**THE HARINGEY (ST ANNS ROAD & FRINTON ROAD N15) TEMPORARY WAITING & LOADING  
RESTRICTIONS ORDER 2021**



The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2021 and may be cited as the Haringey (St Anns Road & Frinton Road N15) Temporary Waiting & Loading Restrictions Order 2021
2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to: -
  - (a) enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
  - (b) wait, load or unload in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule other than those vehicles exempted from such restrictions specified in column 2 to that Schedule;
3. Whilst this Order is in force, any parking place, loading bay, bus stop, bus stand, bus lane, cycle lane or pedestrian crossing located in a length of road specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order shall be suspended during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule.
4. 'The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021' and 'The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021' are hereby temporarily amended as detailed in Article 2(b) and 3 to this Order.
5. The prohibitions and restrictions specified in articles 2 and 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
6. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply to: -
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the works;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (c) any vehicle exempted from the restrictions as defined in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order;
  - (d) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a civil enforcement officer;
  - (e) any vehicle requiring ingress to, and egress from, a property in a prohibited length of road, if the works allow.
7. The Order may continue in force for up to 18 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.

**Schedule 1 – Road Closure**

<b>Dates and Times</b>	<b>Lengths of Roads</b>
Date: 25 <sup>th</sup> October 2021 to 5 <sup>th</sup> November 2021	Frinton Road from its junction with St Anns Road, south west for 27 metres.

**Schedule 2 – Suspensions & Introduction of No Waiting/No Loading at Any Time**

<b>Dates and Times</b>	<b>Lengths of Roads</b>
Date: 25 <sup>th</sup> October 2021 to 5 <sup>th</sup> November 2021	<p>Suspension of parking at following locations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) St Anns Road – outside no. 59 – 67 inclusive</li><li>2) Frinton road – adjacent to no. 47 St Anns Road (15m from north to south) and adjacent to no. 49 St Anns Road (15m from north to south).</li></ol> <p>No parking/waiting/loading/unloading.</p>
