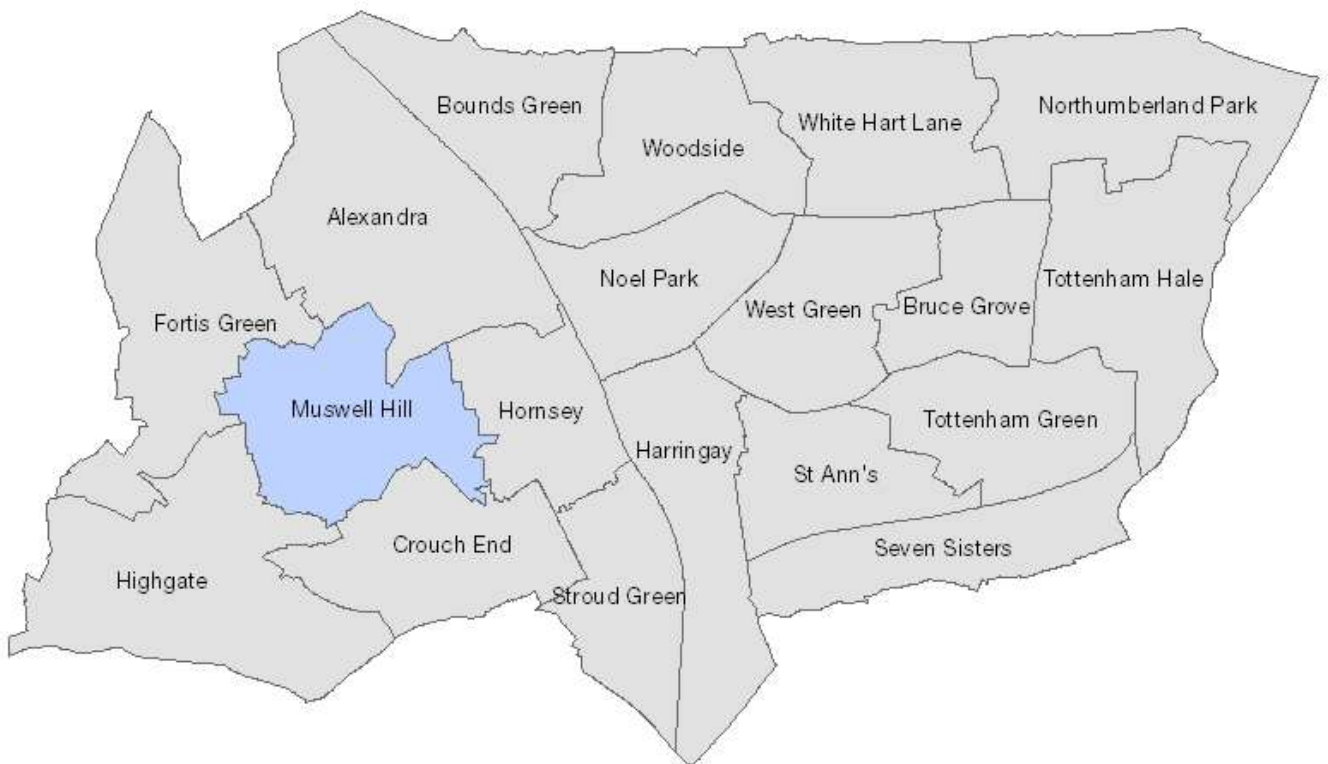


HARINGEY WARD PROFILE:

MUSWELL HILL

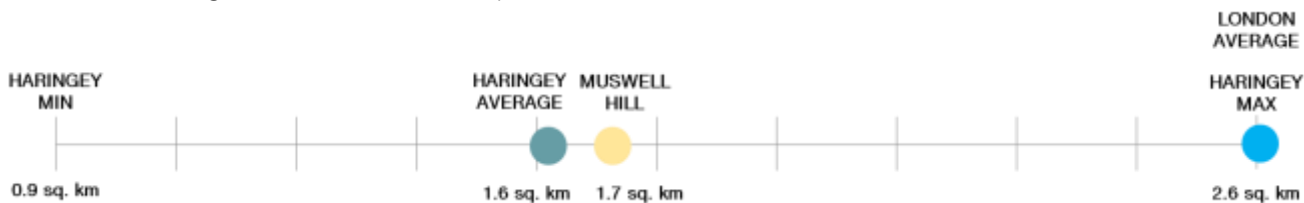


Haringey's Ward Profiles rely on data sources that provide a breakdown to ward-level. Such granular data is less widely available than data at regional or borough level, and as such certain measures use data going back to the 2011 Census. Please be aware of the source and year when using the data cited in this profile.

MUSWELL HILL ATTRIBUTES

SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), MUSWELL HILL

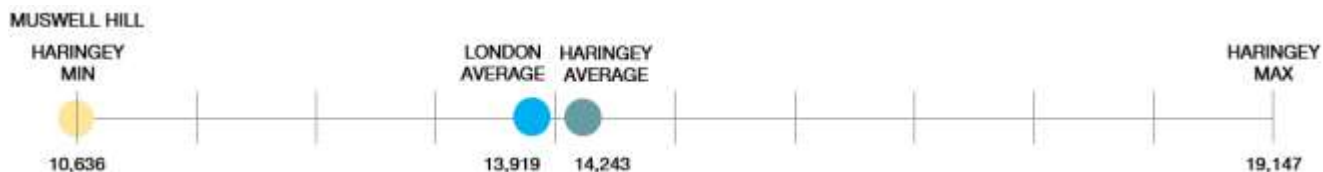
- At 1.7 sq. km, Muswell Hill is larger than the Haringey average (1.6 sq. km), but smaller than the size of the average London ward (2.6 sq. km).

POPULATION, MUSWELL HILL

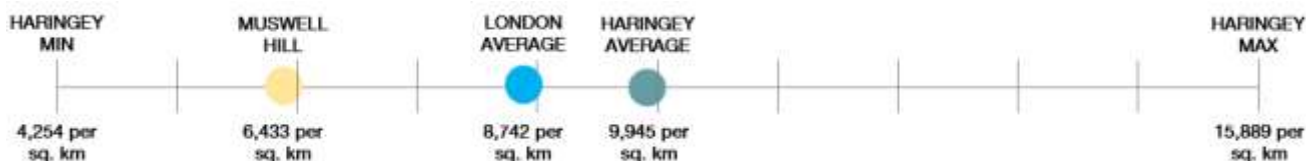
- Muswell Hill has the smallest population of all Haringey wards, with 10,636 residents. This is substantially smaller than the average Haringey (14,243) or London (13,919) ward.

POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), MUSWELL HILL

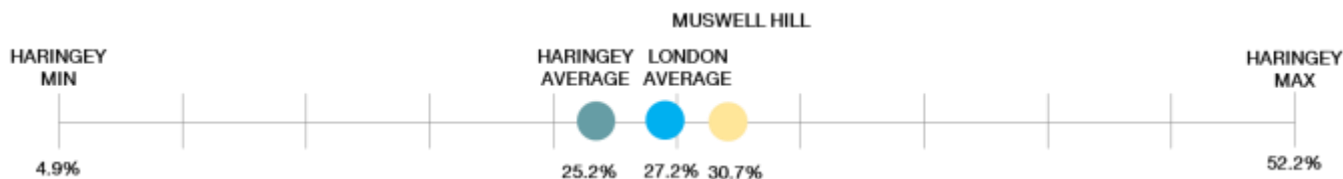
- Population density in Muswell Hill is lower than the Haringey average, at 6,433 residents per sq. km (compared to an average of 9,945 in Haringey and 8,742 in London).

OPEN SPACE, MUSWELL HILL

- 30.7% of Muswell Hill ward is made up of open space, above the Haringey (25.2%) and London (27.2%) averages.

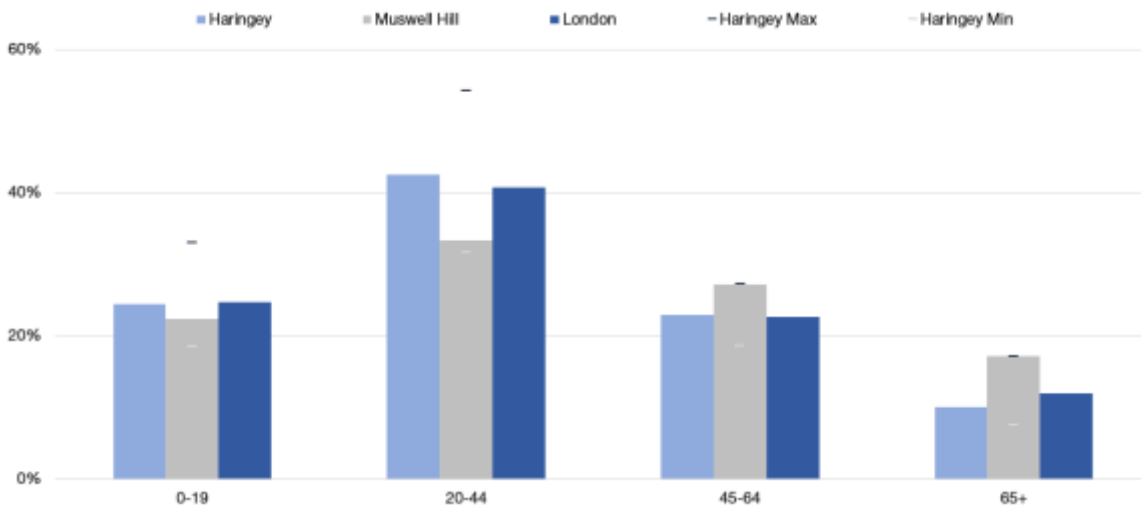

DEMOGRAPHICS

POPULATION AGE, MUSWELL HILL

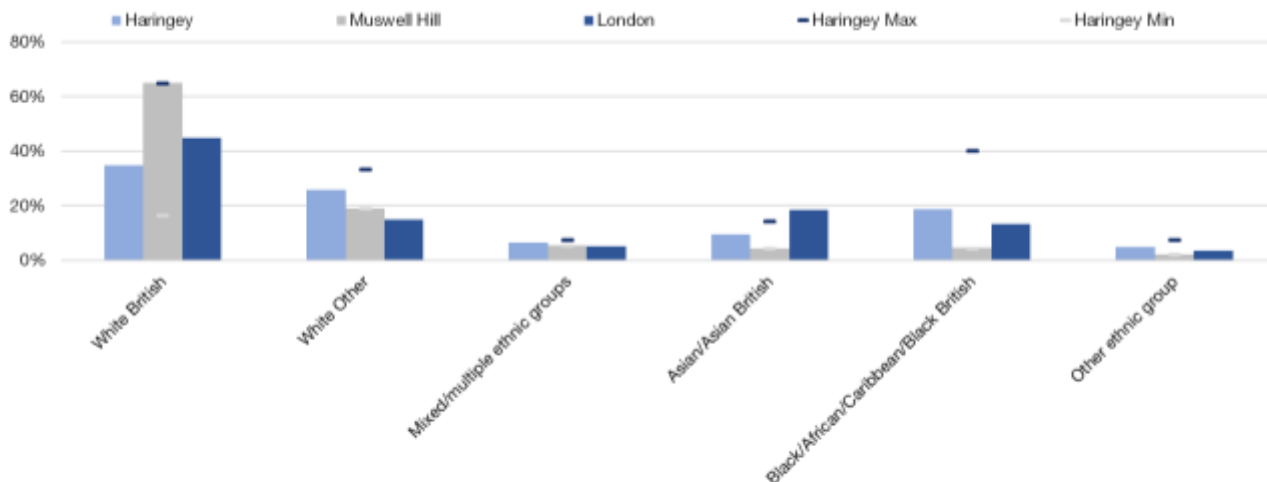
- Muswell Hill has an older population than Haringey more widely, with the second largest proportion of 45-64 year olds (27.1%) and the largest proportion of 65+ year olds (17.2%) in the borough.
- Younger age groups are under-represented in the ward, particularly the 20-44 age group (33.4%, compared to 42.5% in Haringey).

ETHNICITY, MUSWELL HILL

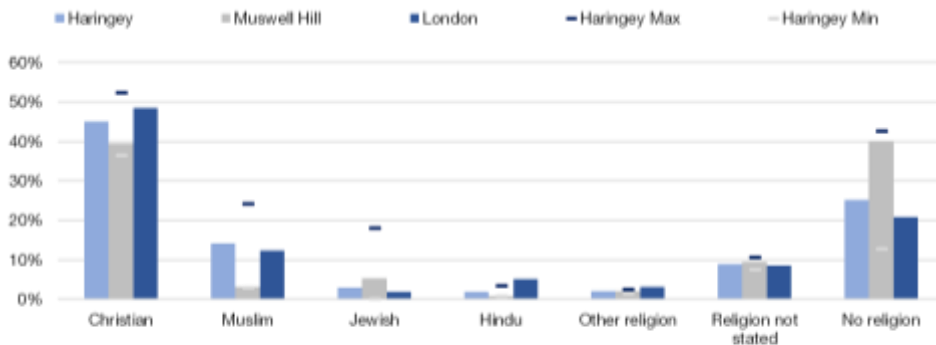
- In Muswell Hill those of White British ethnicity represent the largest group (64.8%). This group is over-represented in Muswell Hill compared to the Haringey average (34.7%), and is the largest proportion of all wards in the borough.
- Those of all other ethnicities are under-represented in Muswell Hill, and the ward has the smallest proportion of Asian residents of all Haringey wards.

RELIGION, MUSWELL HILL

- Muswell Hill has a larger than average proportion of residents saying they have no religion (40%), compared to Haringey generally (25.2%).
- The ward also has the smallest proportion of Muslim residents in Haringey (3%, compared to a borough average of 14.2%).

EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

% PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, MUSWELL HILL

- Muswell Hill has a larger proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (85.3%) than the average in either Haringey (67.4%) or London (71.4%).
- This is the second highest rate in the borough.

% PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, MUSWELL HILL

- In Muswell Hill, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (83.9%) is substantially higher than the Haringey and London averages (65.1% and 68.8% respectively). This is the fourth highest rate in the borough.
- There is substantial variation in GCSE attainment among different Haringey wards, ranging from 44.3% achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths, to 89.2%.

% QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, MUSWELL HILL

- In Muswell Hill, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (71.8%) is significantly above the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages. This is the third highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

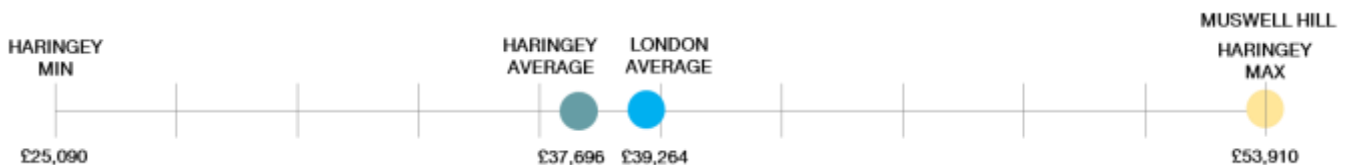

INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, MUSWELL HILL

- The median household income in Muswell Hill is £53,910 a year. This is significantly above the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages, and is the highest level of all Haringey wards.

UNEMPLOYMENT, MUSWELL HILL

- 4.6% of Muswell Hill residents are unemployed. This is substantially below both the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages.
- Muswell Hill has the second lowest rate of unemployment in the borough, joint with Crouch End.

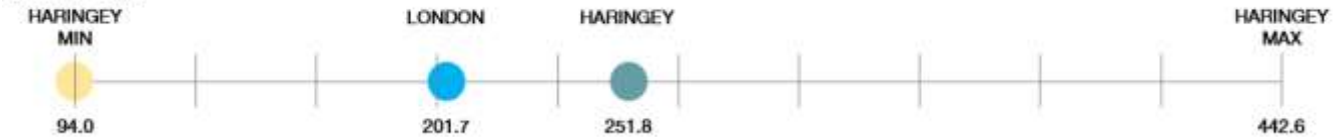

CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), MUSWELL HILL

- In Muswell Hill there are 94 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is substantially below both the Haringey and London levels (251.8 per 10,000 residents and 201.7 per 10,000 residents respectively), and the lowest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

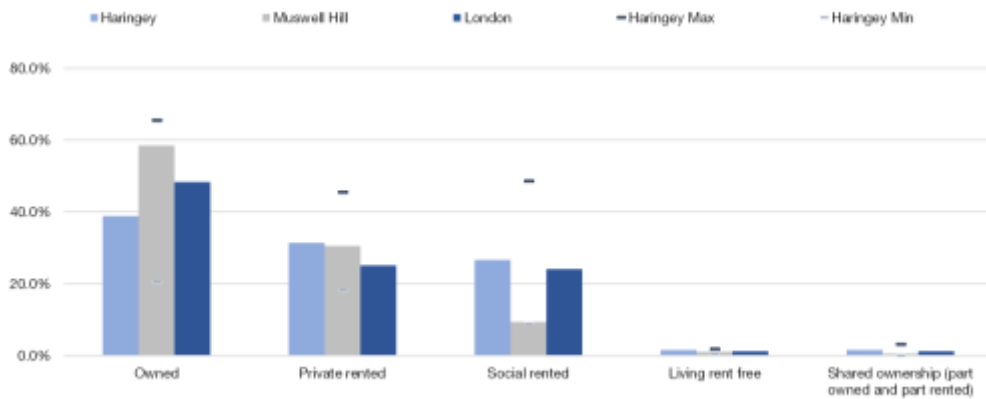

HOUSING TENURE, MUSWELL HILL

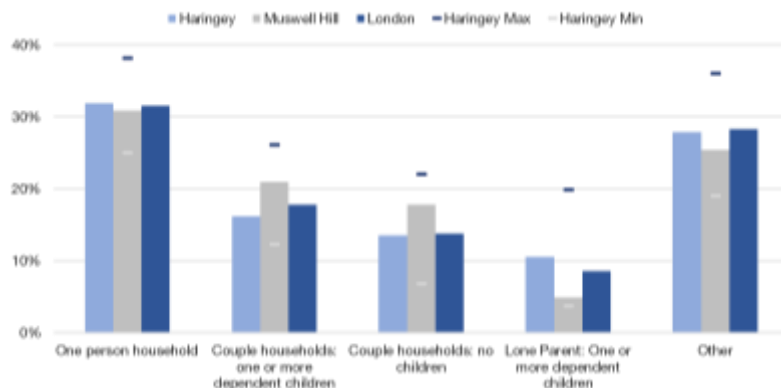
- Muswell Hill has among the smallest proportions of socially rented households of all Haringey wards (9.4% compared to 26.7% in Haringey).
- By contrast, the ward's households are more likely to be lived in by the homeowners than average (58.5% compared to 38.8% in Haringey).

HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, MUSWELL HILL

- In Muswell Hill, Lone parent households are under-represented (4.9% compared to 10.5% in Haringey).
- By contrast, couple households with one or more dependent children or no children are over-represented compared to the wider borough level.

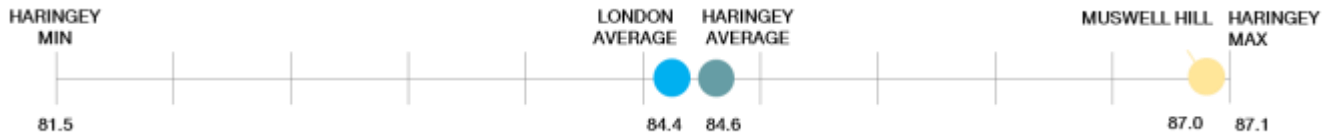

HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, MUSWELL HILL

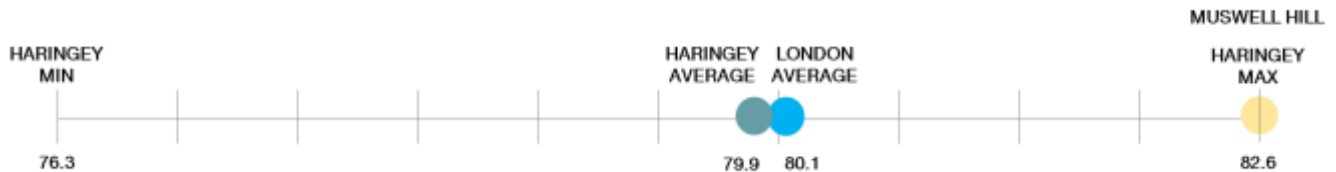
- Female life expectancy in Muswell Hill is 87 years, above the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages. This is the second highest female life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, MUSWELL HILL

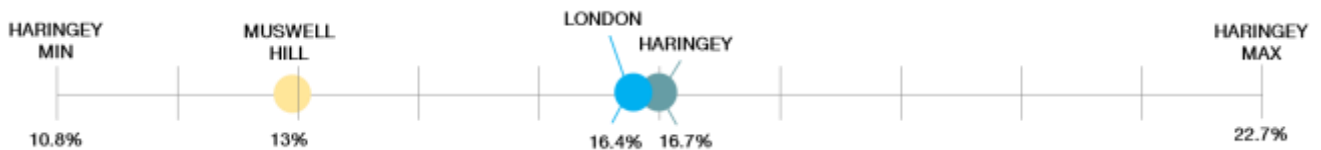
- Male life expectancy in Muswell Hill is 82.6 years, much higher than the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages and the highest male life expectancy in Haringey.

RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, MUSWELL HILL

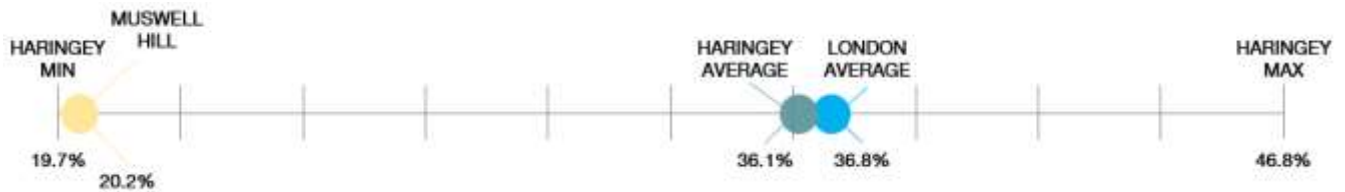
- In Muswell Hill 13% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is the third lowest rate in Haringey, and is below the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

% PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, MUSWELL HILL

- 20.2% of Year 6 children in Muswell Hill have excess weight. This is significantly lower than the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages, and is the second lowest rate of all Haringey wards.

RATE OF CRIME, MUSWELL HILL

- In Muswell Hill there were 197 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was below the Haringey and in line with London levels (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively), though it is not among the lowest levels in the borough.
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
