












Chlamydia proportion aged 15-24 screened




HIV testing coverage, total (%)



New HIV diagnosis rate / 100,000 aged 15+




Population vaccination coverage - HPV (%) (PHOF indicator 3.03xii)







Total prescribed LARC excluding injections rate / 1,000








Under 25s repeat abortions (%)




Sexual offences rate / 1,000 (PHOF indicator 1.12iii)






Chlamydia detection rate / 100,000 aged 15-24 (PHOF indicator 3.02)




Chlamydia detection rate / 100,000 aged 15-24 (PHOF indicator 3.02) (Female)









Chlamydia detection rate / 100,000 aged 15-24 (PHOF indicator 3.02) (Male)




Chlamydia proportion aged 15-24 screened

Genital herpes diagnosis rate / 100,000














Antenatal infectious disease screening – HIV coverage (PHOF indicator 2.21i) Region only








Proportion of TB cases offered an HIV test (TB Strategy Monitoring Indicators)




Population vaccination coverage - HPV (%) (PHOF indicator 3.03xii)








Under 18s conceptions leading to abortion (%)





Under 18s births rate / 1,000






Under 18s alcohol-specific hospital admissions rate / 100,000








16-18 year olds not in education employment or training (%) (PHOF indicator 1.05)








New HIV diagnosis rate / 100,000 aged 15+
