

HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: WHITE HART LANE

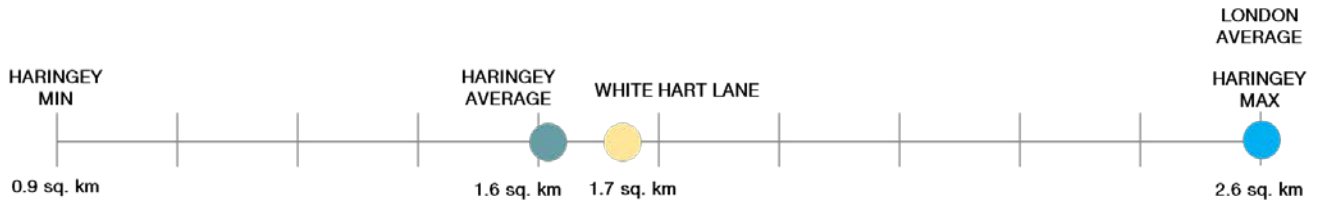

Such granular data is less widely available than data at regional or borough level, and as such certain measures use data going back to the 2011 Census. WHITE HART LANE ATTRIBUTES

SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), WHITE HART LANE

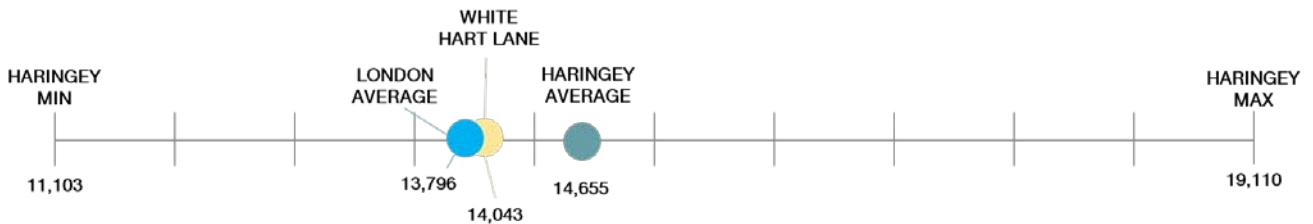
- At 1.7 sq. km, White Hart Lane is slightly larger than the Haringey average (1.6 sq. km), but smaller than the size of the average London ward (2.6 sq. km).

POPULATION, WHITE HART LANE

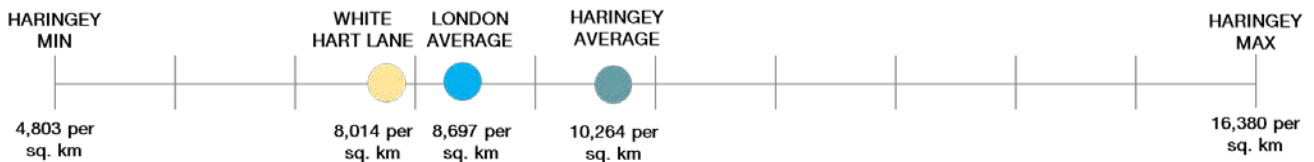
- The population of White Hart Lane (14,043) is largely in line with the London average (13,796), but is below the Haringey average (14,655).

POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), WHITE HART LANE

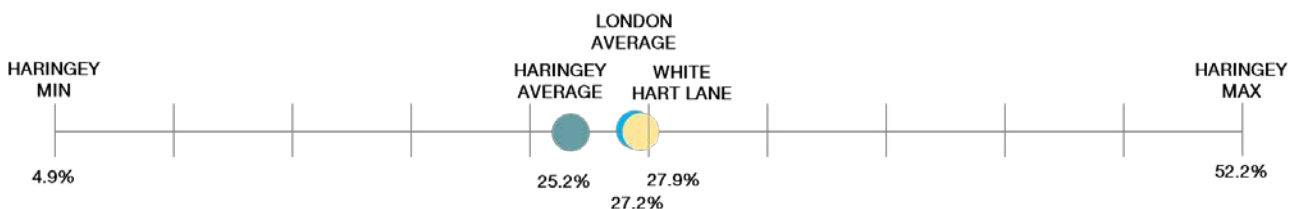
- Population density in White Hart Lane (8,014 residents per sq. km) is lower than the Haringey (10,264 per sq. km) and London (8,697 per sq. km) averages.

OPEN SPACE, WHITE HART LANE

- 27.9% of White Hart Lane ward is made up of open space. This is slightly larger than the Haringey average (25.2%) and is in line with London (27.2%).

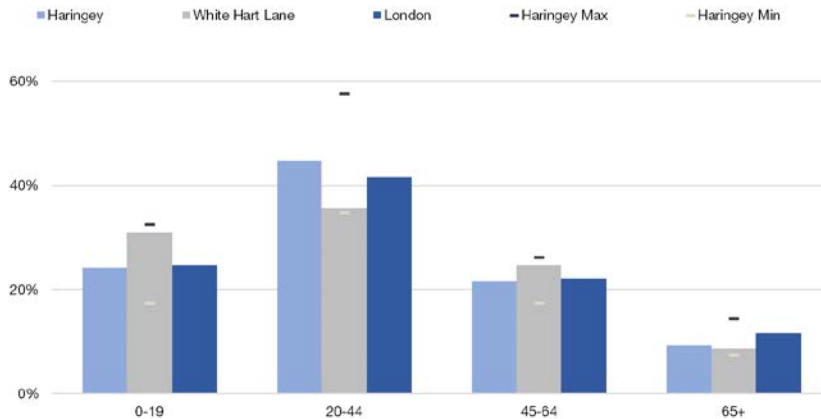

DEMOGRAPHICS

POPULATION AGE, WHITE HART LANE

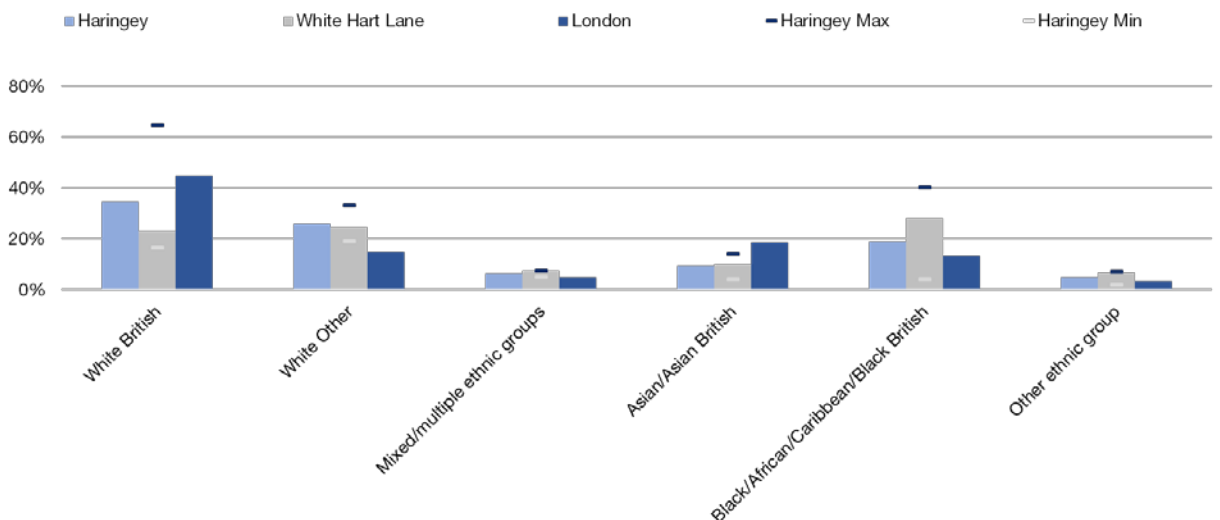
- While the 20-44 age group remains the predominant age group in White Hart Lane by a small margin (35.6%), this group is under-represented in the ward compared to Haringey (44.8%).
- By contrast, the 0-19 age group is over-represented in White Hart Lane (30.9%), as is the 45-64 age group (24.7%).

ETHNICITY, WHITE HART LANE

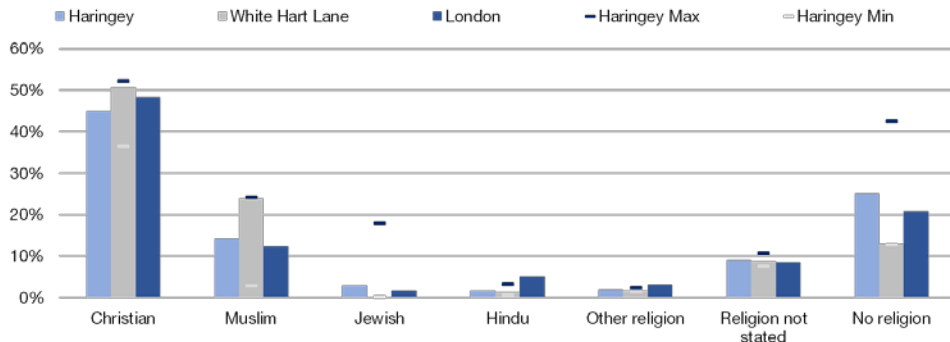
- In White Hart Lane those of Black ethnicity represent the largest group (28.3%). This group is over-represented in White Hart Lane compared to the Haringey average (18.8%).
- Those of White British ethnicity (23%) are under-represented in White Hart Lane compared to the Haringey average (34.7%).

RELIGION, WHITE HART LANE

- White Hart Lane has among the largest proportions of residents identifying as Christian (50.8%) or Muslim (23.9%) of all Haringey wards.
- White Hart Lane has the smallest proportion of residents that do not identify with any religion (12.9%, compared to 25.2% in Haringey).

EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

% PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, WHITE HART LANE

- White Hart Lane has a smaller proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (61.1%) than the average in either Haringey (65.9%) or London (67%). This is not among the lowest levels in the borough.

% PUPILS ACHIEVING 5+ GCSEs AT GRADE 9-4 INCLUDING ENGLISH & MATHS, WHITE HART LANE

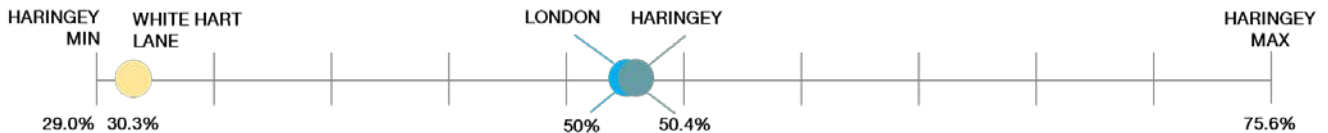
- In White Hart Lane, the proportion of pupils achieving 5 or more GCSEs at grade 9-4 (44.1%) is substantially lower than the Haringey and national averages (53.7% and 60.6% respectively). This is not among the lowest levels in the borough.
- There is substantial variation in GCSE attainment among different Haringey wards, ranging from 35% achieving 5 GCSEs at grade 9-4, to 80.7%.

% QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, WHITE HART LANE

- In White Hart Lane, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (30.3%) is significantly below the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages. This is the second lowest rate of all Haringey wards.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

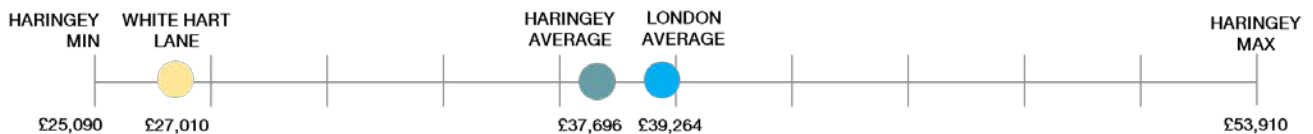

INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, WHITE HART LANE

- The median household income in White Hart Lane is £27,010 a year. This is significantly below the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages, and is the second lowest level of all Haringey wards.

UNEMPLOYMENT, WHITE HART LANE

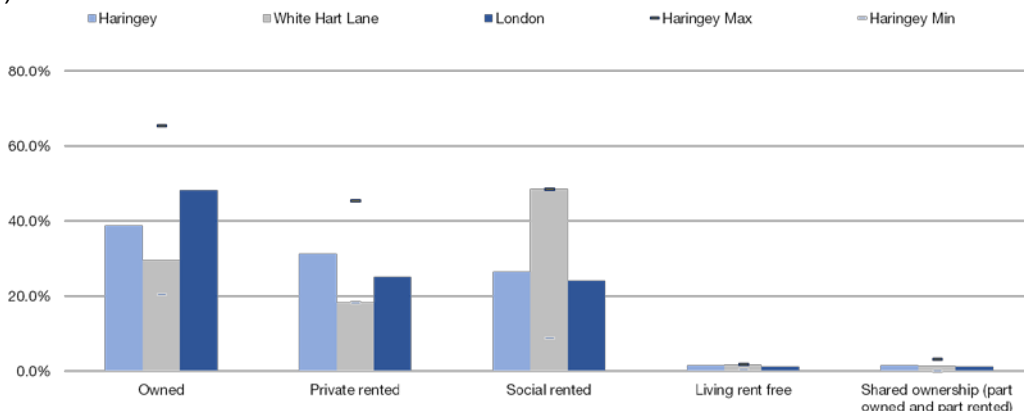
- 12.7% of White Hart Lane residents are unemployed. This is higher than both the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages. This is also the second highest rate of all Haringey wards.

HOUSING TENURE, WHITE HART LANE

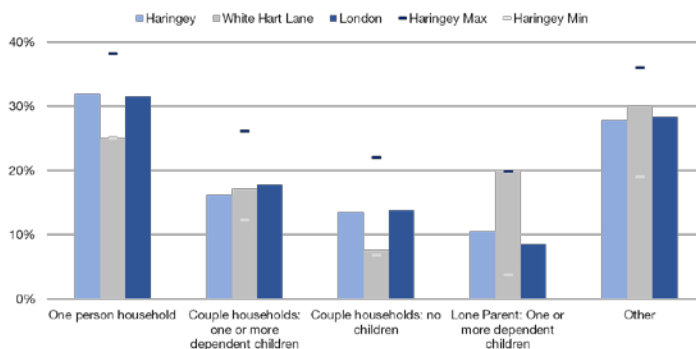
- White Hart Lane has the largest proportion of socially rented households of all Haringey wards (48.7%, a substantially larger proportion than the borough average of 26.7%).
- The ward also has the smallest proportion of privately rented households of all Haringey wards (18.4%).

HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, WHITE HART LANE

- White Hart Lane has the largest proportion of Lone parent households with dependent children of all Haringey wards (19.9%).
- White Hart Lane has the smallest proportion of One person households (25.1%) of all Haringey wards, and Couple households with no children (7.6%) are also under-represented.

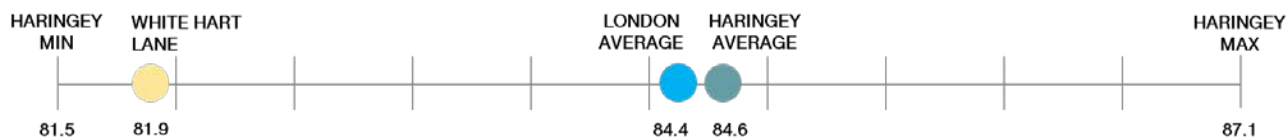

HEALTH & WELLBEING

FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, WHITE HART LANE

- Female life expectancy in White Hart Lane is 81.9 years, below the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages. This is the second lowest female life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, WHITE HART LANE

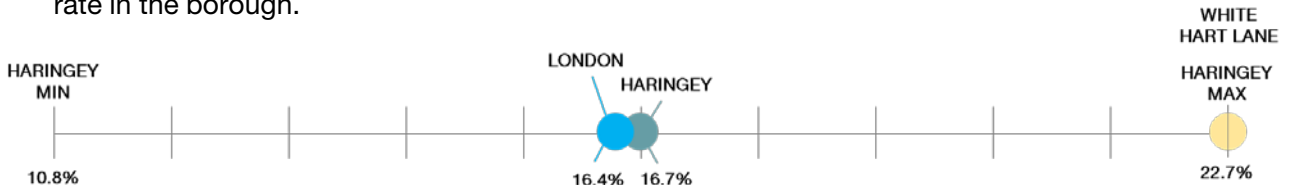
- Male life expectancy in White Hart Lane is 76.6 years, substantially below the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages, and the third lowest male life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, WHITE HART LANE

- In White Hart Lane 22.7% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is much higher than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%), and is the highest rate in the borough.

% PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, WHITE HART LANE

- 44% of Year 6 children in White Hart Lane have excess weight. This is above the Haringey (36%) and London (36.2%) averages, and is the fourth highest rate in the borough.
