TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Haringey (Seven Sisters CPZ) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2021

Made: 4 June 2021

Coming into force: 10 June 2021

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of powers conferred by section 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on 10 June 2021 and may be cited as The Haringey (Seven Sisters CPZ) (Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3) Order 2021.

Interpretation

2. (a) In this Order “the Order of 2010” means The Haringey (Seven Sisters CPZ) (Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2010(b).
- (b) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- (c) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2010 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Amendment to the Order of 2010

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2010 shall have effect as though the items numbered 96 in Schedule 1 to that Order is deleted and replaced with the items numbered 96 in the Schedule to this Order;

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2010 thereto

4. (a) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of the street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a minimum width throughout of 1.8 metres is designated as a parking place.
- (b) The provisions of the Order of 2010 (other than Articles 4 and 14) shall apply to each area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to each area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2010 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

5. The Council shall:
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of the parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;

- (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving either of vehicles specified in the Article 6 to the Order of 2010; and
- (c) carry out such other work as is reasonably required by the Order of 2010 or by this Order for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of the parking place designated by this Order.

SCHEDULE (see Article 4)

IN RELATION TO A PARKING PLACE REFERRED TO IN THIS SCHEDULE THE EXPRESSION "PERMITTED HOURS" MEANS THE PERIOD BETWEEN 8.00 A.M. AND 6.30 P.M. ON MONDAYS TO SATURDAYS INCLUSIVE, ANY SUCH DAY NOT BEING CHRISTMAS DAY, GOOD FRIDAY OR A BANK HOLIDAY.

PARKING PLACES IN WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IF IT DISPLAYS A VALID RESIDENTS' PERMIT OR VISITORS' PERMIT OR ESSENTIAL SERVICE PERMIT OR SHORT STAY ESSENTIAL SERVICE PERMIT.
