

HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: FORTIS GREEN

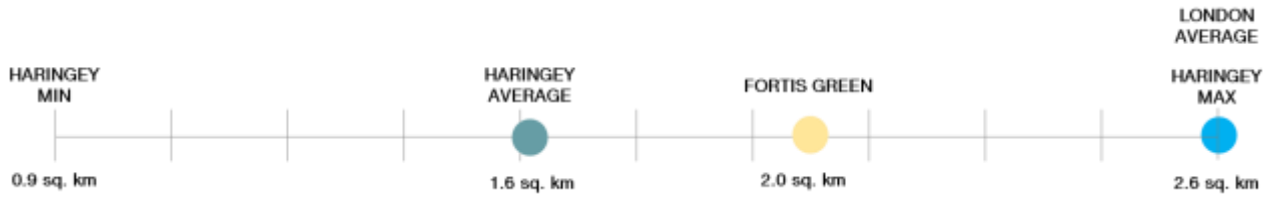


Haringey's Ward Profiles rely on data sources that provide a breakdown to ward-level. Such granular data is less widely available than data at regional or borough level, and as such certain measures use data going back to the 2011 Census. Please be aware of the source and year when using the data cited in this profile.

ATTRIBUTES

SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), FORTIS GREEN

- At 2 sq. km, Fortis Green is larger ward than the average Haringey ward (1.6 sq. km), but smaller than the London average (2.6 sq. km).

POPULATION, FORTIS GREEN

- At 12,665 residents, Fortis Green has a smaller population than the average Haringey (14,243) or London (13,919) ward.

POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), FORTIS GREEN

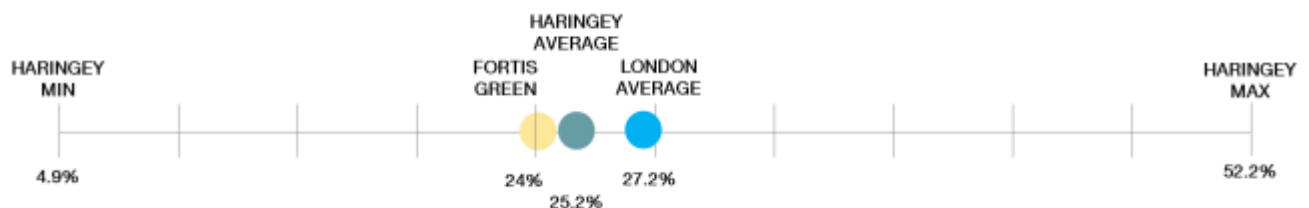
- Fortis Green has a population density 6,341 residents per sq. km. This is lower than the Haringey (9,945) and London (8,742) averages.
- Fortis Green is the third least densely populated ward in the borough.

OPEN SPACE, FORTIS GREEN

- 24% of Fortis Green ward is made up of open space. This is slightly below the Haringey and London averages.

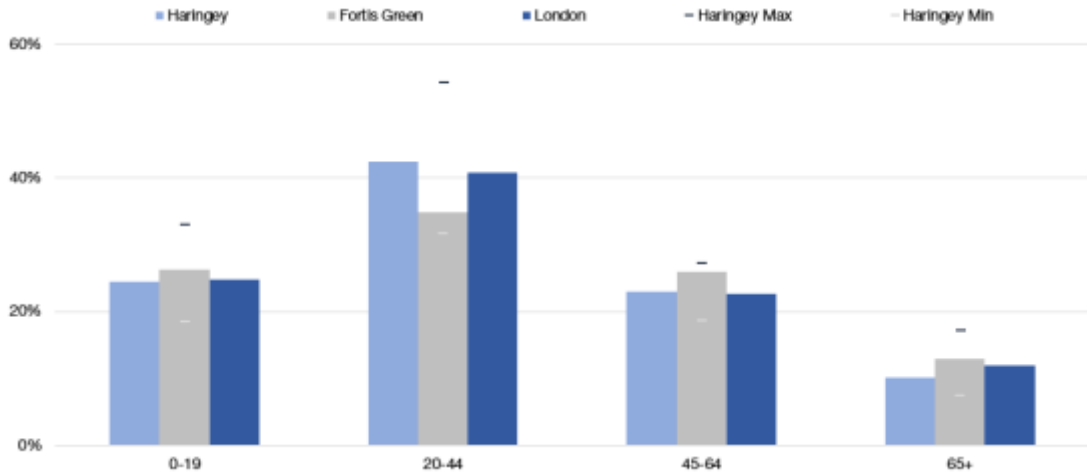

DEMOGRAPHICS

POPULATION AGE, FORTIS GREEN

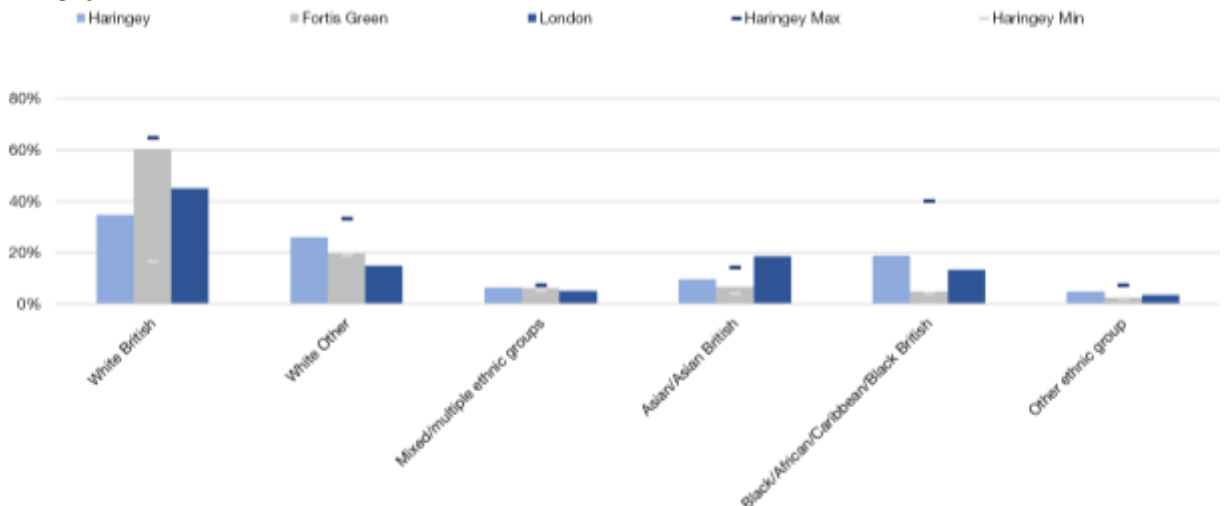
- Fortis Green's overall population spread differs slightly to Haringey more widely. Fortis Green has a slightly higher proportion of residents aged 0-19 (26.3%), a higher proportion of residents aged 45-64 (25.9%) and a higher proportion of residents aged 65+ (13%).
- The 20-44 age group is particularly under-represented in Fortis Green (34.8%) compared to other wards.

ETHNICITY, FORTIS GREEN

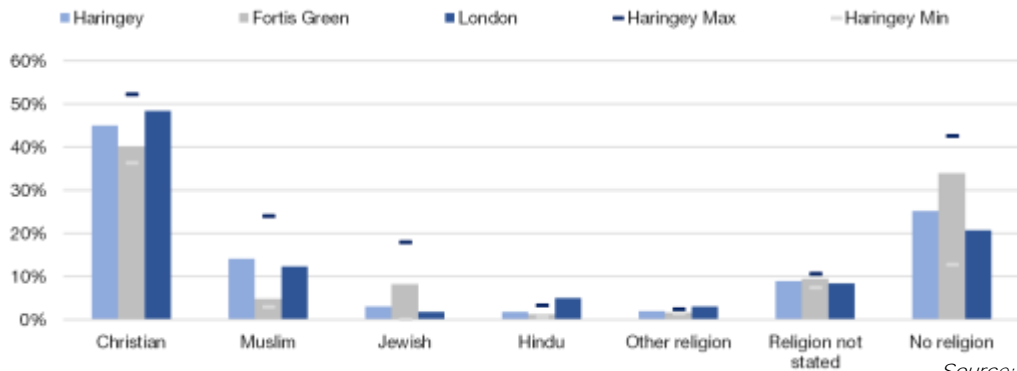
- Fortis Green has a significantly higher proportion of residents whose ethnicity is White British (60.3%), compared to the wider Haringey population (34.7%). This is the major ethnic group in Fortis Green.
- Residents of Black ethnicity are particularly under-represented in Fortis Green (4.8%) compared to Haringey (18.8%).

RELIGION, FORTIS GREEN

- Compared to the rest of Haringey, Fortis Green has a larger than average proportion of residents who identify as having no religion (34%, compared to 25.2% in Haringey).
- Fortis Green also has a larger proportion of Jewish residents (8.3%) compared to the rest of the borough (3%). Muslim residents are under-represented within Fortis Green (4.9%, compared to 14.2% in the borough).

EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

% PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, FORTIS GREEN

- At KS2 Fortis Green pupils perform significantly above the Haringey (67.4%) and London (71.4%) averages, with 83.6% reaching the expected standard at this stage.

% PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, FORTIS GREEN

- In Fortis Green, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (88.8%) is significantly higher than the Haringey and London averages (65.1% and 68.8% respectively).
- Fortis Green has the second highest rate of all Haringey wards.

% QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, FORTIS GREEN

- In Fortis Green, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (68%) is significantly higher than both Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%).
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, FORTIS GREEN

- The median household income in Fortis Green is £49,950 a year. This is higher than the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages, and is the fifth highest rate in the borough.

UNEMPLOYMENT, FORTIS GREEN

- 5.1% of residents in Fortis Green are unemployed. This is substantially lower than the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages.
- This is the fourth lowest level of unemployment in Haringey, joint with Alexandra.

CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), FORTIS GREEN

- In Fortis Green there are 114.5 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is below both the Haringey and London levels (251.8 per 10,000 residents and 201.7 per 10,000 residents respectively), and is the fourth lowest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

HOUSING TENURE, FORTIS GREEN

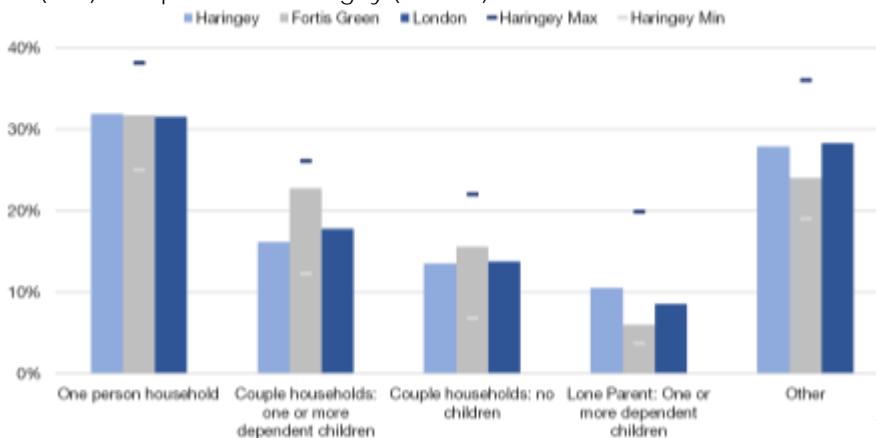
- Households in Fortis Green are more likely to be occupied by the homeowner (53.6%), compared to Haringey (38.8%).
- Socially rented households are significantly under-represented in Fortis Green (11.2%) compared to Haringey (26.7%).

HOUSING COMPOSITION, FORTIS GREEN

- Fortis Green has a large proportion of residents living in a Couple household with dependent children (22.7%) compared to Haringey (16.2%). Lone parent households are under-represented in Fortis Green (6%) compared to Haringey (10.5%).

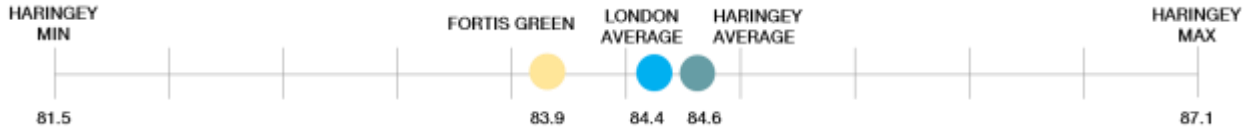

HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, FORTIS GREEN

- Female life expectancy in Fortis Green is 83.9 years, below both the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages.

MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, FORTIS GREEN

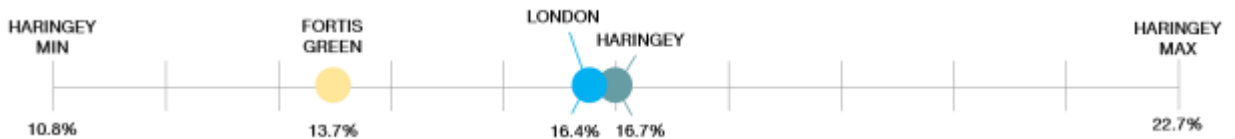
- Fortis Green ward has a male life expectancy of 82.1 years. This is significantly higher than the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages and is the fourth highest male life expectancy in the borough.

RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, FORTIS GREEN

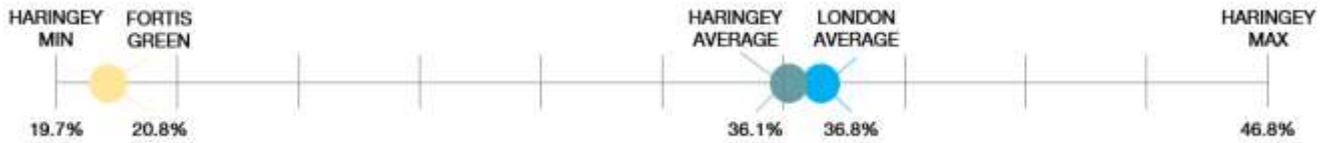
- In Fortis Green 13.7% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is substantially lower than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

% PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, FORTIS GREEN

- 20.8% of Year 6 children in Fortis Green have excess weight. This is significantly below both the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages.
- This is the third lowest level in the borough.

RATE OF CRIME, FORTIS GREEN

- In Fortis Green there were 134 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was significantly below the Haringey and London levels (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively). Fortis Green has the second lowest rate of crime in Haringey.
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
