

# HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: ALEXANDRA

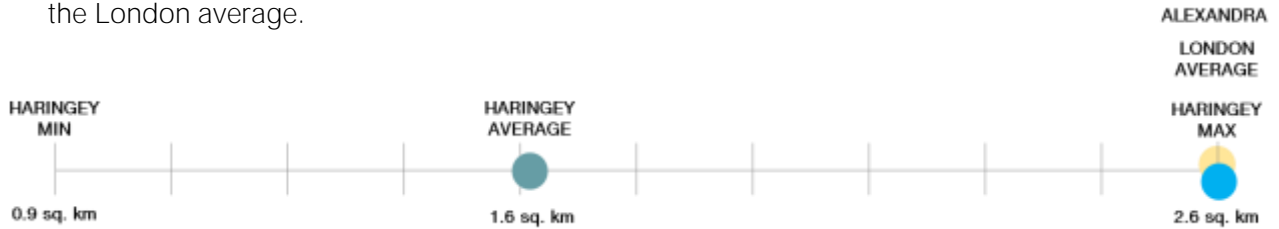

# ATTRIBUTES

## SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), ALEXANDRA

- Alexandra is the largest ward in Haringey, covering 2.6 sq. km.
- Although Alexandra ward is more than 50% larger than the average Haringey ward, it is in line with the London average.

## POPULATION, ALEXANDRA

- Alexandra has the fourth smallest population of all Haringey wards, at 11,578 residents.
- Alexandra has a smaller population than the average Haringey (14,243) or London (13,919) ward.

## POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), ALEXANDRA

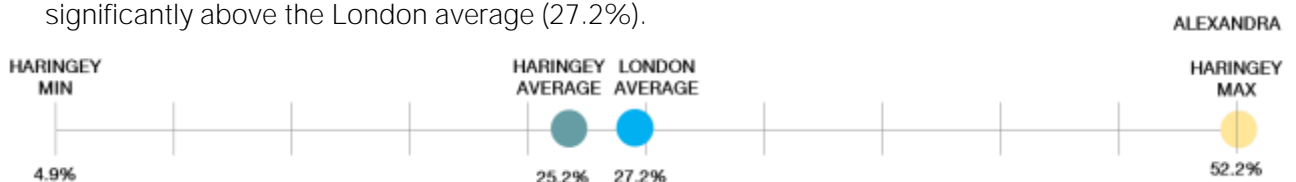
- Alexandra has the second smallest population density of all Haringey wards, at 4,364 residents per sq. km.
- This is less than half the Haringey average (9,945) and substantially below the London average (8,742).

## OPEN SPACE, ALEXANDRA

- 52.2% of Alexandra ward is made up of open space. Alexandra has the highest percentage of open space in Haringey.
- The proportion of open space in Alexandra is over twice the Haringey average (25.2%), and is also significantly above the London average (27.2%).

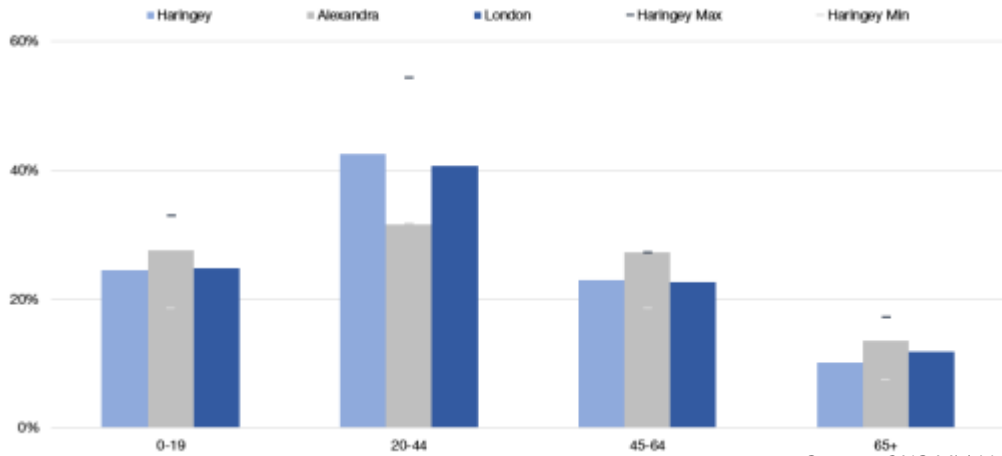

# DEMOGRAPHICS

## POPULATION AGE, ALEXANDRA

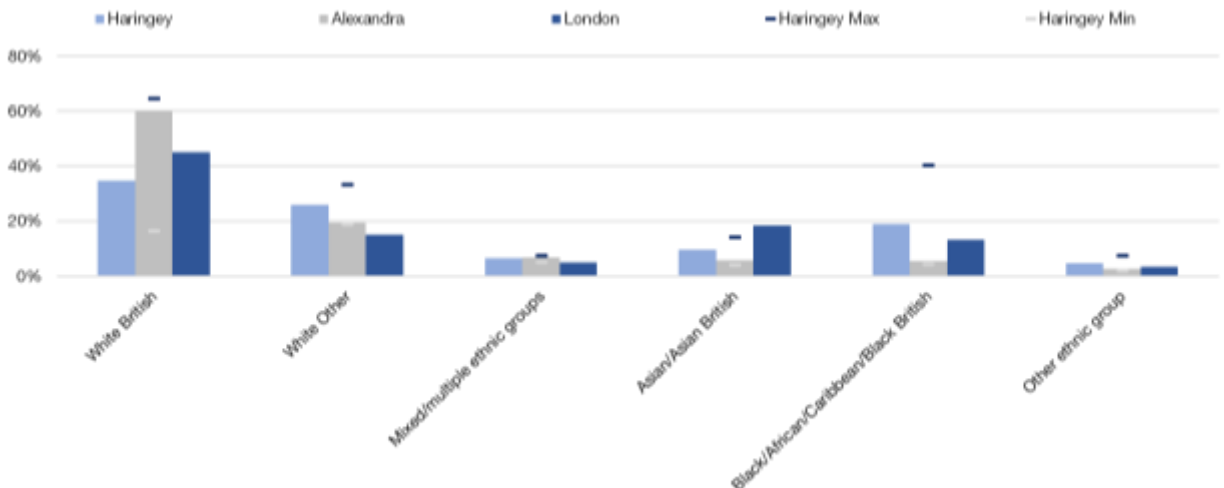
- Alexandra's overall population spread is in line with Haringey more widely, with the largest proportion of residents being aged 45-64 and the smallest proportion aged 20-44.
- However, Alexandra has a broadly older population compared to other Haringey wards, with a larger than average proportion of residents aged 45-64 (27.2%, the largest proportion in the borough) and a larger than average proportion aged 65+ (13.6%).
- The 20-44 population is also particularly under-represented in Alexandra (31.6%, the lowest proportion in the borough) in comparison to Haringey (42.5%) and London (40.7%) .

## ETHNICITY, ALEXANDRA

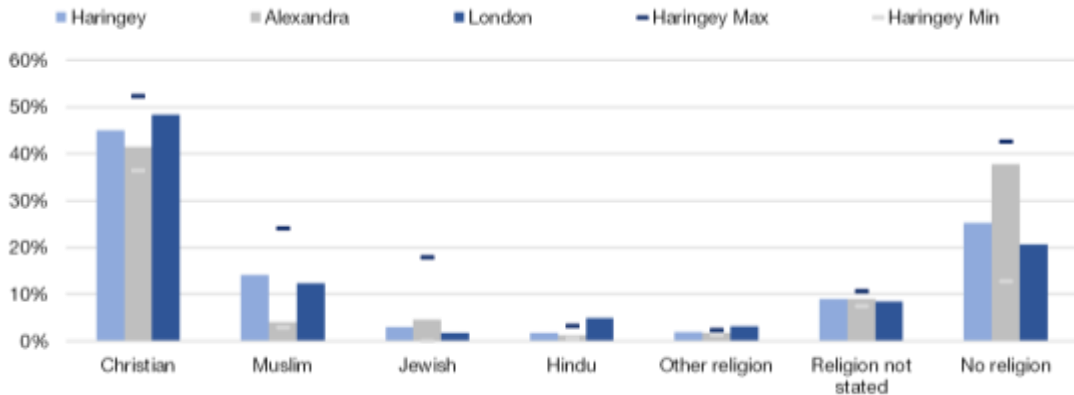
- Alexandra has a larger than average proportion of residents whose ethnicity is White British (60%), compared to the wider Haringey population (34.7%). This is the major ethnic group in Alexandra.
- Those of White Other, Asian and Black ethnicity are under-represented in Alexandra, compared to other Haringey wards.

## RELIGION, ALEXANDRA

- Compared to the rest of Haringey, Alexandra has a larger than average proportion of residents identifying as having no religion (37.8%), and among the smallest proportion of Muslim residents in Haringey (4.2%).

## EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

### % PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, ALEXANDRA

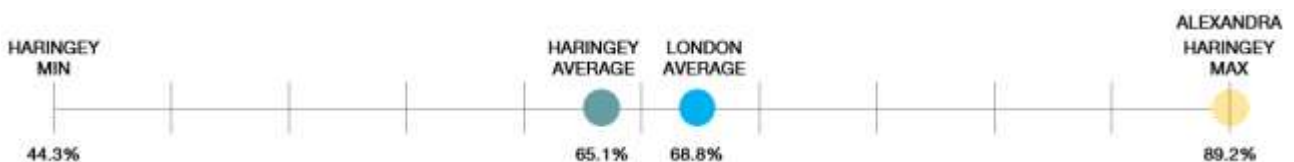
- Alexandra has the third largest proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 of all Haringey wards, at 85%.
- Alexandra pupils are considerably more likely to meet the expected standards at KS2 compared to the Haringey (67.4%) and London (71.4%) averages.

### % PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, ALEXANDRA

- In Alexandra, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (89.2%) is significantly higher than the Haringey and London averages (65.1% and 68.8% respectively).
- Alexandra has the highest proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs in Haringey.

## % QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, ALEXANDRA

- In Alexandra, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (68.3%) is above the level seen in Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%). This is the fifth highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- There is substantial variation in qualification levels between different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

## INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

### MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, ALEXANDRA

- The median household income in Alexandra is £51,450 a year. This is the 4<sup>th</sup> highest income level in Haringey, and is substantially higher than the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages.

### UNEMPLOYMENT, ALEXANDRA

- 5.1% of Alexandra's residents are unemployed. This is below both the Haringey (8.5%) and London (7.3%) averages, and is amongst the lowest levels of unemployment in the borough.

## CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), ALEXANDRA

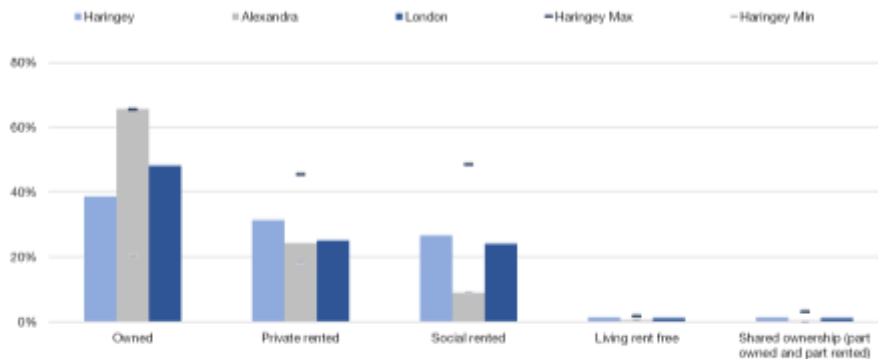
- Alexandra has the third lowest rate of claimants who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed, at 112.3 per 10,000 residents. This is significantly below the London (201.7) and Haringey (251.8) rates.
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

## HOUSING TENURE, ALEXANDRA

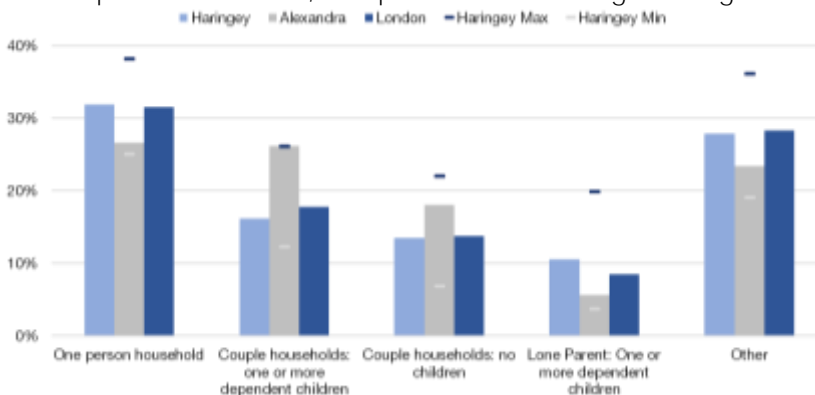
- In Alexandra, two thirds of households (65.7%) are lived in by the homeowner. This is the largest proportion of all Haringey wards.
- In Alexandra there is an under-representation of socially rented households. 9% of Alexandra households fall into this category, the lowest proportion of all Haringey wards and around a third of the Haringey average (26.7%).

## HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, ALEXANDRA

- In Alexandra, over one in four households are Couple households with one or more dependent children (26.2%). This is the largest proportion of all Haringey wards.
- In Alexandra households are less likely to be One person households or Lone parent households with one or more dependent children, compared to the borough average.

# HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

## FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, ALEXANDRA

- Female life expectancy in Alexandra is 86.2 years, above the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages.

## MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, ALEXANDRA

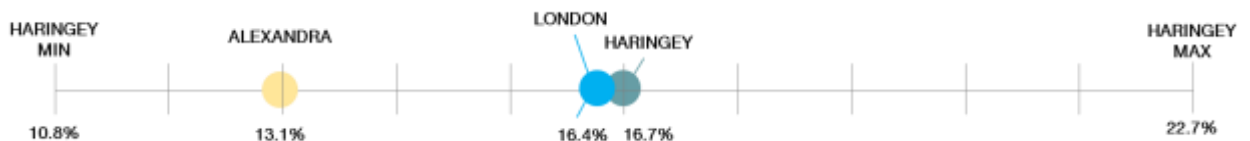
- Male life expectancy in Alexandra is 81.1 years, above the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages.

## RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, ALEXANDRA

- In Alexandra 13.1% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is substantially lower than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely, and the fourth lowest rate of all Haringey wards.

## % PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, ALEXANDRA

- 19.7% of Year 6 children in Alexandra have excess weight. This is substantially below the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages and is the lowest level of all wards in the borough.

## RATE OF CRIME, ALEXANDRA

- In Alexandra there were 134 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was significantly below the Haringey and London levels (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively). Alexandra has the lowest rate of crime of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
