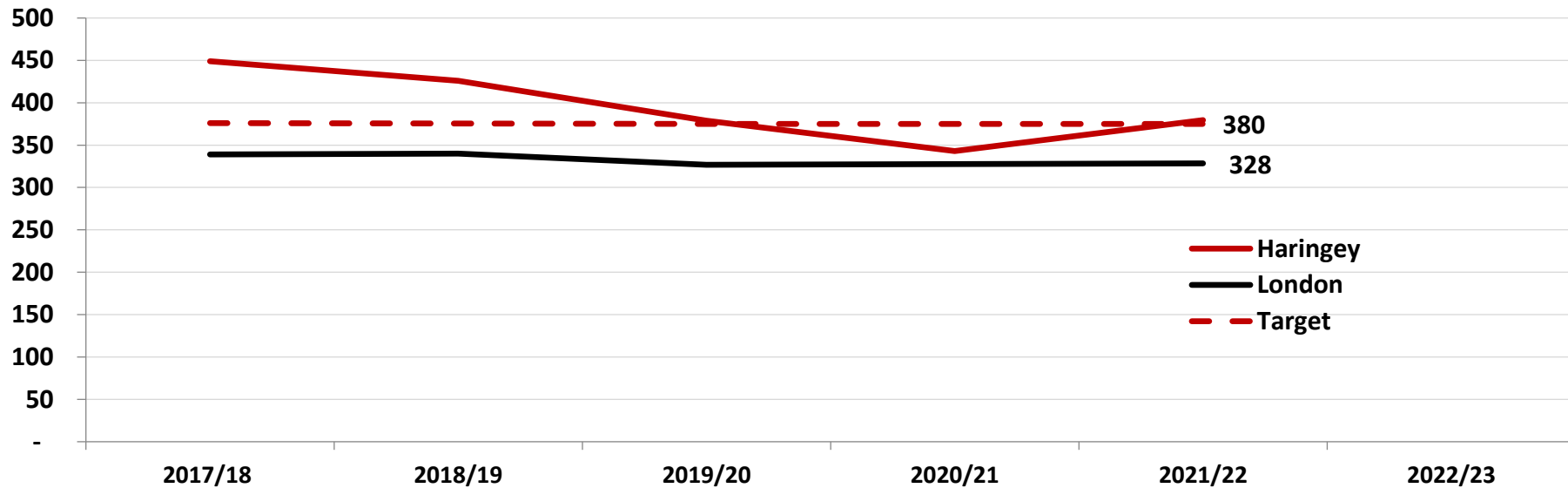


Outcome 8

Domestic abuse: violence with injury

Red

Target: Reduction in the rate per 100,000 16+ population from 2017/18 baseline



Data from the Metropolitan Police indicates that in 2020/21 795 incidents of domestic abuse were recorded in Haringey, an annual equivalent of 343 per 100,000 of the 16+ population. Unfortunately, but not unsurprisingly, the Quarter 1 figures are showing an increasing rate of domestic abuse offenses which has risen above the target to 380 per 100,000 population. This is higher than the London rate of 328 and is now higher than our 2017/18 baseline target of 375 incidents per 100,000 population, as such progress against this outcome has been rated Red having previously been rated as on track to reduce the rate to below the 2017/18 baseline.

Work to secure a BAME domestic abuse service and a mental health domestic abuse service, to support the existing DA services available in the borough has started. The VAWG Team are also scoping a mapping of all existing DA/VAWG training in the council and how this can be delivered across departments jointly.
