

# HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: HIGHGATE

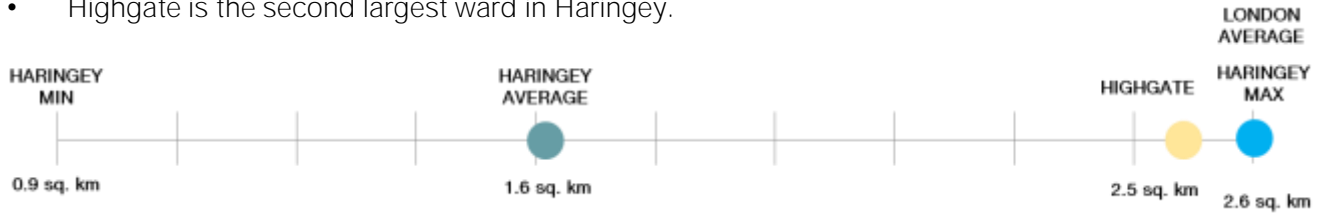

# HIGHGATE ATTRIBUTES

## SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), HIGHGATE

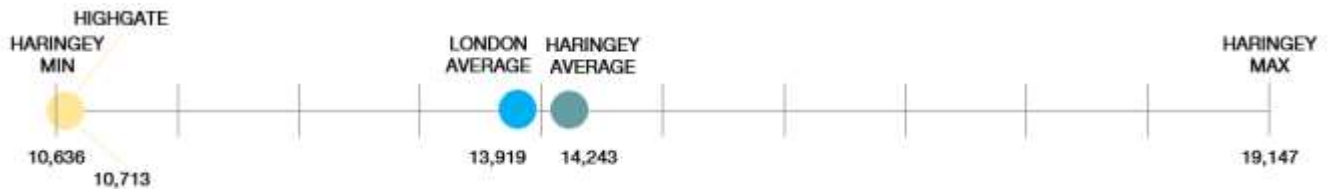
- At 2.5 sq. km, Highgate is much larger than the Haringey average (1.6 sq. km), but slightly smaller than the size of the average London ward (2.6 sq. km).
- Highgate is the second largest ward in Haringey.

## POPULATION, HIGHGATE

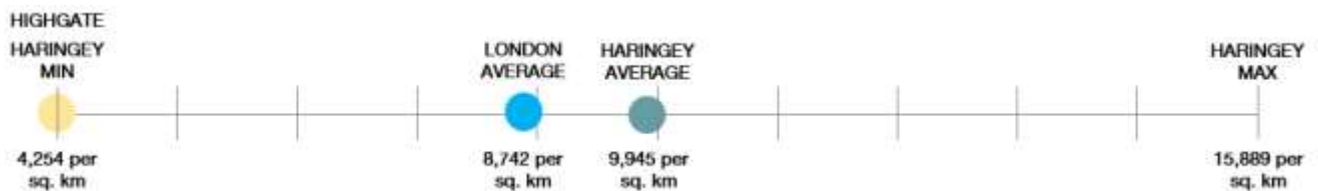
- Highgate has the second smallest population of all Haringey wards, with 10,713 residents. This is substantially less than the average Haringey (14,243) or London (13,919) ward.

## POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), HIGHGATE

- Highgate is the least densely populated ward in Haringey is substantially below the London average, at 4,254 residents per sq. km (compared to an average of 9,945 in Haringey and 8,742 in London).

## OPEN SPACE, HIGHGATE

- 41.8% of Highgate ward is made up of open space, substantially more than the Haringey (25.2%) and London (27.2%) averages.
- This is the third largest proportion of open space of all Haringey wards.

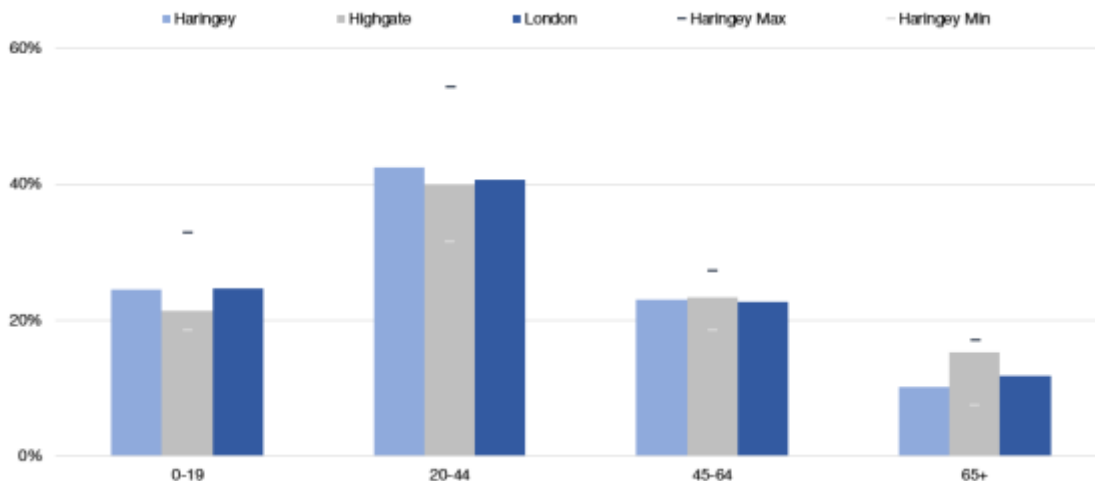

# DEMOGRAPHICS

## POPULATION AGE, HIGHGATE

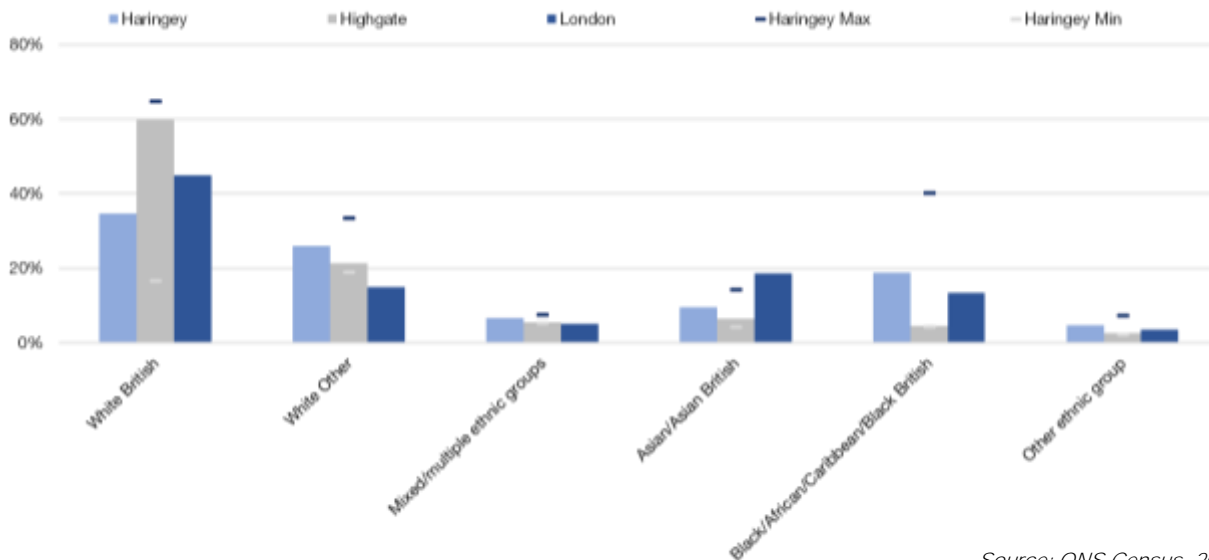
- Highgate's overall population spread mirrors that seen in Haringey more widely, with those aged 20-44 making up the largest proportion of residents (40.1%), and those aged 65+ making up the smallest proportion (15.2%).
- Highgate is relatively speaking an older ward, with those aged 65+ over-represented compared to Haringey, and those aged 0-19 under-represented compared to Haringey.

## ETHNICITY, HIGHGATE

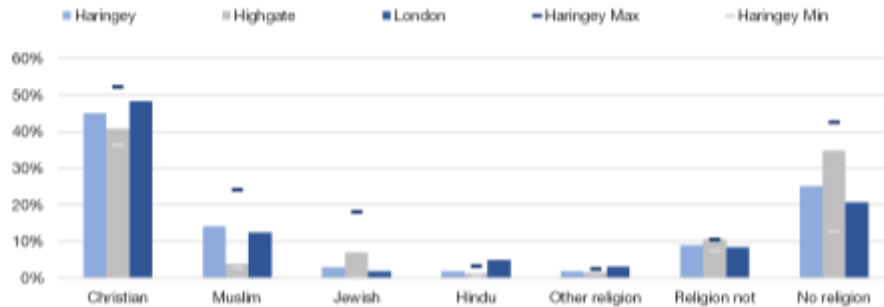
- In Highgate those of White British ethnicity represent the majority (59.8%). This group is over-represented in Highgate compared to the Haringey average (34.7%).
- All other ethnic groups in Haringey are under-represented in Highgate, compared to the wider borough.

## RELIGION, HIGHGATE

- In Highgate there is a larger than average proportion of residents who say they have no religion (34.9%), compared to the wider borough (25.2%).
- The ward also has a smaller proportion of residents saying they belong to each religion than is seen in Haringey as a whole.

## EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

### % PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, HIGHGATE

- Highgate has a larger proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (77.4%) than the average in either Haringey (67.4%) or London (71.4%).
- This is the fifth highest rate in the borough.

### % PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, HIGHGATE

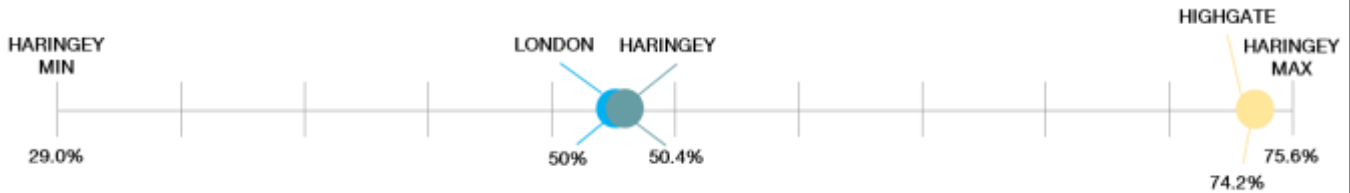
- In Highgate, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (78.6%) is above the Haringey and London average (65.1% and 68.8% respectively).
- Pupils in Highgate have the fifth highest proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs in Haringey.

## % QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, HIGHGATE

- In Highgate, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (74.2%) is significantly above the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages. This is the second highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

## INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

### MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, HIGHGATE

- The median household income in Highgate is £53,710 a year. This is significantly higher than the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages, and is the second highest level of all Haringey wards.

### UNEMPLOYMENT, HIGHGATE

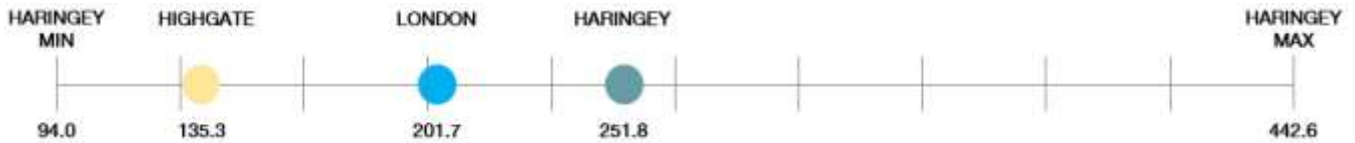
- 3.9% of Highgate residents are unemployed. This is significantly below the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages, and is the lowest unemployment rate of all wards in the borough.

## CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), HIGHGATE

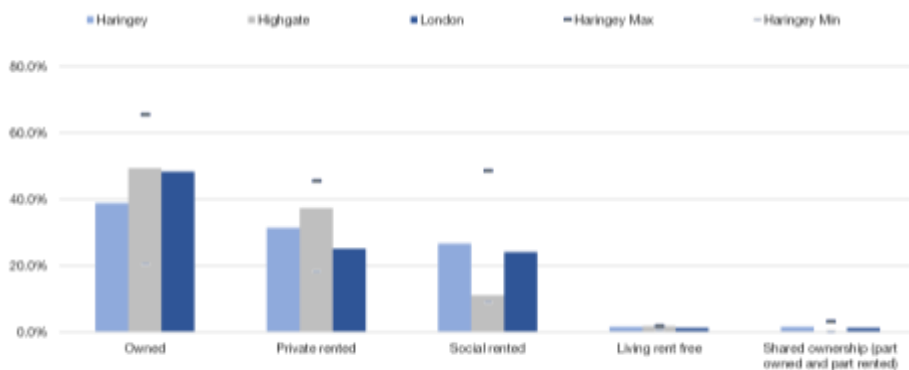
- In Highgate there are 135.3 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is substantially below the Haringey and London levels (251.8 per 10,000 residents and 201.7 per 10,000 residents respectively), and is the fifth lowest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

## HOUSING TENURE, HIGHGATE

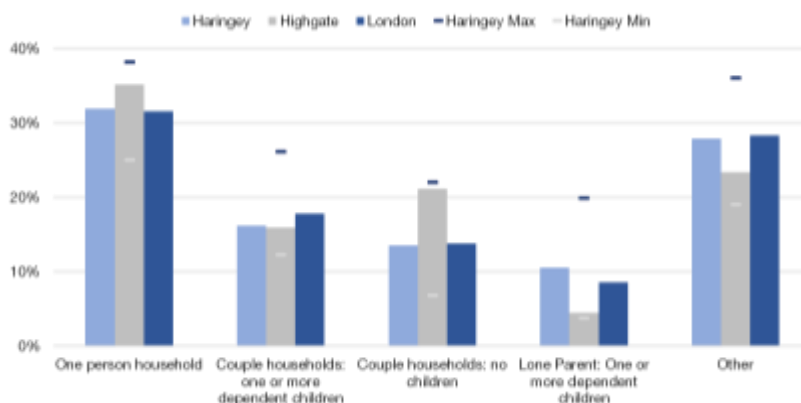
- Highgate households are most likely to be lived in by their owners (49.4%). While this is a substantially larger proportion than the borough average, it is not the highest rate in the borough and is only slightly above the London average (48.3%).
- Highgate households are slightly more likely to be privately rented, compared to the Haringey average (37.4% vs. 31.5%), and are substantially less likely to be socially rented (11.1% vs. 26.7%).

- In Highgate, One person households and Couple households with no children are over-represented, while Lone parent households with one or more dependent children are under-represented.

# HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

## FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, HIGHGATE

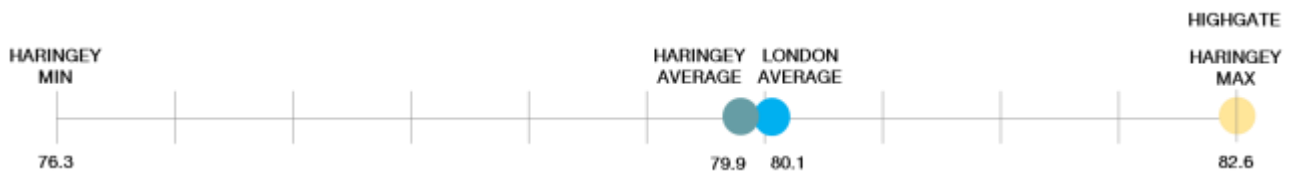
- Female life expectancy in Highgate is 87.1 years. This is significantly higher than the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages, and the highest level of all Haringey wards.

## MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, HIGHGATE

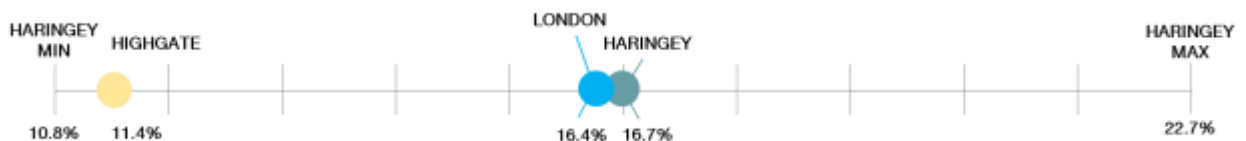
- Male life expectancy in Highgate is 82.6 years, significantly above the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages and the highest male life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

## RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, HIGHGATE

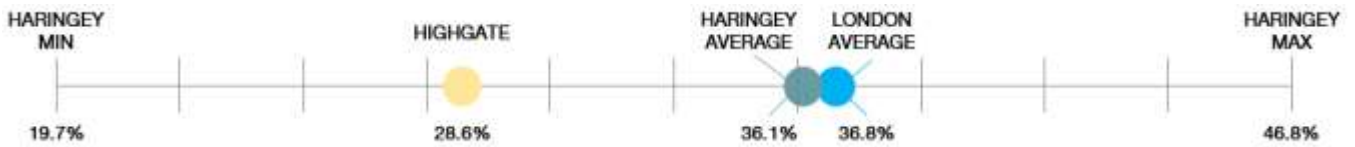
- In Highgate 11.4% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is the second lowest rate in the borough, and is substantially below the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

## % PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, HIGHGATE

- 28.6% of Year 6 children in Highgate have excess weight. This is below the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages, and is the fifth lowest rate of all Haringey wards.

## RATE OF CRIME, HIGHGATE

- In Highgate there were 162 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was significantly below the Haringey and London levels (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively), and the fourth lowest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
