## Consultation on the admission arrangements for 2024 - 2025 at St Martin of Porres Catholic Primary School

The Governing Body of the Federation of St Paul and St Martin of Porres Catholic Primary Schools invite you to view the proposed admissions policy of St Martin of Porres Catholic Primary School for 2024-2025 as well as the Supplementary Information Form (SIF) 2024-2025. These documents are now out for consultation until the **6th January 2023**.

The school is proposing the following changes to its admission arrangements:

- Criterion 5 of the oversubscription criteria that reads “Children of catechumens and members of an Eastern Christian Church” to be moved to criterion 4 and criterion 4 of the oversubscription criteria that reads “Children of staff employed for 2 years or more and/or a member of staff recruited to fill a vacancy for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage” to be moved to criterion 5.  
This change is made to comply with advice from the Education Department of the Diocese of Westminster.
- On the Supplementary Information Form information about the parish in which an applicant lives is to be removed.  
This change is made as parish information is no longer relevant to the oversubscription criteria.
- On the Supplementary Information Form information about the church or place of worship attended by the applicant is to be removed.  
This change is made as this information is no longer relevant to the oversubscription criteria.
