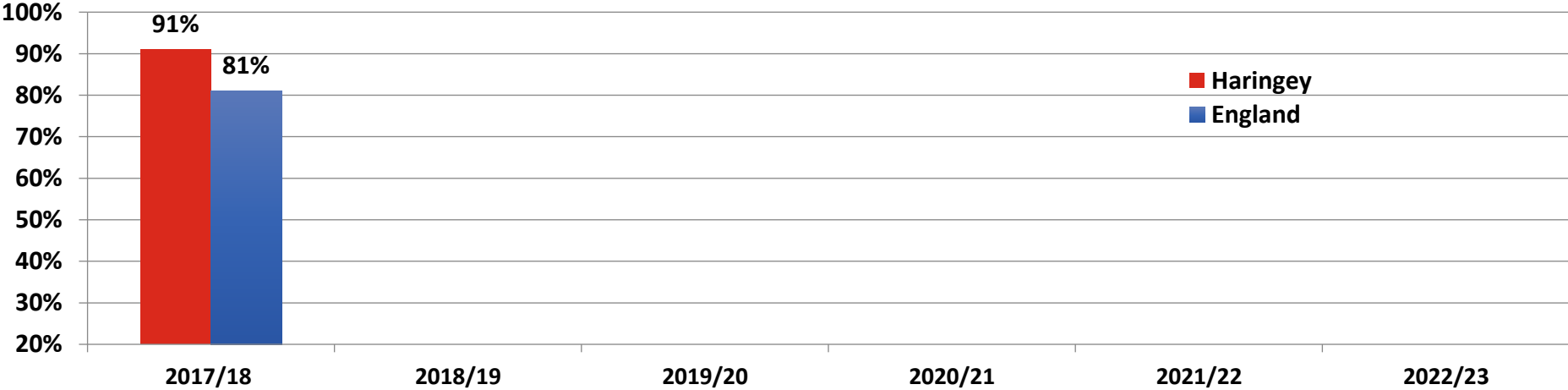

Target: Improvement from 2018 level



We have now established the Haringey Together Citizens’ Panel, with the purpose of ensuring that all Haringey residents, wherever they live in the borough and whatever their background, are given a platform to talk to us about what matters to them. This has been used since mid-2020 to run regular, online surveys that have enabled us to gather resident perspectives on a range of topics, from the impact of coronavirus to their work, finances, and the local economy. We have also used the Citizens’ Panel to provide updates to residents on the work of our strategic partners, and to inform them of statutory consultations being undertaken in the borough.

Future plans for the Citizens’ Panel include using it to undertake more detailed, deliberative engagement with members which will generate insights that build on and add depth to the feedback generated through ongoing surveys as well as increase residents’ understanding of our services. The development of a dedicated Citizens’ Panel webpage, which is planned for 2021-2022, will also provide us with a dedicated space to disseminate information about our services and benefits more widely, also providing a forum through which members will be able to interact with us more easily and flexibly.
