Subject: Response to Core Consultation (Pinkham Woods)

I live about a mile away from Pinkham Woods and i would like to object to the re-designation of the Former Friern Barnet Sewage treatment site (Pinkham Woods) from *EL (Employment Use)* to *LSIS (Locally Significant Industrial Use)*.

I object because redesignating the site to LSIS will remove protection for the nature conservation value of the site and makes it more likely that the site will be used for heavy industrial use. If that happens it will lead to damage of the natural environment and biodiversity of the site. I would like to request an assessment of the natural environment to assess the site's nature conservation value as i believe this to be of significant value.

I object also because the council has not put forward any credible evidence to support why this land should be redesignated. The only reason i can see why the council would want the redesignation to happen is to make it easier to build a waste management plant to which there is significant local opposition. Also the updated Sustainability Appraisal produced by Hyder Consulting UK Limited points out the threat to the biodiversity of the site and does not add any evidence to support the redesignation of the site to LSIS.
