THE HARINGEY (FOOTPATH 122, HARINGEY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE) ORDER 2022


Made: 2nd March 2022

Coming into force: 7th March 2022

The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain footpath in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those footpath and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 7th March 2022 and may be cited as the Haringey (Footpath 122, Haringey) (Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2022.
2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall proceed in the lengths of footpath specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
3. The prohibitions and restrictions specified in article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. The Order may continue in force for up to 6 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.
