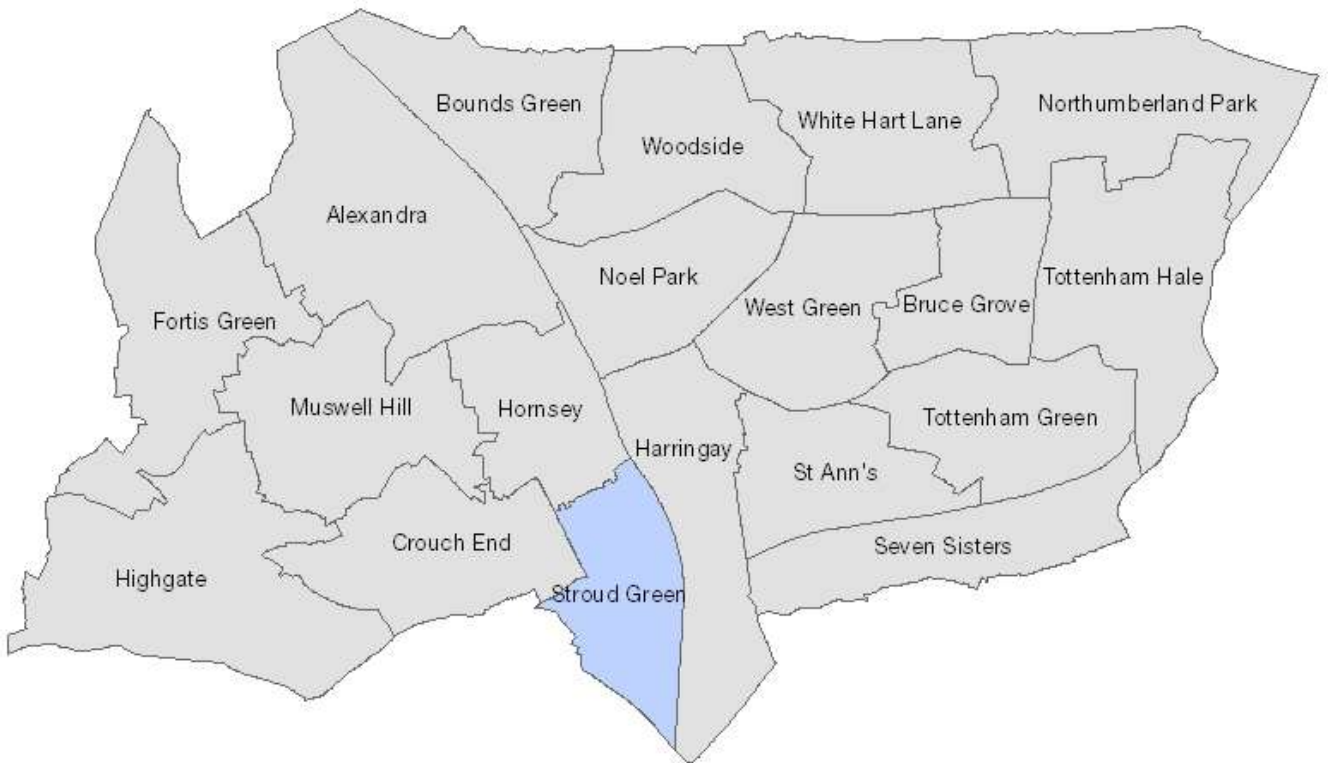


# HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: STROUD GREEN

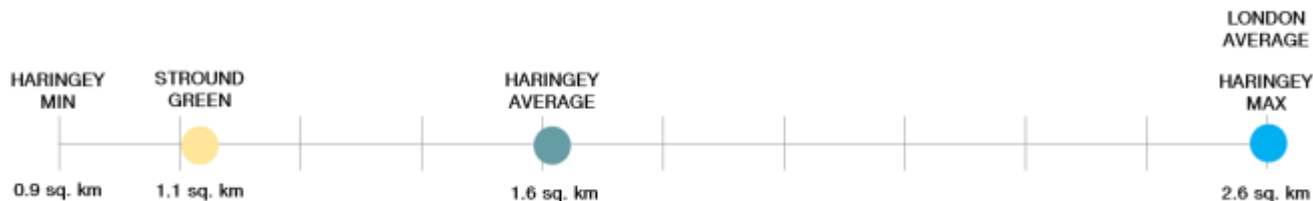

# STROUD GREEN ATTRIBUTES

## SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), STROUD GREEN

- At 1.1 sq. km, Stroud Green is smaller than the Haringey (1.6 sq. km) and London (2.6 sq. km) averages.

## POPULATION, STROUD GREEN

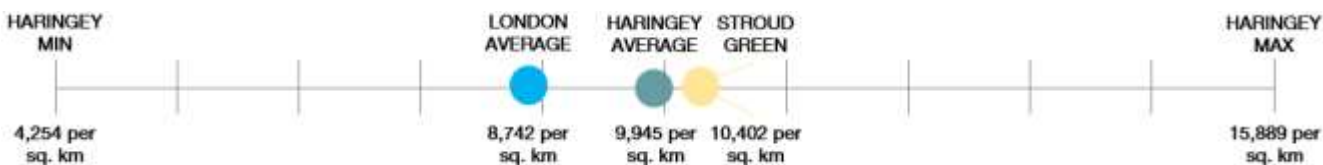
- Stroud Green has a smaller population than either the average in Haringey (14,243) or London (13,919), at 11,568 residents.

## POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), STROUD GREEN

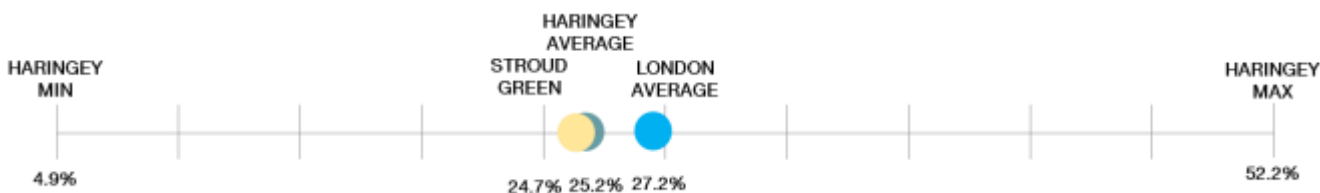
- Population density in Stroud Green is slightly larger than average Haringey Ward, at 10,402 residents per sq. km (compared to an average of 9,945 in Haringey and 8,742 in London).

## OPEN SPACE, STROUD GREEN

- 24.7% of Stroud Green ward is made up of open space, which is largely in line with the Haringey average (25.2%) and slightly below London (27.2%).

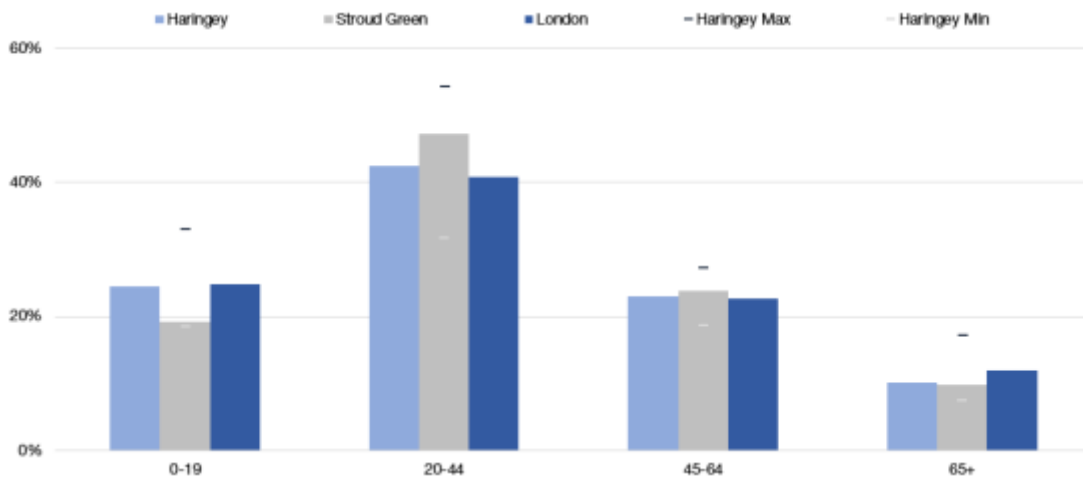

# DEMOGRAPHICS

## POPULATION AGE, STROUD GREEN

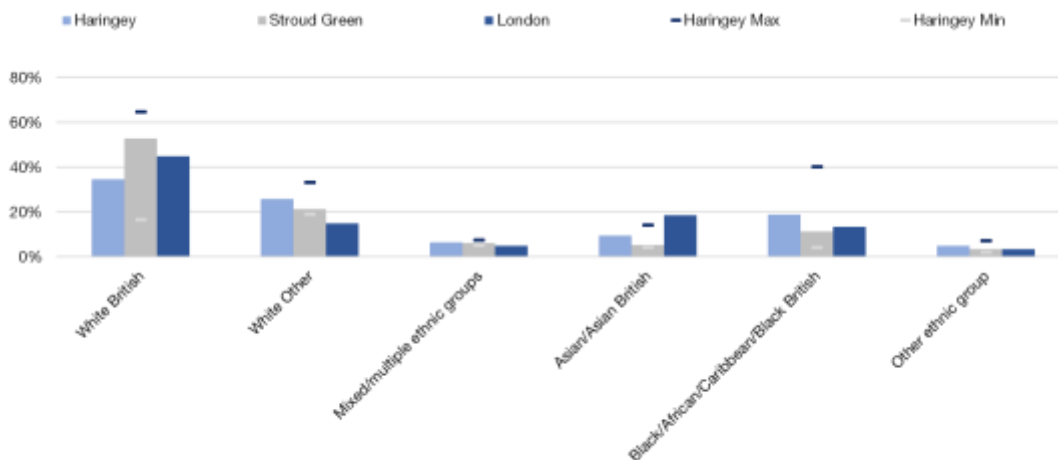
- Stroud Green's population is predominantly in the middle age ranges, with 20-44 year olds over-represented in the borough (47.8% compared to 43.2% in Haringey).
- Stroud Green has among the lowest proportion of 0-19 year olds (19.1%), with this group being significantly under-represented compared to Haringey (24.4%).

## ETHNICITY, STROUD GREEN

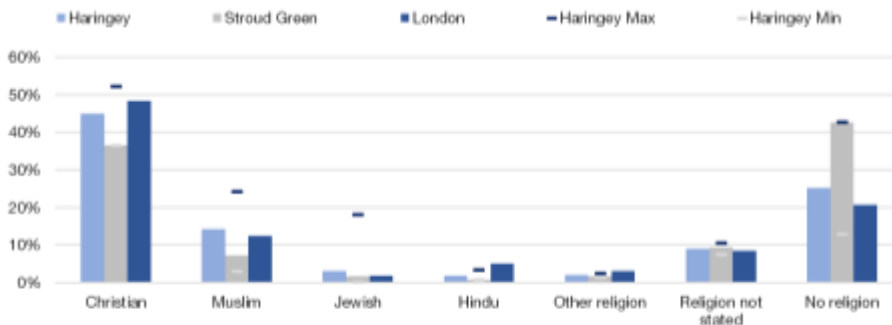
- In Stroud Green those of White British ethnicity represent the largest group (52.9%), with this group over-represented compared to the Haringey average (34.7%).
- By contrast those of White Other, Asian and Black ethnicity are under-represented in the ward.

## RELIGION, STROUD GREEN

- Of all Haringey wards, Stroud Green has the largest proportion of residents who identify as having no religion (42.7%).
- By contrast, Stroud Green has the smallest proportion of Christian residents of all Haringey wards (36.5%), and the Muslim faith is also under-represented in the ward (7.3%).

## EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

### % PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, STROUD GREEN

- At KS2 Stroud Green pupils perform slightly above the average in London (71.4%) and significantly above the average in Haringey (67.4%) with 72.7% reaching the expected standard at this stage.

### % PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, STROUD GREEN

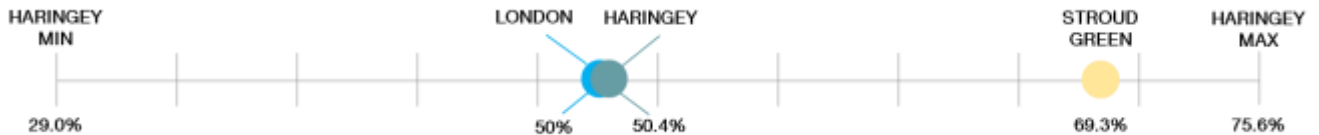
- In Stroud Green, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (72.5%) is above the Haringey and London averages (65.1% and 68.8% respectively).
- There is substantial variation in GCSE attainment among different Haringey wards, ranging from 44.3% achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths, to 89.2%.

## % QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, STROUD GREEN

- In Stroud Green, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (69.3%) is notably higher than the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages. This is the fourth highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

## INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

### MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, STROUD GREEN

- The median household income in Stroud Green is £44,780 a year. This is higher than the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages.

### UNEMPLOYMENT, STROUD GREEN

- 5.9% of Stroud Green residents are unemployed, a lower rate than either the Haringey average (8.6%) or the London rate (7.3%).

## CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), STROUD GREEN

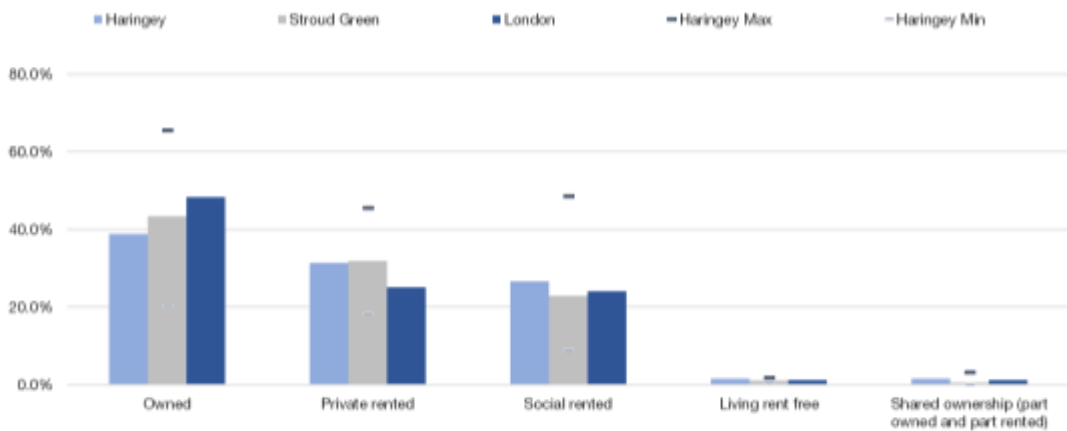
- In Stroud Green there are 229.1 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is below the Haringey level but above London (201.7 per 10,000 residents and 251.8 per 10,000 residents respectively).
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

## HOUSING TENURE, STROUD GREEN

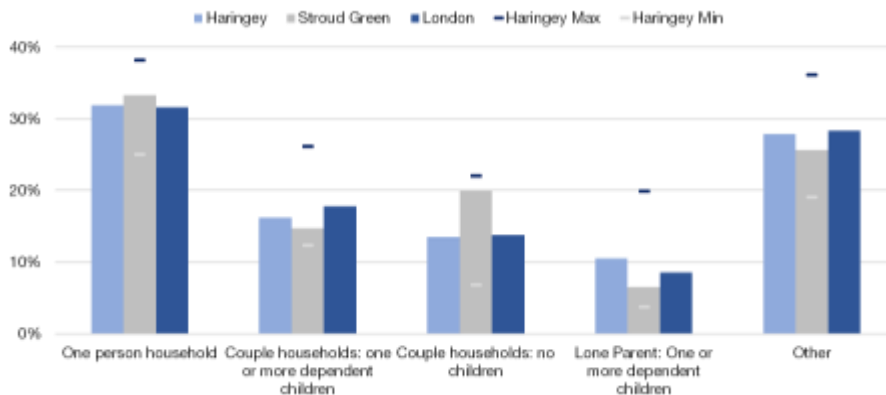
- In Stroud Green there is a slightly smaller proportion of social rented households compared to the borough average (22.9% vs. 26.7%), and a slightly larger proportion of households that are lived in by their owners (43.5% vs. 38.8%).

## HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, STROUD GREEN

- In Stroud Green, Couple households with no children are notably over-represented compared to the borough average (19.9% vs. 13.5%). By contrast, Lone parent households and Couple households with dependent children are under-represented in the ward.

# HEALTH & WELLBEING

## FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, STROUD GREEN

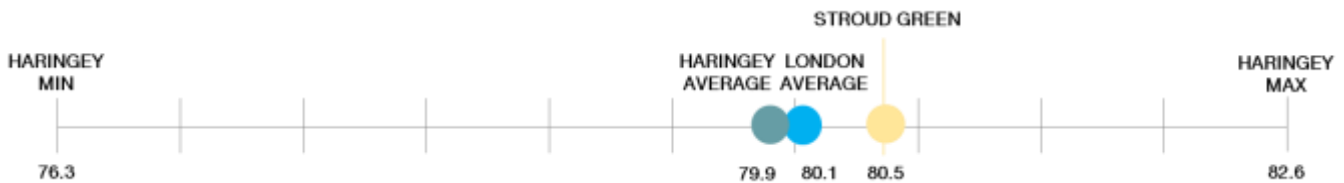
- Female life expectancy in Stroud Green is 82 years, substantially below the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages. This is the third lowest female life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

## MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, STROUD GREEN

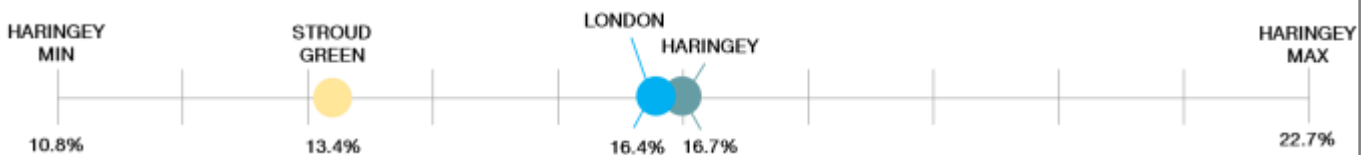
- Male life expectancy in Stroud Green is 80.5 years, slightly higher than the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages.

## RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, STROUD GREEN

- In Stroud Green 13.4% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is lower than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

## % PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, STROUD GREEN

- 29.9% of Year 6 children in Stroud Green have excess weight. This is below the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages.

## RATE OF CRIME, STROUD GREEN

- In Stroud Green there were 153 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was substantially lower than the Haringey and London levels (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively), and is the third lowest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
