### Dates for the diary 2018/19 academic year

The Healthy Schools programme offers the opportunity to develop a focus on health and wellbeing to support the attainment, achievement and happiness of pupils, staff and wider school communities. The programme is coordinated by Public Health, Haringey Council, and the Mayor of London.

**Networks** take place on a termly basis, and are open to school staff who are working towards the Healthy Schools programme. Partnership work across different sectors is key to the success of the Healthy Schools programme, and therefore a variety of other professionals also attend the networks (including School Nursing, Haringey Obesity Alliance, Oral Health promotion, Public Health, Smarter Travel, and many more). The purpose of the networks are to:

- Gain the latest information on health and wellbeing in schools, and current projects that schools can get involved with
- Share creative ideas with other school staff who lead on the Healthy Schools programme
- Network with professionals from a range of different agencies, to identify how their expertise can support schools to become Healthy Schools

**Silver award workshops** are aimed at staff who lead on the Healthy Schools programme and wish to achieve the Healthy Schools Silver award. The one-off sessions provide advice and guidance on creating a needs analysis, ideas for an effective action plan, and how to write a successful application for the Silver award.
