Subject: redesignation of former Friern Barnet Sewage Treatment Works for industrial use

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to object to the redesignation of the former Friern Barnet Sewage works site from employment to Local Industrial use. It does not appear that Haringey Council has consulted about this, or considered other designations for the site, which would conserve eco systems and the local environment.

The loss of the caveat to protect the nature conservation is a major change to the status of this site. A consequence would be the likely loss of this valuable nature conservation site, which is one of only nine sites designated Grade 1 of Borough Importance for Nature Conservation.

A change of designation would widen the range of uses on the site to include heavy industrial type uses, with all the potential noise, pollution and traffic congestion impacting upon the local environment.

Inevitably re-designation would mean the site would become vulnerable to Policy 4.4 of the London Plan, which directs local authorities in London to identify Locally Significant Industrial Sites which might be suitable for waste management. The significant local opposition to such a use should be noted.
