I am a Haringey resident, and write to you now to to register my deep concerns about plans for an industrial scale waste processing plant at Pinkham Way. In particular, I object to the inclusion of a change of land designation for DEA6 from employment land to locally significant industrial site in the Core Strategy on the grounds that:

1. The suitability of using the site for industrial use when it has been previously listed as green space that should be protected
2. The environmental impact of using the site for industrial use, particularly when the site is very close to a built up residential area and local schools
3. The limited consultation that has been carried out and Haringey Council's failure to adequately consult local people and inform them of the re-consultation
