**THE HARINGEY (ALEXANDRA PALACE) (SPECIAL EVENTS) (RED BULL SOAPBOX DERBY)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2022**


Made: 28th June 2022

Coming into operation: 1st July 2022

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that borough is satisfied that traffic on those roads should be prohibited by reason of a special event and in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st July 2022 and may be cited as the Haringey (Alexandra Palace) (Special Events) (Red Bull Soapbox Derby) Traffic Order 2022.
2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to: -
 - (a) enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
 - (b) wait, load or unload in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule other than those vehicles exempted from such restrictions specified in column 2 to that Schedule;
3. Whilst this Order is in force, any parking place, loading bay, bus stop, bus stand, bus lane, cycle lane or pedestrian crossing located in a length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order shall be suspended during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule.
4. 'The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021' and 'The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021' are hereby temporarily amended as detailed in Article 2(b) and 3 to this Order.
5. The prohibitions specified in articles 2 and 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
6. Nothing in this Order shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the said event;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes in an emergency;
 - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden.

Schedule 1 – Road Closure

Operational dates	General Effect of Order
01/07/2022 00:00 until 04/07/2022 16:00	Road closure of Alexandra Palace Way/South Terrace N22 - The entire length through the park.
03/07/2022 15:00 – 19:00	Road closure of Bedford Road N22 - from the boundary of Alexandra Palace way along its length until the roundabout with Palace Gate Road roundabout.
