Dear Haringey Council

I am writing to express concern at your plans regarding for the change of designation for the site on Pinkham Way.

It is my understanding that the updated Sustainability Appraisal produced by Hyder Consulting UK Limited failed to provide further evidence in support of this re-designation and on the contrary pointed out its threat to the biodiversity of the site. In areas and communities already blighted by the North Circular, it seems to me that Haringey should have considered whether this redesignation was the most appropriate strategy against alternatives such as Green Grid cross boundary green space connecting Barnet, Haringey and Enfield. The LSIS designation is only deliverable if the Grade 1 Borough Importance for Nature designation is removed or substantially compromised. The Council's own additional evidence points out in relation to the Friern Barnet site in particular that any development on the site has potential to have biodiversity impacts because it is a Site of Importance for Nature Conservation (p6 of [Hyder Addendum SA](#)). Clearly, the bigger the development the bigger the impact.
