EARLSMEAD ROAD N15 – INSTALLATION OF VEHICLE CROSSOVERS AND AMENDMENT TO PARKING PROVISION

THE HARINGEY (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 11) ORDER 2021 AND THE HARINGEY (SEVEN SISTERS CPZ) (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey on 4 June 2021 has made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The general effect of the Order: To remove an existing resident permit holder parking space outside No. 12 Earlsmead Road N17 and replace it with single yellow line waiting restrictions operating at zone hours in order to facilitate the installation of vehicle a crossover outside of this property.

Date of operation: The Order will come into operation on 10 June 2021.

Application to the high court: Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it does not comply with the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
