

# HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: TOTTENHAM GREEN



*Haringey's Ward Profiles rely on data sources that provide a breakdown to ward-level. Such granular data is less widely available than data at regional or borough level, and as such certain measures use data going back to the 2011 Census. Please be aware of the source and year when using the data cited in this profile.*

# TOTTENHAM GREEN ATTRIBUTES

## SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), TOTTENHAM GREEN

- At 1.4 sq. km, Tottenham Green is slightly smaller than the Haringey average (1.6 sq. km), and substantially smaller than the average London ward (2.6 sq. km).
- Despite this, Tottenham Green is not among the smallest wards in the borough.

## POPULATION, TOTTENHAM GREEN

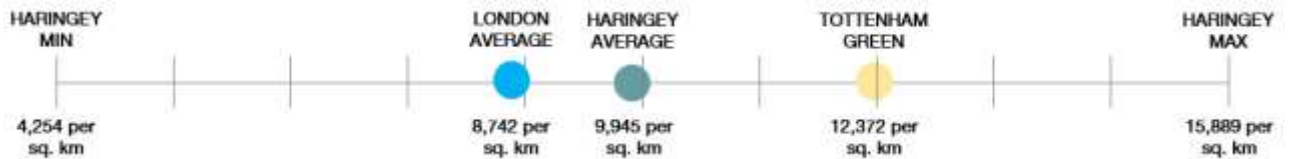
- Tottenham Green has a larger population than the average Haringey (14,243) or London (13,919) ward, at 16,516 residents.
- Tottenham Green has the third largest population of all wards in the borough.

## POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), TOTTENHAM GREEN

- Population density in Tottenham Green is higher than average, at 12,372 residents per sq. km (compared to an average of 9,945 in Haringey and 8,742 in London).
- Despite being higher than the average, Tottenham Green is not among the wards with the highest population density in the borough.

## OPEN SPACE, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- 10.5% of Tottenham Green ward is made up of open space, substantially below the Haringey (25.2%) and London (27.2%) averages.
- Tottenham Green has the third smallest proportion of open space of all Haringey wards.

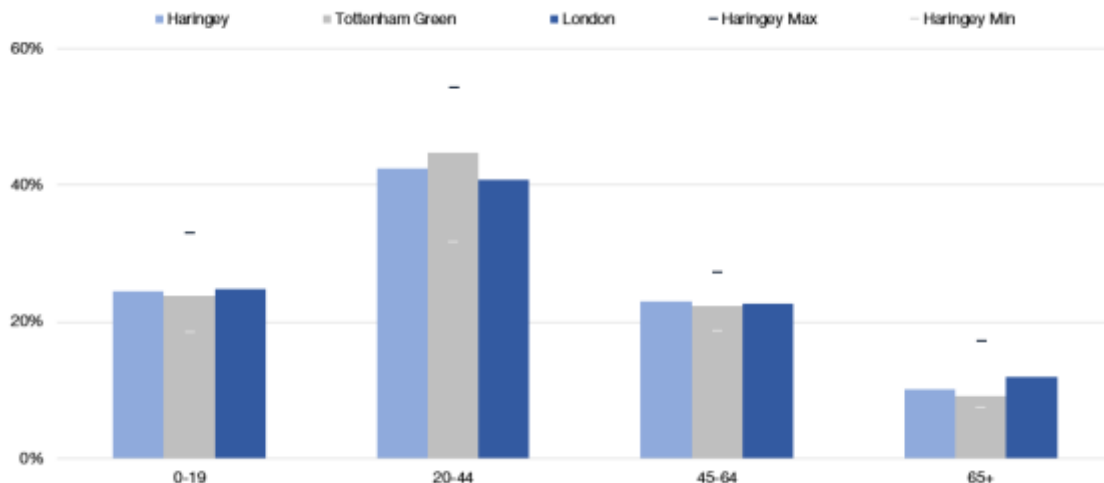

# DEMOGRAPHICS

## POPULATION AGE, TOTTENHAM GREEN

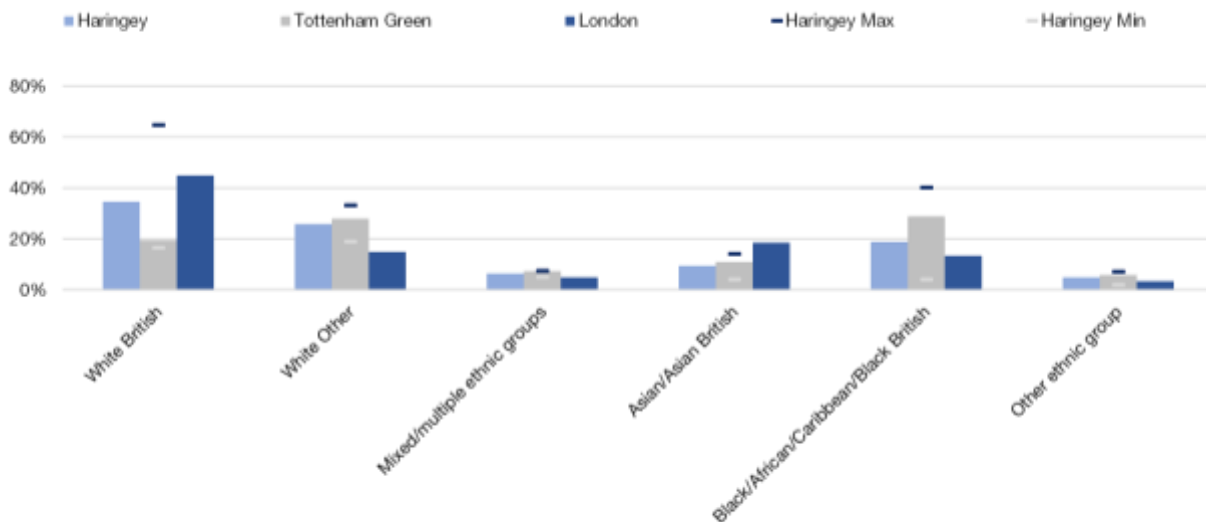
- Tottenham Green's overall population spread is in line with that seen in Haringey more widely, with those aged 20-44 making up the largest proportion of residents (44.8%), and those aged 65+ making up the smallest proportion (9.2%).
- No age group is particularly over- or under- represented in the ward, comparative to the borough average.

## ETHNICITY, TOTTENHAM GREEN

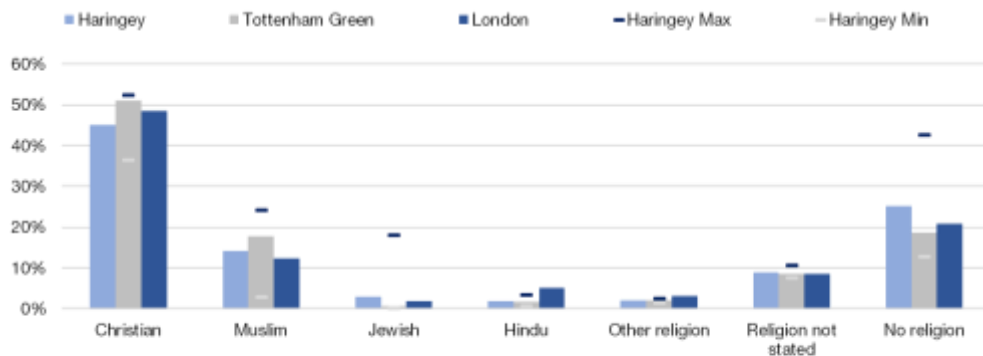
- In Tottenham Green those of Black ethnicity represent the largest ethnic group (28.8%), closely followed by those of White Other ethnicity (27.9%).
- Those of White British ethnicity (19.3%) are under-represented in Tottenham Green, compared to the Haringey average (34.7%).

## RELIGION, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- Over half of Tottenham Green residents identify as Christian (50.9%), a higher proportion than the Haringey average (45%).
- By contrast, Tottenham Green has a smaller proportion of residents saying they have no religion (18.6%), compared to the level in Haringey (25.2%).

## EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

### % PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, TOTTENHAM GREEN

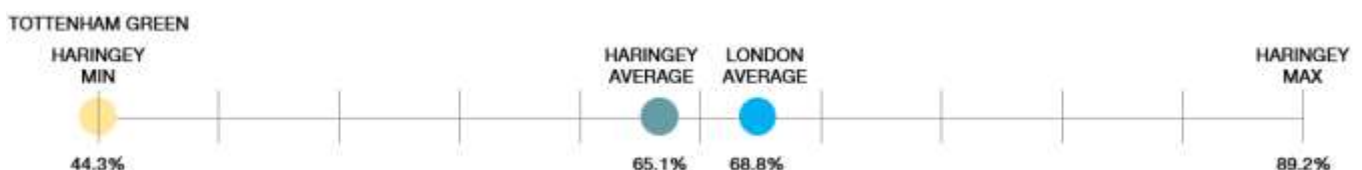
- Tottenham Green has a smaller proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (62.4%) than the average in either Haringey (67.4%) or London (71.4%).

### % PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, TOTTENHAM GREEN

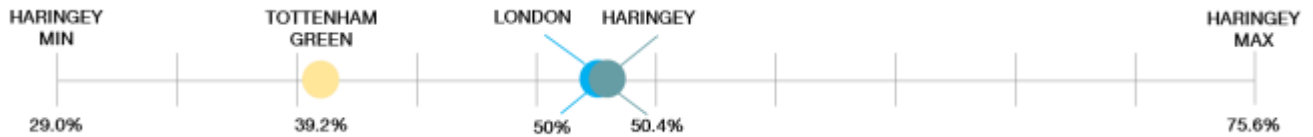
- In Tottenham Green, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (44.3%) is the lowest in the borough, below the Haringey and London averages (65.1% and 68.8% respectively).
- There is substantial variation in GCSE attainment among different Haringey wards, ranging from 44.3% achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths, to 89.2%.

## % QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- In Tottenham Green, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (39.2%) is below the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages. This is not among the smallest proportions seen in the borough.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

## INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

### MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- The median household income in Tottenham Green is £28,920 a year. This is below the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages, and is the fourth lowest median household income of all Haringey wards.

### UNEMPLOYMENT, TOTTENHAM GREEN

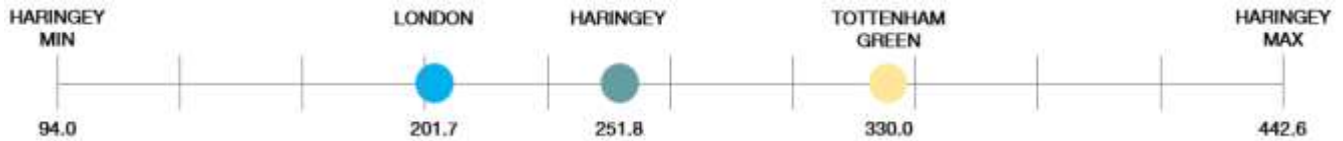
- 11.3% of Tottenham Green residents are unemployed. This is the fourth highest rate in the borough, and is higher than both the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages.

## CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), TOTTENHAM GREEN

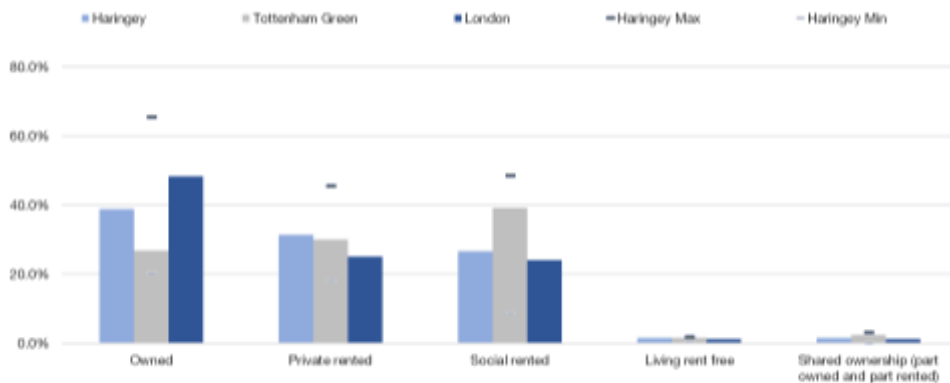
- In Tottenham Green there are 330 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is substantially above both the Haringey and London levels (251.8 per 10,000 residents and 201.7 per 10,000 residents respectively), and is the third highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

## HOUSING TENURE, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- Tottenham Green households are most likely to be socially rented (39.2%), with a higher rate of socially rented households in the ward compared to Haringey more widely (26.7%).
- By contrast, Tottenham Green households are less likely to be lived in by the homeowners (31.2%) compared to Haringey as a whole (38.8%).

## HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- In Tottenham Green, household composition broadly follows the pattern seen in Haringey more widely.
- One person households, as well as lone parent households with one or more dependent children, are slightly over-represented in the ward.

# HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

## FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, TOTTENHAM GREEN

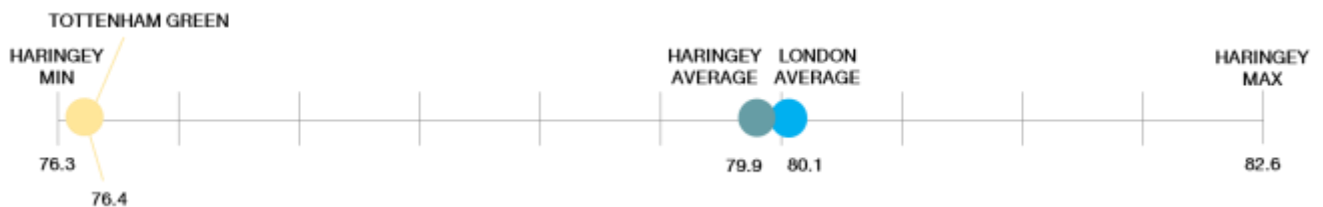
- Female life expectancy in Tottenham Green is 81.5 years, the lowest rate of all Haringey wards and substantially below the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages.

## MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, TOTTENHAM GREEN

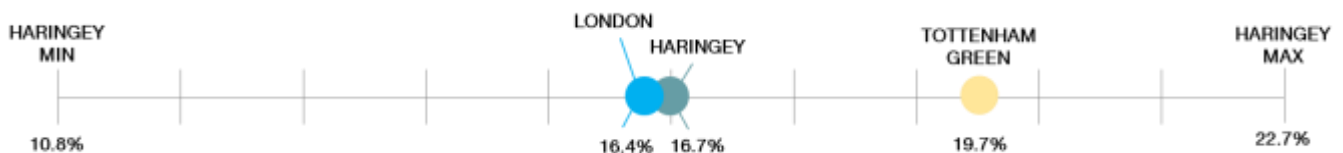
- Male life expectancy in Tottenham Green is 76.4 years, substantially below the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages, and the second lowest male life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

## RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, TOTTENHAM GREEN

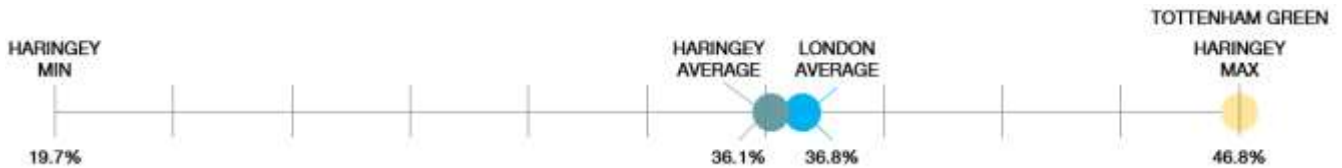
- In Tottenham Green 19.7% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is higher than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

## % PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- 46.8% of Year 6 children in Tottenham Green have excess weight. This is significantly above the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages.
- Tottenham Green has the highest rate of excess weight of all Haringey wards.

## RATE OF CRIME, TOTTENHAM GREEN

- In Tottenham Green there were 374 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was significantly higher than the Haringey and London levels (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively). This is the second highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
