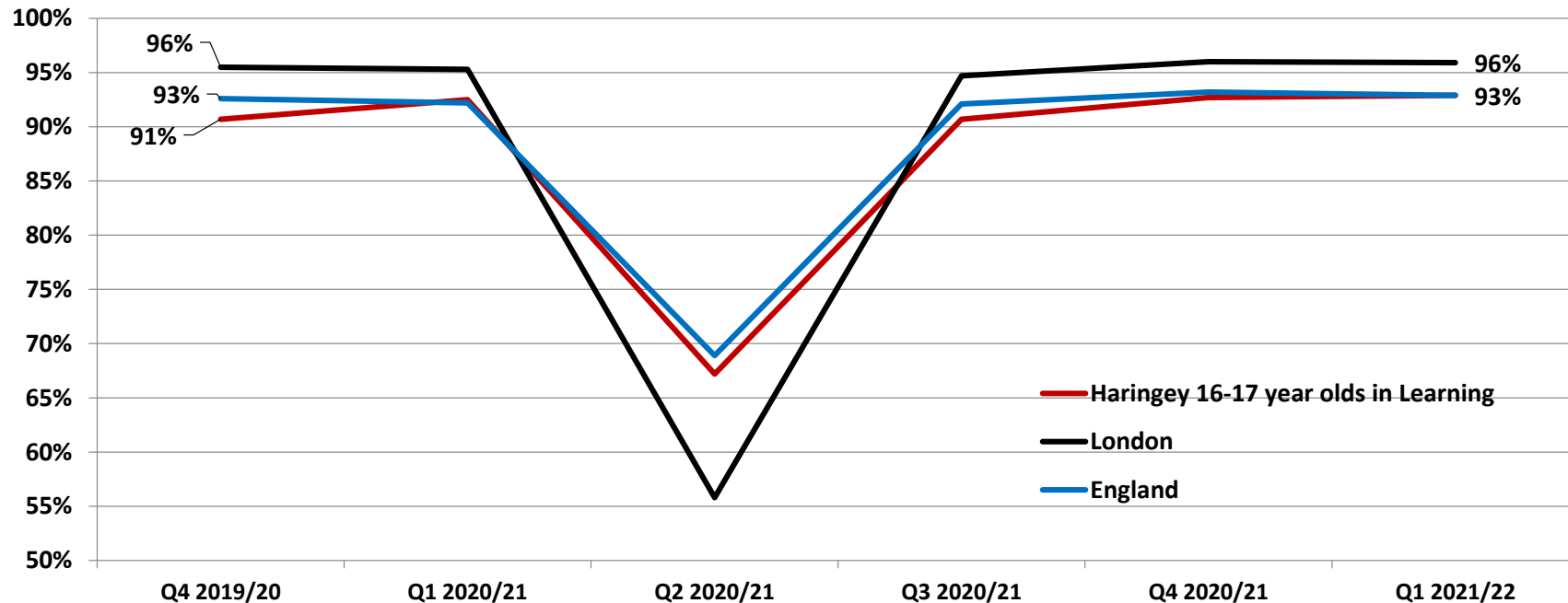


## Outcome 6

Percentage of young people aged 16-17 in education, employment or training (EET) *NB 16-24 year old data is only published at regional level and not at Local Authority level*

Target: To be above the London average by 2022



At the end of June 2021, 93% of young people in Haringey were in Education Employment or Training. This was amongst the lowest in London and our ambition is to be above the London average (currently 96.0%) by 2022. This is rated as RED, as we are below the London average.

We have now set up a working group to review the way we identify, track and support young people who are not in education, employment or training and aim to complete this by the Autumn. Key factors relating to our current performance which we need to address include:

- our capacity to track those young people whose activity is unknown;
- our capacity to provide them with effective information, advice and guidance about learning, training and employment opportunities;
- and that we ensure that schools are sharing young people's destinations with us in a timely way.
