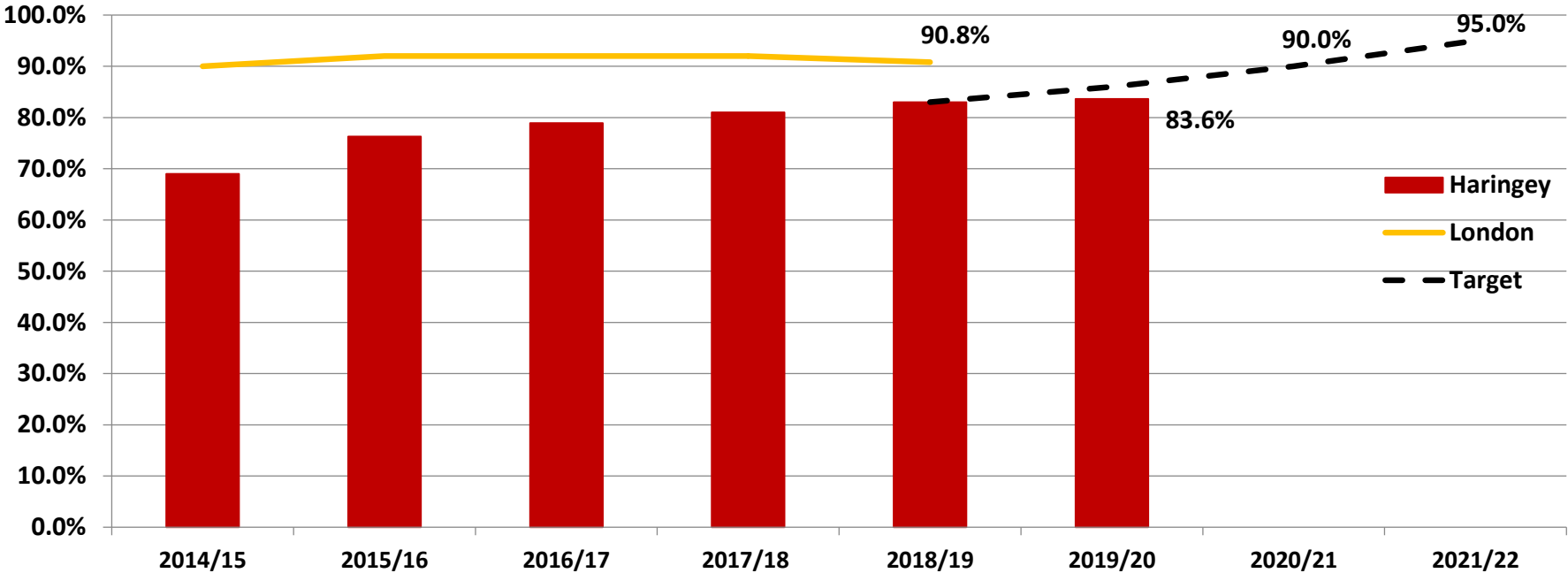

Percentage of council homes meeting the Decent Homes standard

Target: 95% by 2022



At the end of the 2018/19 financial year Homes for Haringey had achieved its target of 83% of residences meeting the Decent Homes standard.

In 2018/19 the London average for Decent Homes declined slightly to 92% as components that were installed as part of the original Decent Homes programmes reach the end of their working lifespan. There is a wide variance in the number of Decent Homes properties across London, with some boroughs having levels as low as 50%.

At the end of Q2 2019/20 the Decent Homes figure for Haringey properties was 83.6%. Final data for 2019/20 is not available at this time; this indicator will be updated once further information is available and until then will maintain its green amber status.
