

# HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: WOODSIDE

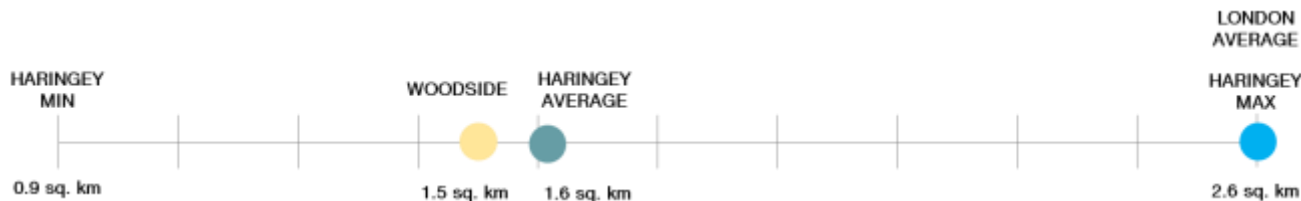

# WOODSIDE ATTRIBUTES

## SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), WOODSIDE

- At 1.5 sq. km, Woodside is smaller than the average Haringey (1.6 sq. km) and London (2.6 sq. km) ward. London wards are on average 63% bigger than Haringey wards.

## POPULATION, WOODSIDE

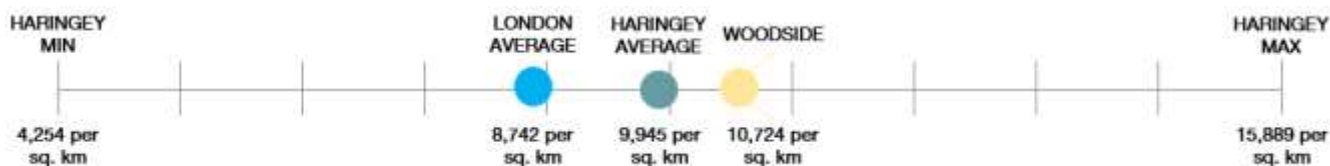
- With 16,075 residents, Woodside's population is larger than either the average Haringey (14,243) or London (13,919) ward.

## POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), WOODSIDE

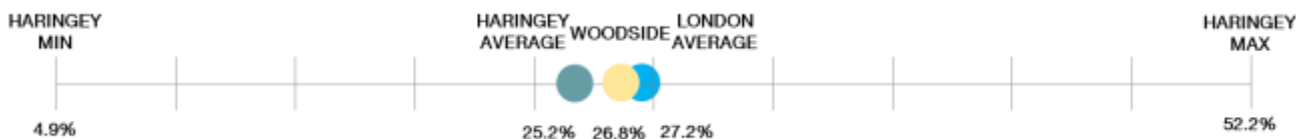
- Population density in Woodside is slightly larger than the Haringey average, at 10,724 residents per sq. km (compared to an average of 9,945 in Haringey and 8,742 in London).

## OPEN SPACE, WOODSIDE

- 26.8% of Woodside ward is made up of open space, sitting in between the Haringey (25.2%) and London (27.2%) averages.

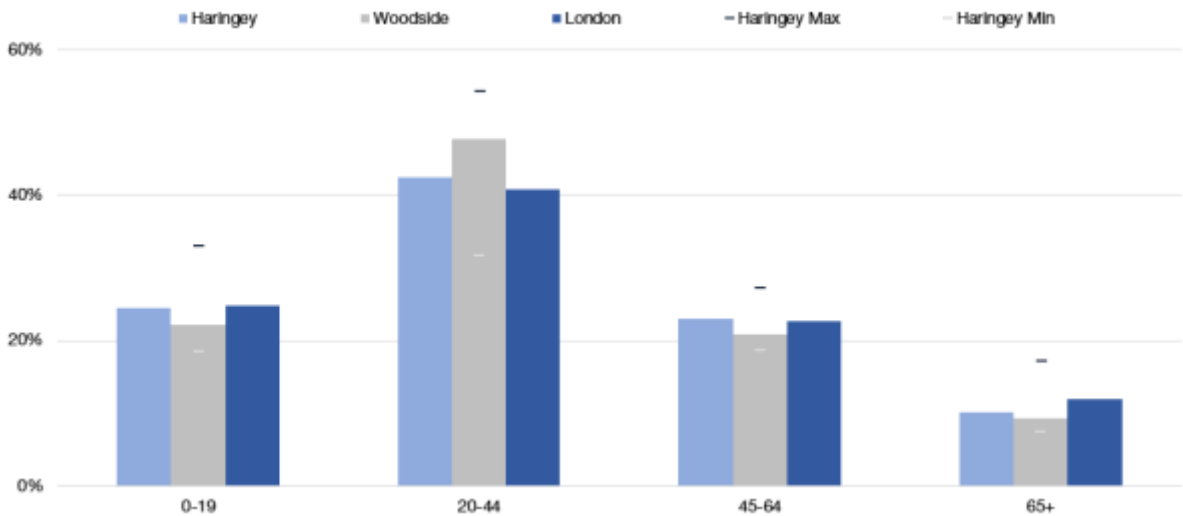

# DEMOGRAPHICS

## POPULATION AGE, WOODSIDE

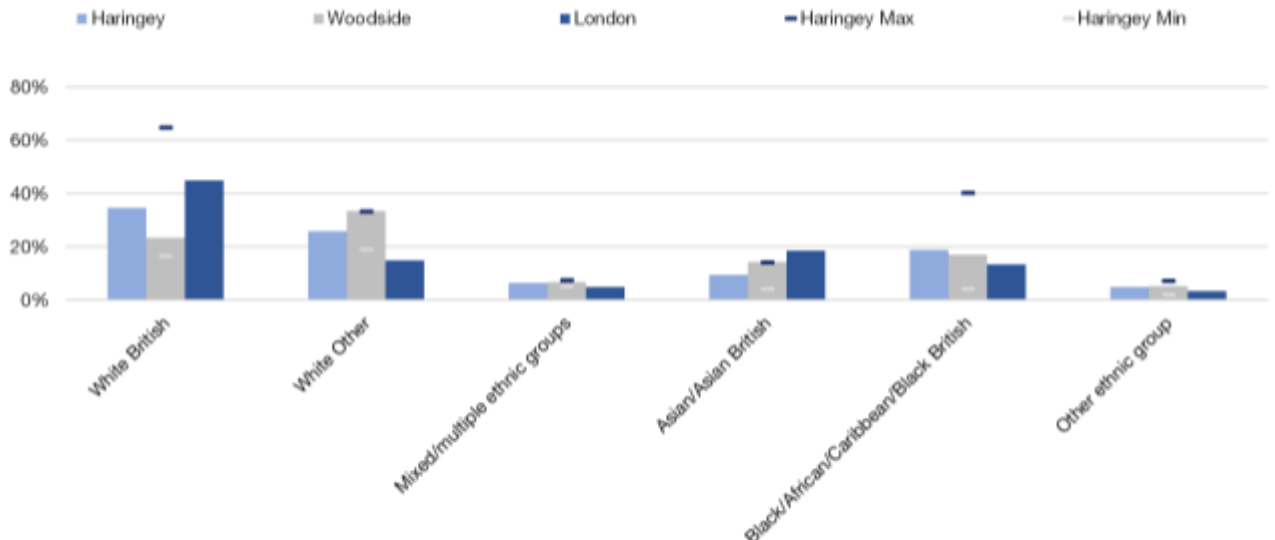
- Those aged 20-44 make up the largest age group among Woodside residents (47.8%), while those aged 65+ make up the smallest proportion (9.3%). This follows the pattern seen in the wider borough, with 20-44 year olds slightly over-represented compared to the wider borough (42.5%).

## ETHNICITY, WOODSIDE

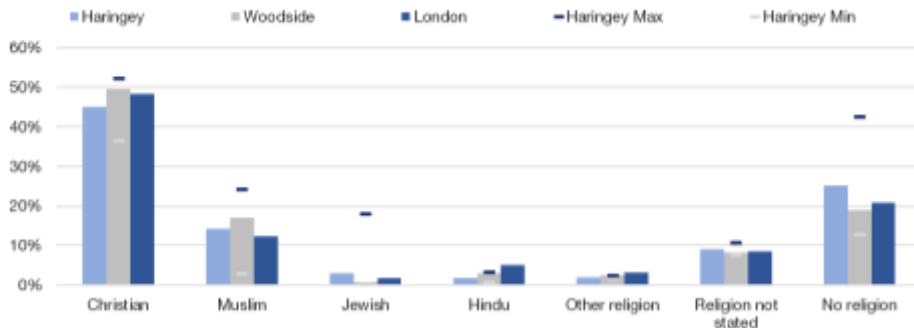
- In Woodside those of White Other ethnicity represent the largest group (33.5%). Woodside has the largest proportion of residents of White Other ethnicity of all Haringey wards. Woodside also has the largest proportion of Asian residents of all Haringey wards (14.3%).
- Those of White British ethnicity are under-represented in Woodside (23.3%) compared to the Haringey average (34.7%).

## RELIGION, WOODSIDE

- Woodside residents are slightly more likely to be Christian (49.6%) or Muslim (17%), compared to the Haringey average (45% and 14.2% respectively).
- By contrast, residents that do not identify with any religion are under-represented in Woodside (18.9%), compared to the Haringey average (25.2%).

## EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

### % PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, WOODSIDE

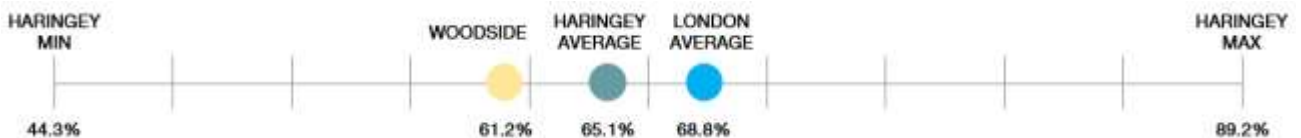
- The proportion of Woodside pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level (60.6%) is smaller than both the Haringey (67.4%) and London (71.4%) averages. Despite being below the average Woodside is not amongst the lowest levels in the borough.

### % PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, WOODSIDE

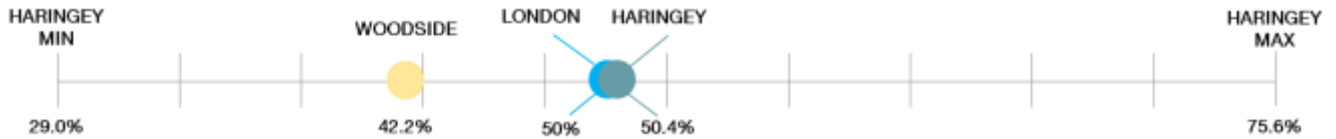
- In Woodside, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (61.2%) is below the Haringey average (65.1%) and the London average (68.8%) respectively.
- There is substantial variation in GCSE attainment among different Haringey wards, ranging from 44.3% achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths, to 89.2%.

## % QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, WOODSIDE

- In Woodside, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (42.2%) is below the Haringey (50.4%) and London (50%) averages.
- There is substantial variation in qualification level among different Haringey wards, ranging from 29% being qualified to level 3 or higher, to 75.6%.

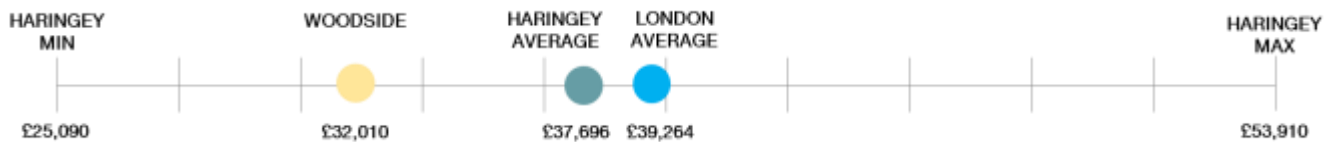

## INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

### MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, WOODSIDE

- The median household income in Woodside is £32,010 a year. This is below the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages. This is not among the lowest levels of all Haringey wards.

### UNEMPLOYMENT, WOODSIDE

- 8.8% of Woodside residents are unemployed. This is slightly higher than the Haringey average (8.6%) and higher than the rate in London (7.3%).

## CLAIMANTS (INC. UNIVERSAL CREDIT & JSA), WOODSIDE

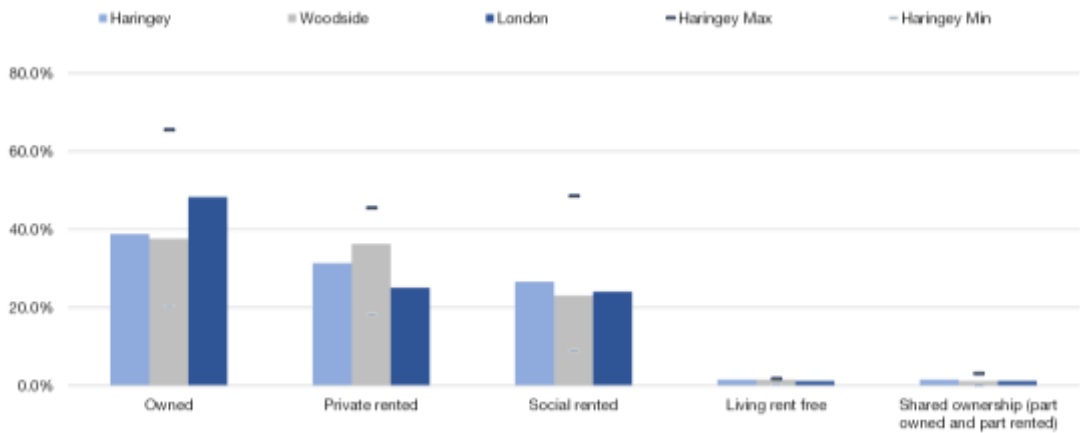
- In Woodside there are 214.6 claimants per 10,000 residents who claim benefit principally for the reason of being unemployed.
- This is lower than the Haringey level and higher than London (251.8 per 10,000 residents and 201.7 per 10,000 residents respectively).
- The rate of claimants in Haringey is almost 25% higher than the London rate.

## HOUSING TENURE, WOODSIDE

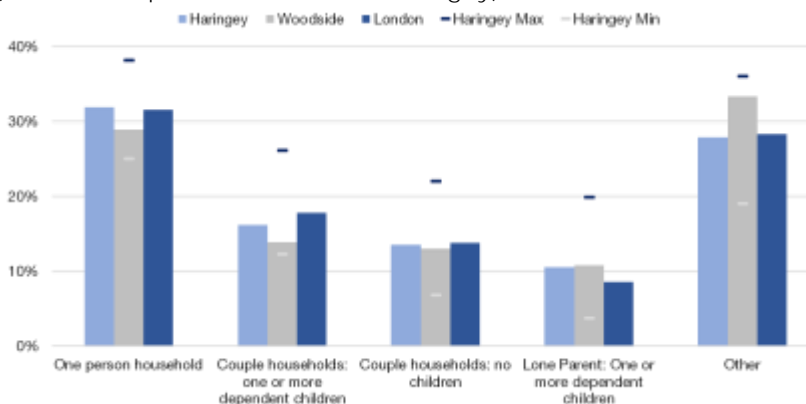
- Patterns of tenure in Woodside largely follow the borough pattern, though the private rental sector is comparatively slightly over-represented (making up 36.4% of households vs. 31.5% in Haringey).

## HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, WOODSIDE

- In Woodside, patterns of household composition largely follow the borough pattern, though 'Other' household types (e.g. households with non-dependent children and house shares) are slightly over-represented (33.4% compared to 27.9% in Haringey).

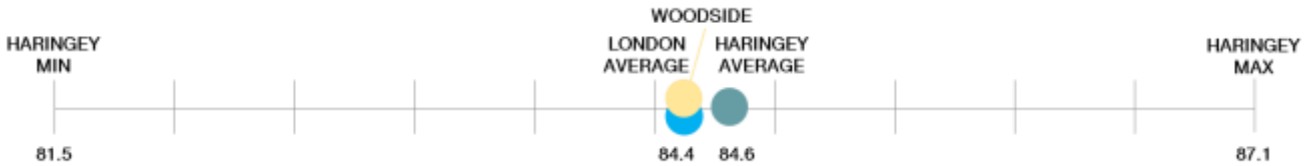

## FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, WOODSIDE

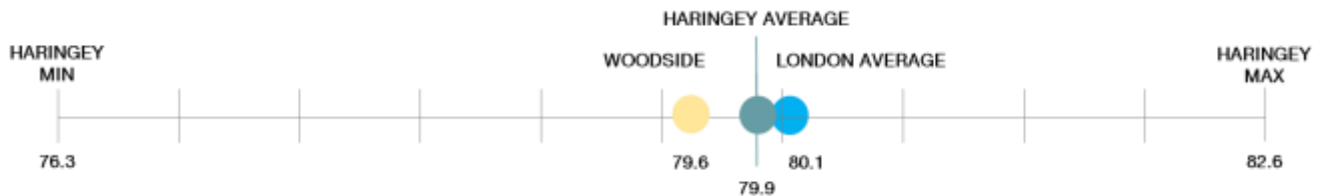
- Female life expectancy in Woodside is 84.4 years, in line with the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages.

## MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, WOODSIDE

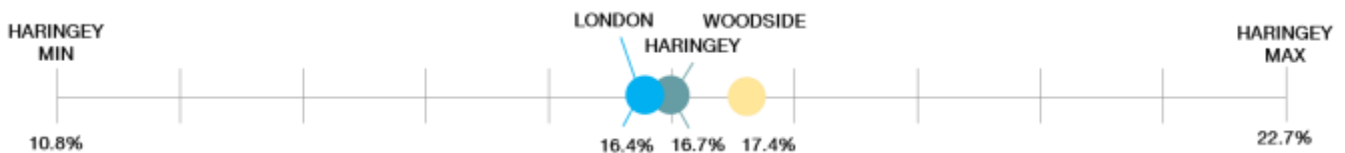
- Male life expectancy in Woodside is 79.6 years, slightly lower than the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages.

## RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, WOODSIDE

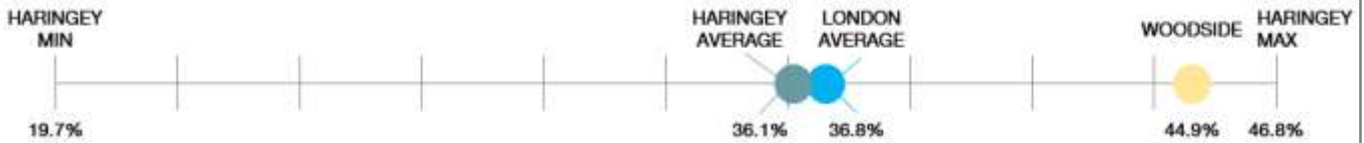
- In Woodside 17.4% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is slightly higher than the rate seen in Haringey (16.7%) and London (16.4%) more widely.

## % PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, WOODSIDE

- 44.9% of Year 6 children in Woodside have excess weight. This is above the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages, and is the fourth highest rate in Haringey.

## RATE OF CRIME, WOODSIDE

- In Woodside there were 178 crimes per 1,000 residents between January 2018 and December 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was lower than both the Haringey and London rate (229 per 1,000 residents and 193 per 1,000 residents respectively).
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 18% above the London rate.
