What if we...

1 Narrow the road to make it safer for pedestrians.

2 New planting to filter rain water and create a greener route along Park Lane to the Lee Valley.

3 New drop kerbs for level crossings for wheelchair or buggy users.

4 Potential for a new seating area to meet and greet friends and family

5 New clear signage showing route through station to Lee Valley.



6 New tree and street greening marking the eastern entrance to the station.

7 Improved fence and planting to prevent littering.

8 New even paving making it easier to cross the road.

9 New lighting will be introduced to make a safer and more welcoming environment
