

## Session: My Street, My Town, My Region ...

Apx Session Length: 50 Mins

Topic/Aims:	To raise awareness and widen student knowledge on the availability of different jobs outside of the local area
Learning Outcomes:	To identify which jobs are available locally, regionally and nationally To identify the types of jobs available
In class activity:	Group activity to pinpoint locations of jobs on a map Group discussion
Resources:	Maps of Greater London for each group of students A selection of job vacancy or apprenticeship vacancies from across London PowerPoint presentation "Key Regional Facts"

### My Town, My Street, My Region - Introduction

There is literally a world of jobs out there. Young people who grew up in Haringey are now working all over the world. Sometimes this is for a period of time and sometimes this means moving forever. Other people commute every day to jobs in other London boroughs as well as into The City or the Centre of London. Local people have also started businesses that trade all over the world. There are lots of jobs and types of jobs in Haringey and its surrounding boroughs, but it is also true that the further afield you go, the more jobs there are and the more different types of job. Being within easy travelling distance of The City and Central London means most jobs are within your grasp, due to your excellent location and the ease of travel.

5 mins	Icebreaker: Students are asked to brainstorm someone they know who has either left Haringey altogether to work somewhere else or commutes every day.  The group see how far the furthest person has gone. 20 mins	Introduce activity: Split students into small groups and give each a map sheet of Greater London region  Ask them first to make a list of jobs that are in the same street or very near to school (don't forget the jobs that are in school)  Students then mark on the map a two mile radius of school and list the jobs that are possible.  The group then needs to list jobs you can't do in the London area e.g. Deep Sea Diver,  Group to nominate person to feedback	Group activity followed by group discussion and feedback	To identify which jobs are available locally, regionally and nationally	Ensure all are involved in this activity by talking to those who may not understand what is expected of them	Maps of Greater London region
