entry 2

This class is for learners who can introduce themselves and can describe their daily routine and likes and dislikes.

### Entry 3

This class is for learners who can talk and write about events in the past, present and future. They use adjectives in sentences to give more information and are able to use formal language appropriately.

### Level 1

This class is for learners who can write accurately about events in the past, present and future and can hold a conversation at an advanced level.

### Level 2

This class is for learners who can analyse, recount events accurately and give an opinion, give clear concise information about their future plans.

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## Employability qualifications

The course is at **two levels**: the Award and the full Certificate and is accredited by NCFE.

It is portfolio completion and there is the opportunity to do small project work, increase your digital IT skills and demonstrate work competencies.

These qualifications focus on a range of skills that employers ask for including:

- Working as part of a Team
- Understanding Mindset
- Communication Skills
