THE HARINGEY (CROSS LANE & HIGH STREET N8) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council of the London Borough of Haringey has made the Temporary Traffic Order(s) described below under S14(1) Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (the Act):-

THE GENERAL EFFECT OF THE ORDER:

1. To temporarily close 1) **Cross Lane N8**: From its junction with High Street, north to the (northern) development access gate on Cross Lane. 2) **High Street N8 (arm fronting properties 53-67)**: From the shared property boundary of No.59/No.61 to the western kerb-line of Cross Lane.
2. To temporarily introduce No Waiting/No Loading at any time restrictions and suspend all parking restrictions on both sides of 1) **Cross Lane N8**: From its junction with High Street, north to the (northern) development access gate on Cross Lane. 2) **High Street N8 (arm fronting properties 53-67)**: From the shared property boundary of No.59/No.61 to the western kerb-line of Cross Lane.

The alternative route will be via High Street, New River Avenue, Cross Lane and vice versa.

The temporary order is due to come into effect on 25 October 2021 to 31 March 2022 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting and is required while footway and carriageway paving works are undertaken as part of S278 Project. It should be noted that these dates are on the proviso that no objections are received to the associated permanent scheme and will be cancelled accordingly should objections be received.

The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021' and 'The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021' will be temporarily amended as detailed in point 2 above.

The provisions of this order shall apply only at such times and as directed by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
