

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1) – TTMO31**

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey intends to make the Temporary Traffic Order described below:-

<b>Chesnut Road N17 (Mulally &amp; Co Limited)</b>	
<b>Reason for 14(1) Order – To allow access for new construction site</b>	
<p><b>Dates:</b> Thurs 6<sup>th</sup> April 2023 to Thurs 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023 <b>Times:</b> 24hrs</p> <p><b><u>Agreed Site Working Arrangements</u></b></p> <p>Deliveries can be undertaken during school holidays as per agreed timings, and will be monitored: 06:30 – 07:30 vehicles can enter site</p> <p>Additional deliveries can be undertaken between 17<sup>th</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> August between 08:00 and 09:30 and between 15:30 and 18:00</p> <p>At all other times outside of school holiday periods the HGV extended delivery timings should apply: Deliveries can enter site before 07:00</p> <p>Within the HGV extended timings (outside of school holiday periods) there can be:</p> <p>During School Term:- Number of vehicles undertaking deliveries to be limited as per agreed working arrangements.</p>	<p><b>General Effect of Order</b></p> <p>Chesnut Road N17, suspension of parking between its junction with Hamilton Close and the north-eastern boundary of No. 1 Fairbanks Road.</p> <p>Parking suspension required to allow free movement of HGV to and from site in Hamilton Close</p> <p>No waiting/loading/unloading</p>

The provisions of the Order shall apply only at such times and as directed by traffic signs. For road closures, alternative routes will be directed by traffic signs.
