| Health, Safety & Security | This is well covered, it is interesting to see that you have teams who look for how to design out issues | There needs to be more clarity on how you monitor and validate what the person inspects when they are dealing with play equipment. |
| Maintenance of equipment, buildings & landscape | This is comprehensively covered in the plan. | See table tennis comment. As you have amalgamated the operations and commissioning your need to address how will you be carrying out such a detailed monitoring. |
