Maintenance of equipment, buildings & landscape	There is clear reference to who is responsible for the various activities that are needed to maintain the site. There are clear objectives to ensure the maintenance of the site is an ongoing commitment.	
Litter, cleanliness, vandalism	There are regular litter collections scheduled. There is also a plan to removed dogs bins and for dog waste to be put into the general waste in the future.	Consider how you might advise the users of this change before it happens.

Environmental Management	The environmental management of the site is well supported by the friends of group and Tottenham Green market.	
Biodiversity, Landscape and Heritage	There has been considerable investment to ensure the war memorial is conserved for the future and this is also supported by ongoing activities to ensure the memorial is maintained.	
Community Involvement	There is very good community involvement both with the friends of group and the market. These provide a number of events for the users of the site.	
Marketing & Communication	The marketing and communication for the site falls into the approach for all sites in Haringey and uses a wide variety of media to reach its audience.	
Overall management	The management plan is a comprehensive document that covers all aspects of the site.
