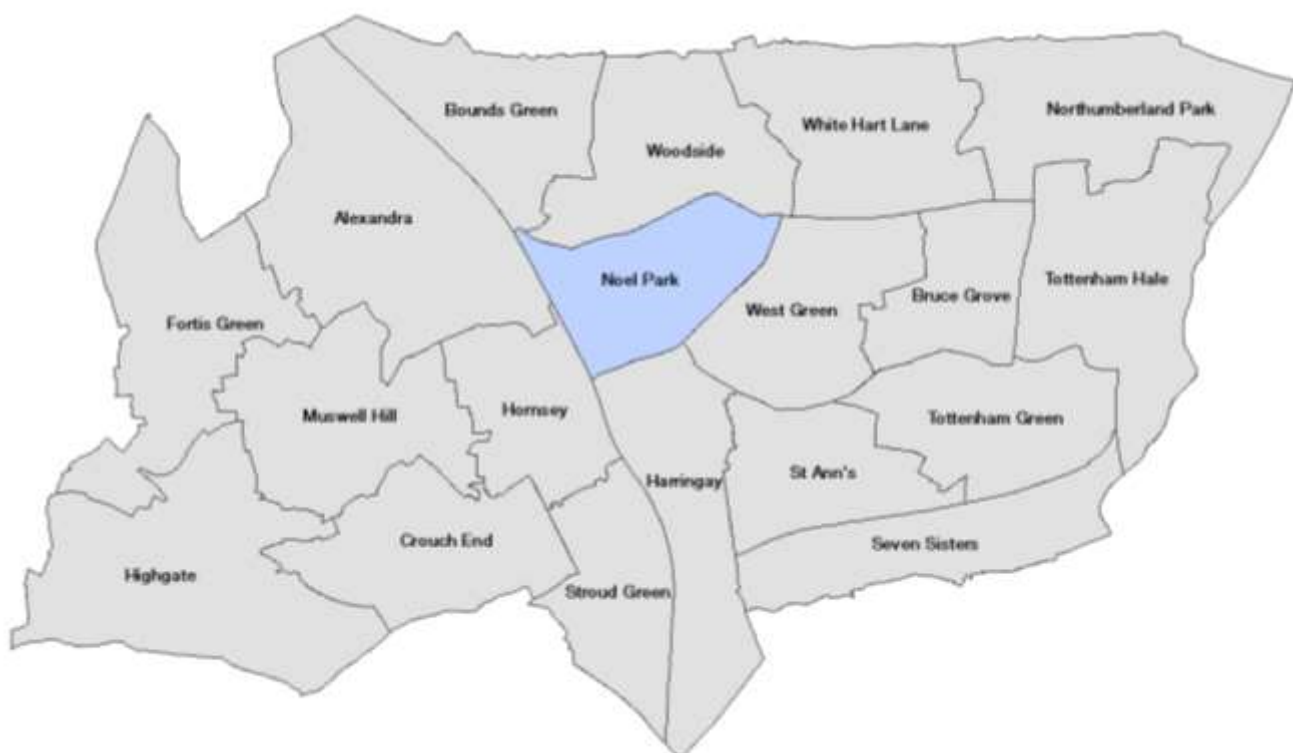


HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: NOEL PARK



Haringey's Ward Profiles rely on data sources that provide a breakdown to ward-level. Such granular data is less widely available than data at regional or borough level, and as such certain measures use data going back to the 2011 Census. Please be aware of the source and year when using the data cited in this profile.

NOEL PARK ATTRIBUTES

SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), NOEL PARK

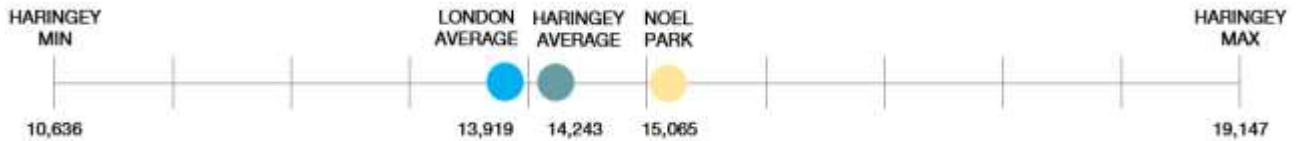
- Noel Park is a relatively small ward, at 1.2 sq. km.
- This is smaller than the Haringey average, and is less than half the size of the average London ward.

POPULATION, NOEL PARK

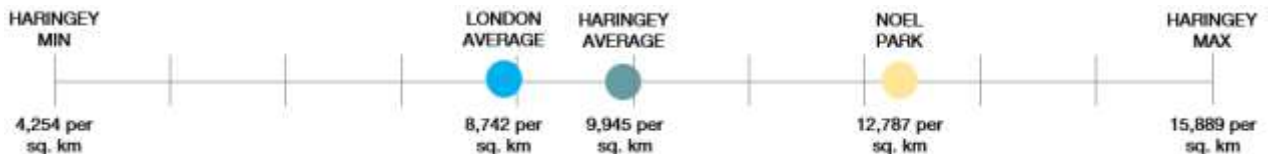
- Noel Park has a larger population than the average Haringey or London ward, at 15,065 residents.

POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), NOEL PARK

- Population density in Noel Park is higher than the average in Haringey (9,945), at 12,787 residents per sq. km. This is also substantially higher than the London average (8,742).

OPEN SPACE, NOEL PARK

- 11.5% of Noel Park ward is made up of open space. This is relatively small for Haringey, and less than half of the average seen in Haringey (25.3%) and London (27.5%) wards.

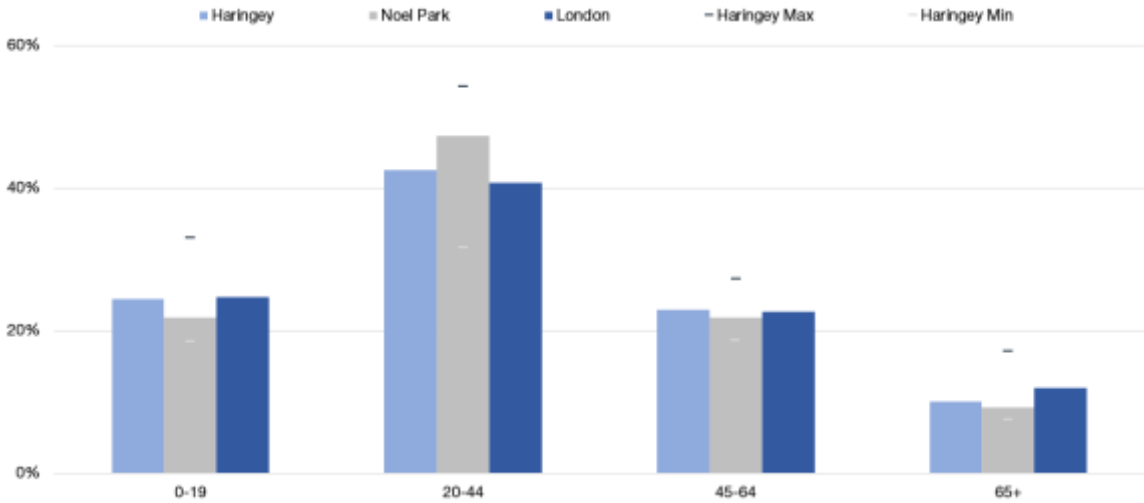

NOEL PARK DEMOGRAPHICS

POPULATION AGE, NOEL PARK

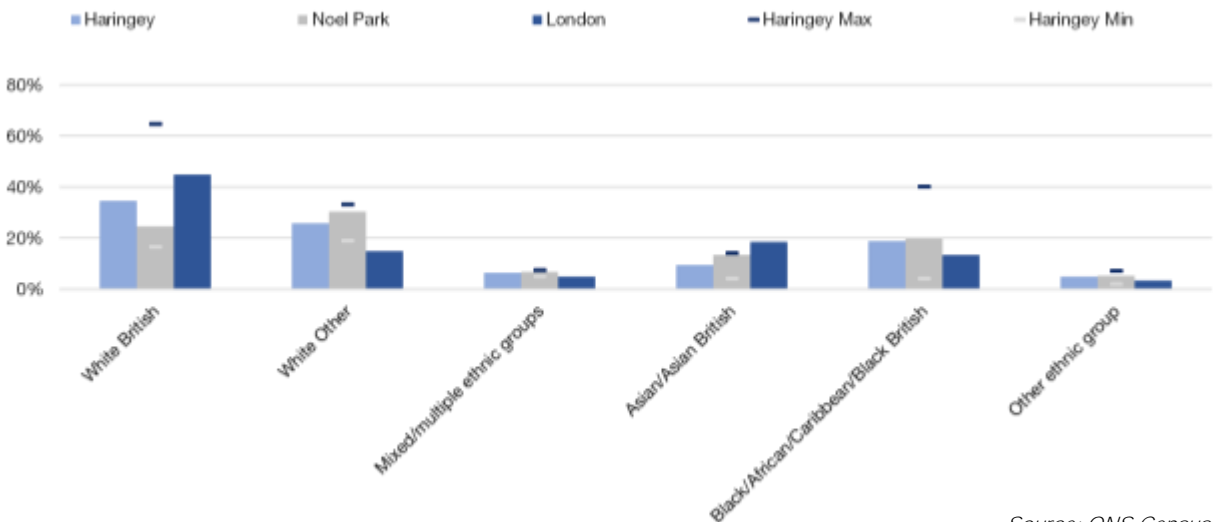
- Noel Park's overall population spread mirrors that seen in Haringey more widely, with just under half of residents aged 20-44 (47.3%), and a small proportion aged 65+ (9.1%).
- The 20-44 population is particularly over-represented in Noel Park compared to other wards and is the fourth highest in the borough.

ETHNICITY, NOEL PARK

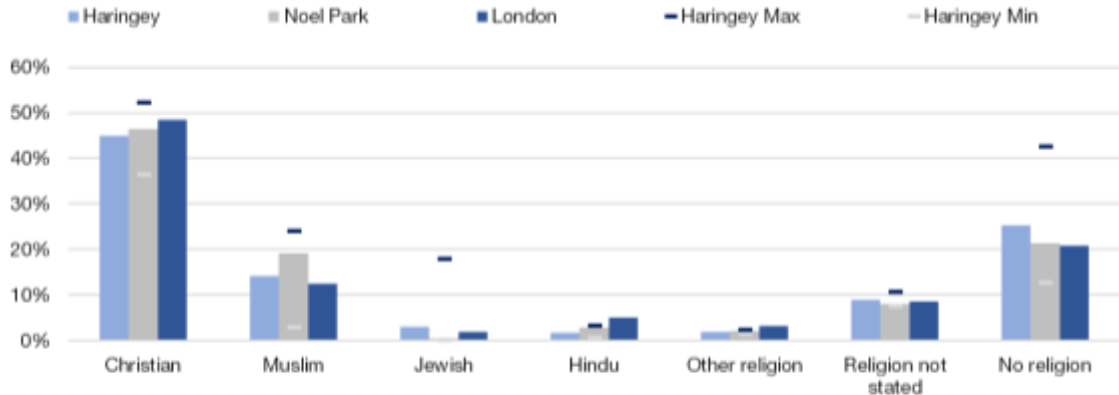
- Noel Park has a larger than average proportion of residents whose ethnicity is White Other, compared to the wider Haringey population. This is the major ethnic group in Noel Park.
- Those of White British ethnicity are under-represented in Noel Park, compared to other Haringey wards.

RELIGION, NOEL PARK

- Compared to the rest of Haringey, Noel Park has a larger than average Muslim population (19.1%), and among the smallest proportions of Jewish residents in Haringey (0.4%).

NOEL PARK EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

% PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, NOEL PARK

- Noel Park has a smaller proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (59.5%) than the average in both Haringey (67.4%) or London (71.4%).
- Whilst substantially lower than the average in Haringey and London, Noel Park is not amongst the lowest levels in the borough.

% PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, NOEL PARK

- In Noel Park, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (58.2%) is lower than the Haringey and London averages (65.1% and 68.8% respectively).
- There is substantial variation in GCSE attainment among different Haringey wards, ranging from 44.3% achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths, to 89.2%.

% QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, NOEL PARK

- In Noel Park, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (44.3%) is below the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, NOEL PARK

- The median household income in Noel Park is £30,620 a year. This is substantially below the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages, but is not among the lowest levels in Haringey.

UNEMPLOYMENT, NOEL PARK

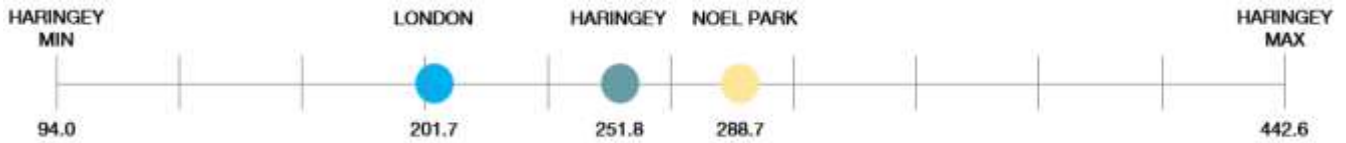
- 10% of Noel Park residents are unemployed. This is above both the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages, but is not among the highest levels of unemployment in the borough.

CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), NOEL PARK

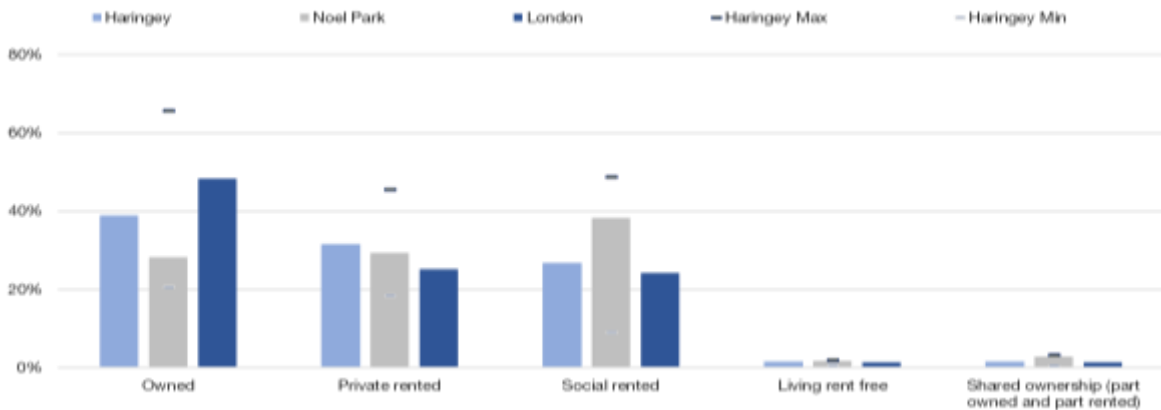
- In Noel Park there are 288.7 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is above both the Haringey and London levels (251.8 per 10,000 residents and 201.7 per 10,000 residents respectively), though it is not among the highest rates of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

HOUSING TENURE, NOEL PARK

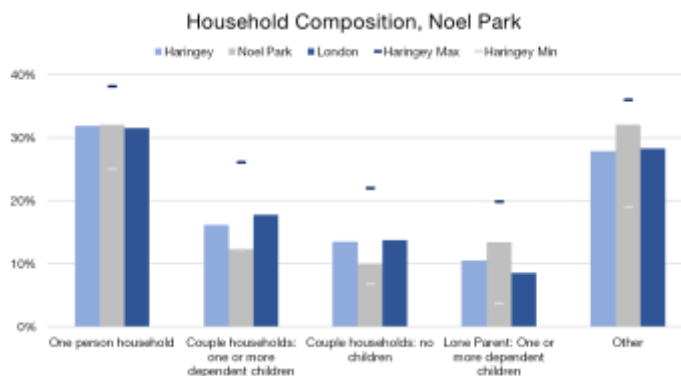
- In Noel Park, there is an under-representation of households that are lived in by the homeowners, and an over-representation of socially rented households, compared to the Haringey and London averages.

HOUSING COMPOSITION, NOEL PARK

- In Noel Park there is a slight over-representation of lone parent households that have one or more dependent children, representing 13.5% of all households (compared to 10.5% in Haringey).
- Noel Park also has the smallest proportion of households that are couple households with dependent children, of all Haringey wards (12.4%, compared to 16.2% across Haringey).

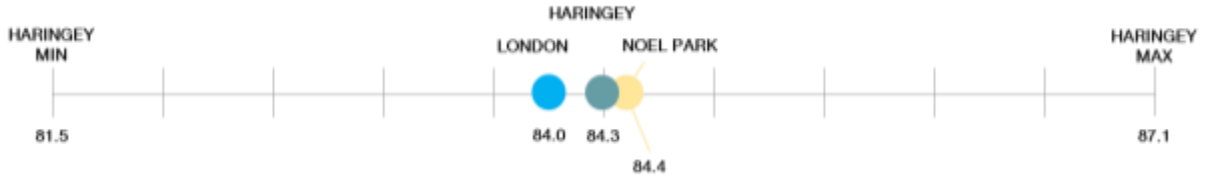

HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, NOEL PARK

- Female life expectancy in Noel Park is 84.4 years, in line with the Haringey (84.3) and London (84.0) averages.

MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, NOEL PARK

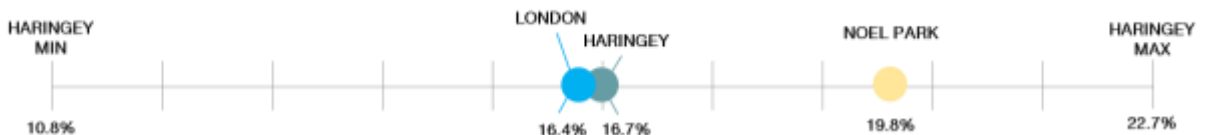
- Male life expectancy in Noel Park is 77.4 years, substantially below the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.0) averages.

RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, NOEL PARK

- In Noel Park around one in five residents (19.8%) have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is substantially higher than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

% PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, NOEL PARK

- 43.5% of Year 6 children in Noel Park have excess weight. This is substantially above the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages. Whilst above average Noel Park isn't among the highest levels in Haringey.

RATE OF CRIME, NOEL PARK

- In Noel Park there were 478 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was more than double the rate in either Haringey or London (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively), and is the highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
