<b>A Welcoming Place</b>	The Judges found the site to be very welcoming	
<b>Healthy, Safe and Secure</b>	The Judges felt secure and appreciated the actions taken for the anti-social issues in the park	The Environmental play area has little play value this should be considered when this area is reviewed in the future. The toddlers area needs edge treatment as in other sites.
<b>Well Maintained and Clean</b>	The site overall looked neat and tidy during the Judges visit.	The shrub beds at the entrance needs gapping up, perhaps wire in if there are issues. Paths need re tarmacking in places. Consider rotating football goal post to ease wear. There is Contractor damage to grass areas where they have driven across it. Engage the Contractor with the management plan. There was some dog fouling on the site.
<b>Environmental Management</b>	There is no chemical or peat use on the site.	
<b>Biodiversity Landscape and Heritage</b>		Consider how you could increase the diversity of the site .

<b>Community Involvement</b>	There is some interest shown through gardening on the site.	There is a need to engage more with the community so that it's not just one person.
<b>Marketing and Communication</b>	Good use of social media	The Judges think the site will definitely benefit from the new notice board planned.
<b>Management</b>	The Judges felt this was a nice neat site which needs some targets to aspire to which will ensure ongoing development and maintenance.
