Subject: redesignation of use of Pinkham Way site

Dear Sir/madam

I have been a Haringey resident and voter and consumer of local services for 36 years.

I wish to strongly and forcefully object to the redesignation of the Pinkam Way site from its suitability for employment use to industrial use.

On reading Haringey's strategy I see that in section 5.1.18 there is a recommendation that "existing employment sites be retained.....to contribute to social infrastructure and provide training." This seems tp me totally appropriate to the nature of the site. Switching to industrial designation :

a) in such an area so close to two primary schools and quite dense housing

b)where it is adjacent to an ecological and environmental site

c) when there has not been adequate information or consultation of all us local people whose children and grandchildren will be directly impacted, apart from ourselves

is completely wrong and undemocratic.

I urge you to insist that the process be done openly and with integrity the next time.
