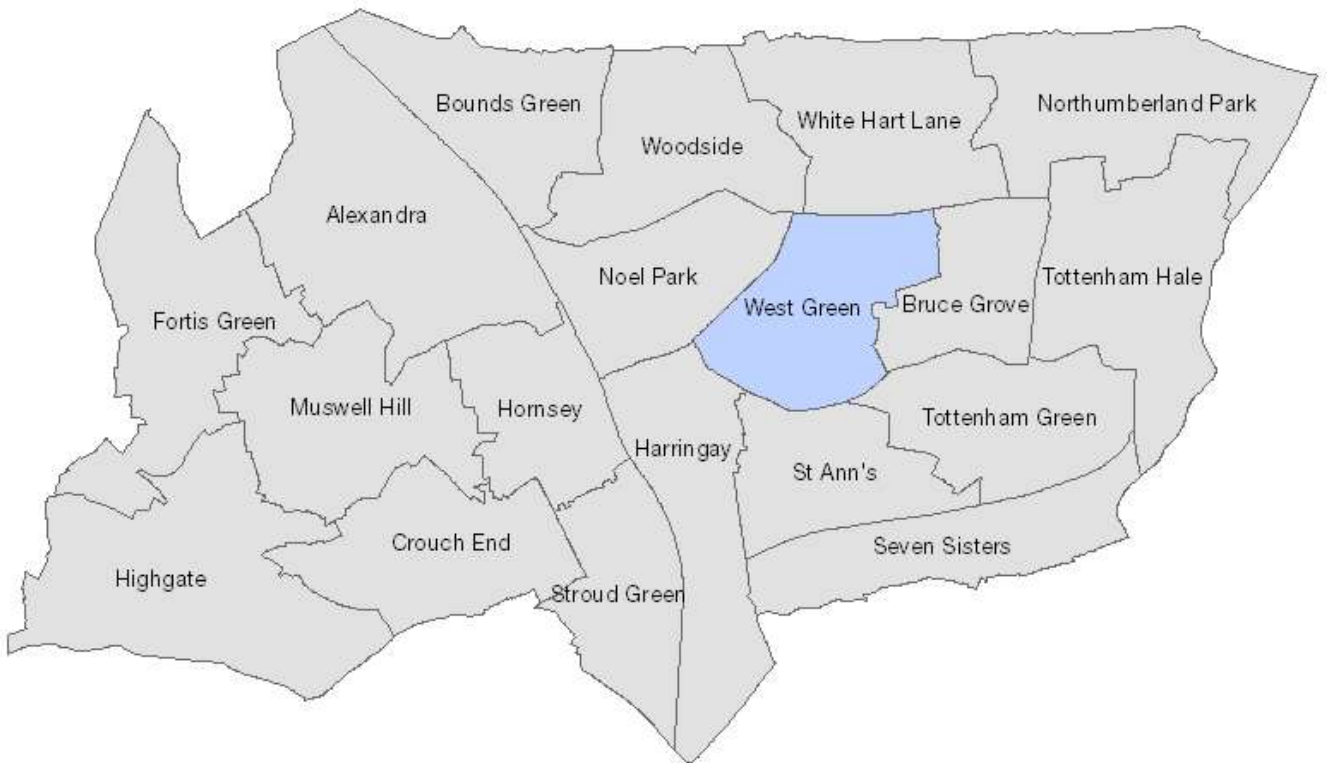


# HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: WEST GREEN



*Haringey's Ward Profiles rely on data sources that provide a breakdown to ward-level. Such granular data is less widely available than data at regional or borough level, and as such certain measures use data going back to the 2011 Census. Please be aware of the source and year when using the data cited in this profile.*

# WEST GREEN ATTRIBUTES

## SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), WEST GREEN

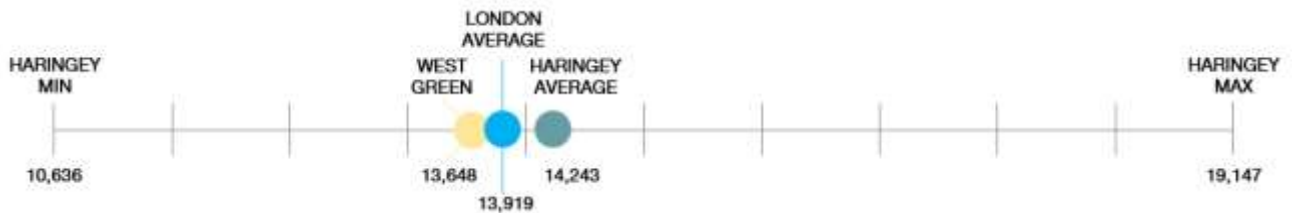
- At 1.4 sq. km, West Green is slightly smaller than the Haringey average (1.6 sq. km). Both West Green and Haringey wards on average are substantially smaller than the average London ward (2.6 sq. km).

## POPULATION, WEST GREEN

- West Green has 13,648 residents. This is slightly smaller than the average Haringey (14,275) ward, but in line with the London (13,919) average.

## POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), WEST GREEN

- Population density in West Green is in line with the Haringey average, at 9,652 residents per sq. km (compared to an average of 9,945 in Haringey and 8,742 in London).

## OPEN SPACE, WEST GREEN

- 38.2% of West Green ward is made up of open space, above the Haringey (25.2%) and London (27.2%) averages.

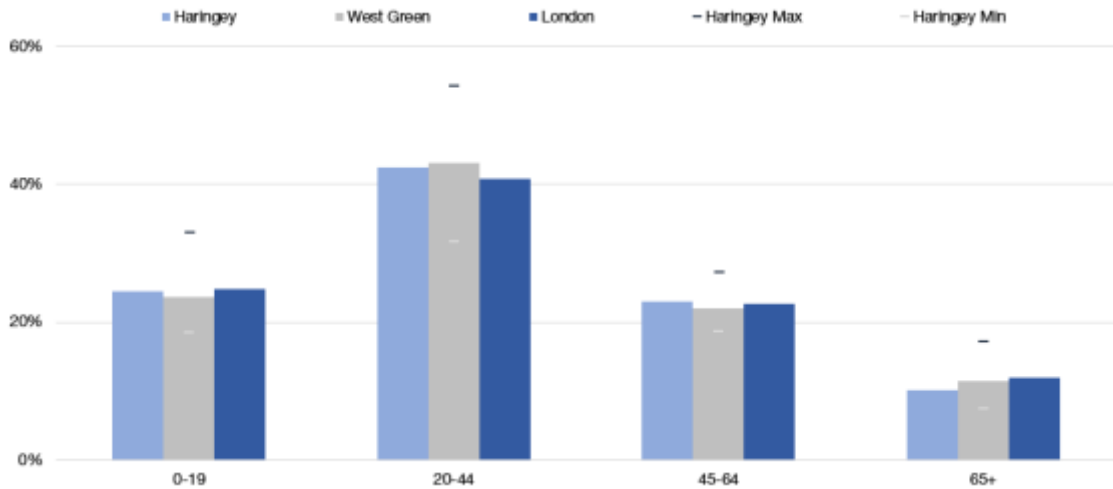

# DEMOGRAPHICS

## POPULATION AGE, WEST GREEN

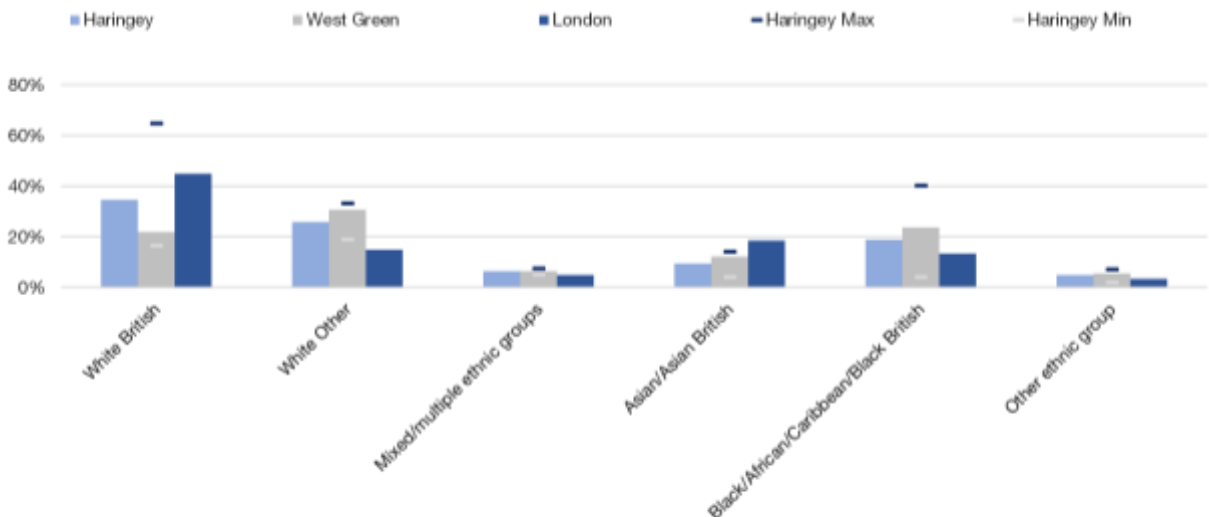
- West Green's overall population spread mirrors that seen in Haringey more widely, with no age group particularly over-represented or under-represented in the ward.

## ETHNICITY, WEST GREEN

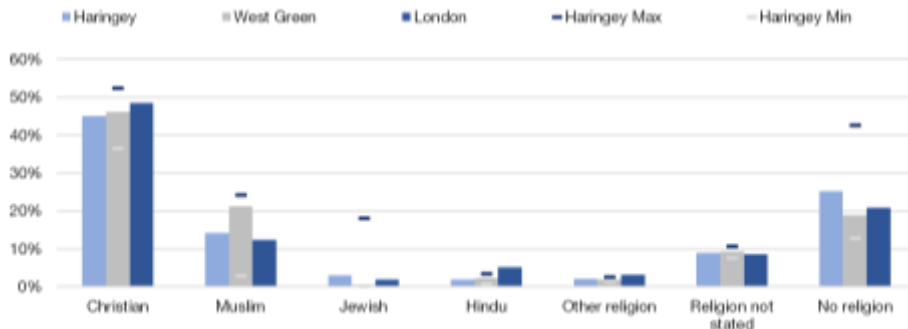
- West Green largely follows the ethnicity pattern seen in Haringey more widely, with the exception that the White British ethnic group is the third largest ethnic group (while it is usually the largest). 21.7% of West Green residents are of White British ethnicity, compared to 34.7% in Haringey.

## RELIGION, WEST GREEN

- While following the overall borough pattern, West Green has a larger proportion of Muslim residents (21.2%) compared to Haringey (14.2%).
- There is also a slightly smaller proportion of residents in West Green saying they have no religion (18.8%) compared to Haringey more widely (25.2%).

## EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

### % PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, WEST GREEN

- West Green has a smaller proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (57.8%) than the average in either Haringey (67.4%) or London (71.4%).
- This is the third lowest level within the borough.

### % PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, WEST GREEN

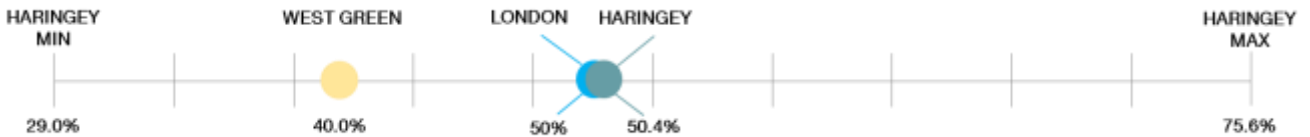
- In West Green, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (51.6%) is below the Haringey and London average (65.1% and 68.8% respectively).
- This is the third lowest level within the borough.

## % QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, WEST GREEN

- In West Green, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (40%) is below the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

## INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

### MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, WEST GREEN

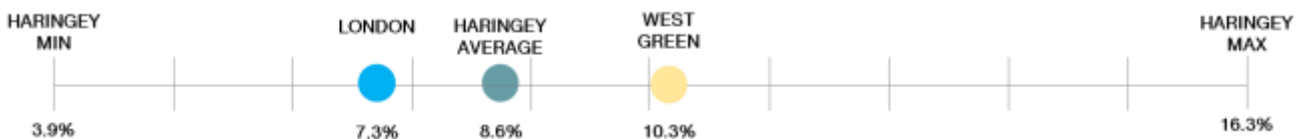
- The median household income in West Green is £31,110 a year. This is below the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages.

### UNEMPLOYMENT, WEST GREEN

- 10.3% of West Green residents are unemployed. This is higher than both the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages.

## CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), WEST GREEN

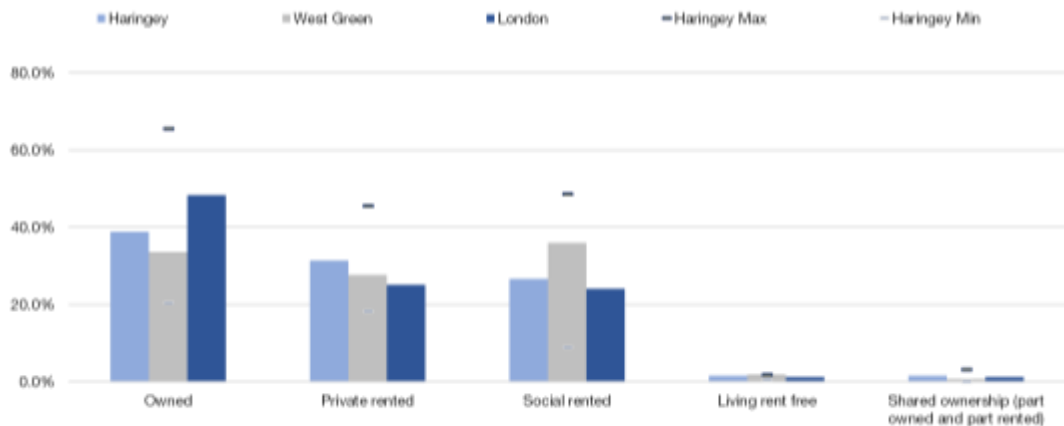
- In West Green there are 293.1 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is above both the Haringey and London levels (251.8 per 10,000 residents and 201.7 per 10,000 residents respectively), and is the fifth highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

## HOUSING TENURE, WEST GREEN

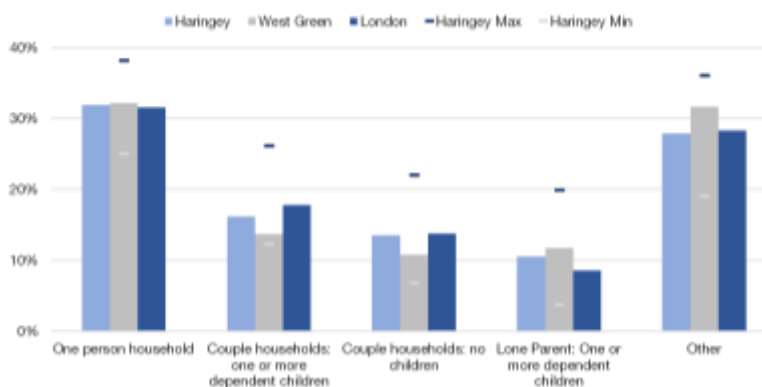
- West Green households are most likely to be socially rented (36%, a larger proportion than the borough average of 26.7%).
- By contrast, households that are lived in by the homeowners and privately rented households are slightly under-represented in West Green.

## HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, WEST GREEN

- In West Green, household composition largely follows the wider pattern, with the exception that Couple households with dependent children (13.7%) and Couple households with no children (10.8%) are slightly under-represented compared to Haringey (16.2% and 13.5% respectively).

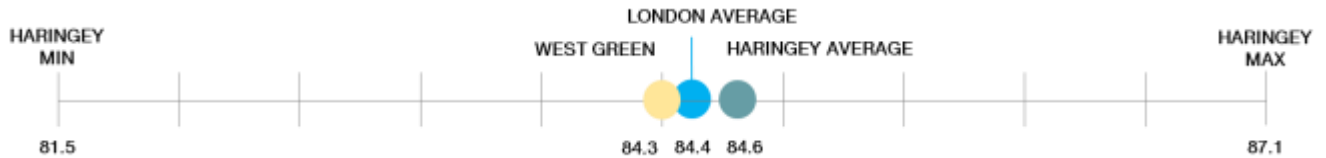

# HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

## FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, WEST GREEN

- Female life expectancy in West Green is 84.3 years, slightly below the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages.

## MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, WEST GREEN

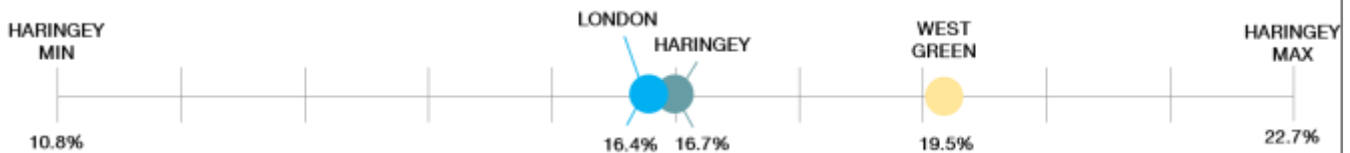
- Male life expectancy in West Green is 80.7 years, slightly above the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages.

## RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, WEST GREEN

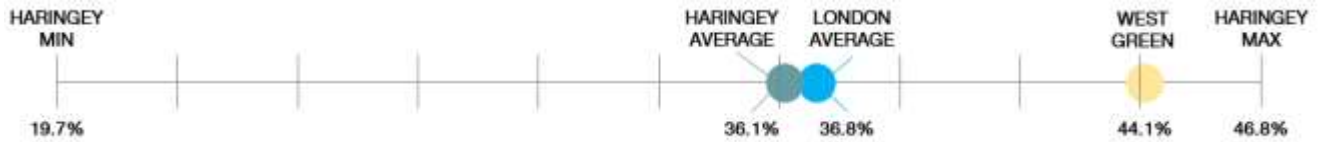
- In West Green 19.5% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is higher than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely, and is the fifth highest rate of all Haringey wards.

## % PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, WEST GREEN

- 44.1% of Year 6 children in West Green have excess weight. This is above the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages.
- Although above average, levels of excess weight in West Green is not among the highest in Haringey.

## RATE OF CRIME, WEST GREEN

- In West Green there were 221 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was slightly lower than the Haringey level, and higher than London (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively).
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
