The Haringey (Prescribed Routes) (No. 13) Traffic Order 2021

Made: 1 April 2021


Coming into operation: 8 April 2021

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of powers conferred by section 6 and 124 and Part IV to Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 8 April 2021 and may be cited as The Haringey (Prescribed Routes) (No. 13) Traffic Order 2021.
1. In this Order:-

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
2. Whilst this Order continues in force and without prejudice to the validity to anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any Act or any omission before the coming into operation of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle:-
 - (a) proceeding in Albert Road, N22 to enter or proceed in the length of Albert Road that lies south of the triangular island site fronting Nos. 191 to 217 Albert Road and to prohibit vehicles from travelling in a direction other than from east to west in that length of road;
 - (b) to make a 'U-turn' in Durnsford Road, N11 between its junction with Crescent Rise and a point 100 yards south-west of that junction.
3. Nothing in this order shall apply:-
 - (a) to any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes
 - (b) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
 - (c) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
4. 'The Haringey (Prescribed Routes) (No. 5) Traffic Order 2010' is hereby revoked, the restrictions contained within the aforementioned order shall continue in force by virtue of this order.
