I am writing to object to the above change of use. I have serious concerns about the change of designation of the Pinkham Way site from employment use to industrial use. The council formally refers to this as 'employment land designations in SP8 Employment of the Core Strategy, change of land designation for DEA6 from employment land to locally significant industrial site.'

I also object to the change of use for the Pinkham Way site on the following grounds:

• The suitability of using the site for industrial use when it has been previously listed as green space that should be protected.

• The environmental impact of using the site for industrial use, particularly when the site is very close to a built up residential area and local schools.
